## Team,

Below is an update on Harlan County and Lovewell.

- As I wrote last time, the Corps is again allowing Lovewell to go 1.6 ft into the flood pool, or 10%. They crossed this threshold over the weekend. As of this morning they are halting inflows into the reservoir and will start filling the bays in the upper canal. They are also gong to start putting water into the lower canal system. They could start deliveries to the lower District next week.
- As a result of the May 31adjusted shutoff for Harlan County being set at 1928.17 and some June inflows, the Bostwicks now have enough to delivery 2 inches to NBID and the Upper KBID under "normal river conditions". At this point, no decision has been made on whether to take this water or leave it in the reservoir for next year. If one of the Districts decides to take the water, the other one probably will as well.
- Superior has been taking river water for a couple of weeks now.
