MINUTES

The Board met Tuesday October 5, 2010 at 8:00 A.M., with Gary Housholder, Brad Peterson, Monty Dahl and Kenny Nelson present.

Time sheets and checks were signed. Minutes and the financial report from the previous meeting were approved as mailed.

There was no correspondence for the month.

A transfer acre request to install a pivot for Greg and Kay Mikesell in the NE 16-2-5 was approved. Acres will be transferred from the NW 28-2-5 and the SE 21-2-5 to complete the needed acres in 16-2-5.

Kenny reported the last irrigator shut off on September 29 from water being drained out of the canal system. This water was used in the lower Courtland West where crops were replanted or set back due to a late June hailstorm.

Brian Nelson has found employment at another location and will leave the district on October 15.

Kenny reported the White Rock 1.1 pipe lateral was completed on October 4. This is the last of the 2025 Challenge Grant projects. He also reported on other accomplishments and future work to be accomplished.

The Board was informed of a long-term problem with repairing or replacing radial gates on the Courtland Canal. The one contracted for emergency repair in 2008 cost \$100,000.00. There are 12 other gates on the system that are 50+ years old and may soon need replaced or repaired. The Bureau may be called upon to help with this review and in developing a long-term plan.

It was reported the contractor building the ramp flumes in the Courtland Canal is making progress.

A report was given on water supply. Both Harlan County and Lovewell are in good shape.

With no further business, the meeting adjourned at 9:00 am.
