Good Morning Kenny,

As of this morning, Lovewell Reservoir storage is 24,150 acre-feet leaving 12,500 acre-feet in the conservation pool for irrigation. At 53% efficiency we could deliver approximately another 2.7 inches to all acres in the district. If we were to average 300 cfs release for the remaining of the season the water would last through August 18th. Seems we should not have a problem extending the season through at least the 15th (average 350 cfs release with inflows offsetting evaporation).
