For your information, the well above normal temperatures that we received last week rapidly melted our snow cover and resulted in the pool level at Harlan County Lake reaching the shut off elevation of 1928.86 feet on Sunday. We are currently storing water in the lake that can be utilized for irrigation. Hopefully we will see the inflows at Harlan County Lake continue for a while longer and that we will experience above normal precipitation this spring. At the risk of sounding too optimistic, things are looking up.
