
These orders modify the authorized acres that can be irrigated by these files. The authorized place of use is as shown on the plats within the change approvals.

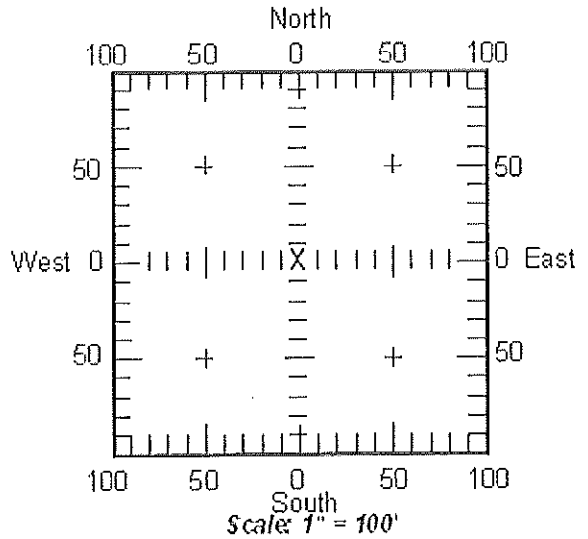

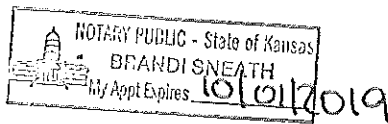

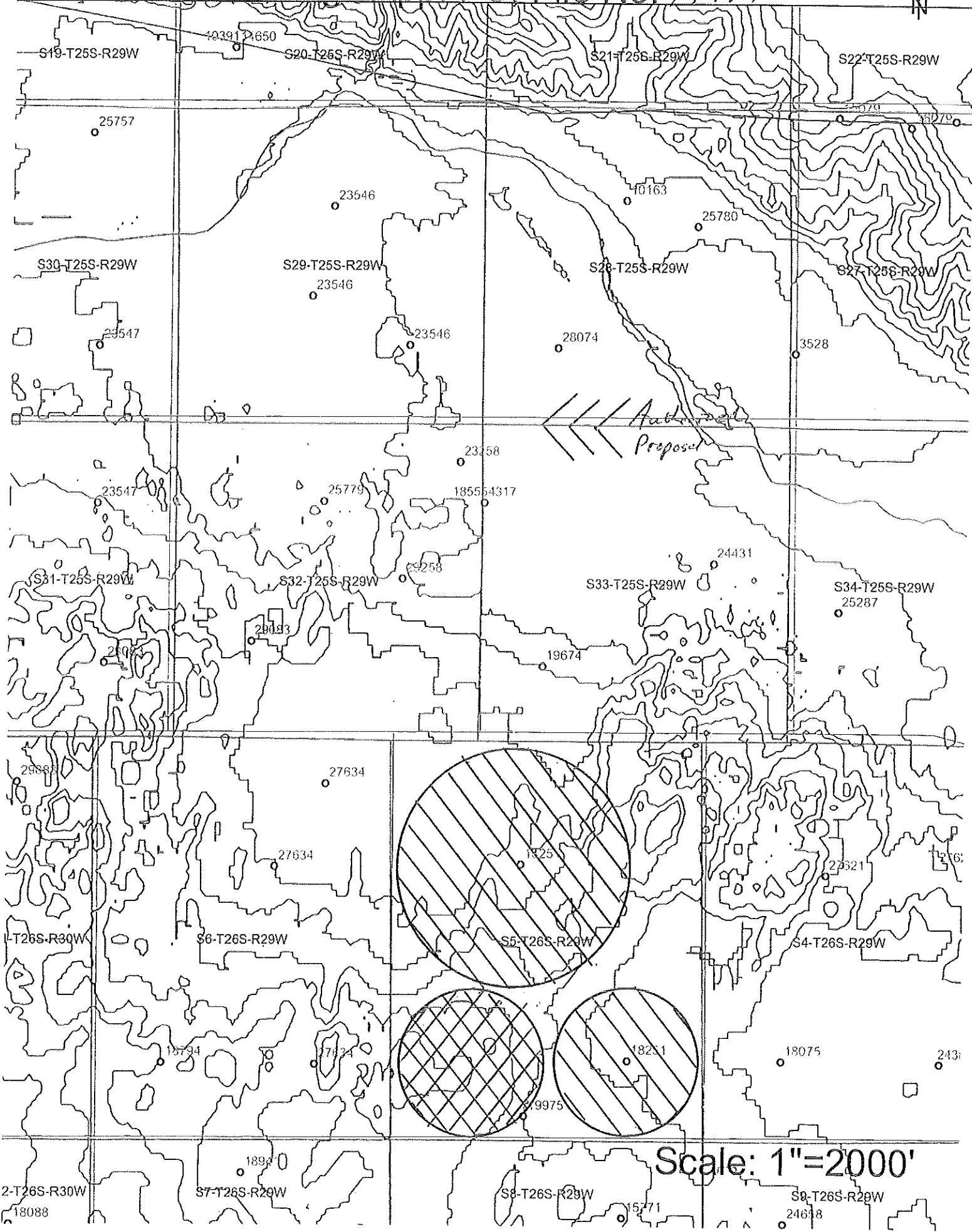

# Change App. PU, File No. 19975

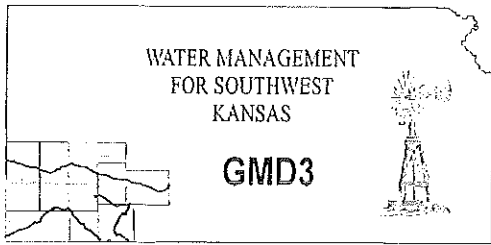


Proposed


