The term permit referenced above has been filed by Mick Ross, proposing to appropriate 130 acre-feet of groundwater at a rate of 1,200 gallons per minute for irrigation use. The point of diversion is located in the Crooked Creek drainage basin. The application was filed to allow the applicant to use more water from the proposed well for the 2018 irrigation season while not increasing the overall quantity on the place of use through offset from another well that also covers a portion of the same place of use.

The term permit has a period of use from August 1, 2018 through December 31, 2018. The safe yield requirements set forth in K.A.R. 5-3-11 and 5-23-4 are not applicable to term permits of five (5) years or less. Therefore, this term permit is exempt from safe yield criteria.

The proposed point of diversion is currently authorized by Water Right, File Nos. 30,950. An offset of 130 acre-feet from un-used quantity of water from Water Right, File No. 25,031 will ensure that no additional water will be diverted from the source of supply over what is currently authorized for irrigation use on the place of use.

The proposed place of use overlaps a portion with Water Right, File Nos. 13,158; 25,031 & 30,950. The place of use covers 274 acres located in Section 19 & Section 29 in Township 31 South, Range 28 West, Meade County.

The point of diversion is subject to a 1,600 feet spacing distance to other points of diversion for all non-domestic and non-temporary water rights. The closest Water Right, File No. 25,031, is located 2,576 feet away. Therefore, the application complies with well spacing criteria.

The quantity of water approved under this permit is further limited to the quantity which combined with Water Right, File No. 25,031, will provide a total not to exceed 626 acre-feet of water per calendar year, for irrigation use.

The quantity of water and rate of diversion approved under this permit is further limited to the quantity which combined with Water Right, File No. 30,950, will provide a total not to exceed 242 acrefeet of water per calendar year at a total rate of diversion not exceed 1,200 gallons per minute (2.67 c.f.s.) from the point of diversion.

In an email dated August 7, 2018 a copy of the application was sent to GMD No. 3 along with a request to make a recommendation. In a letter dated August 13, 2018, Jason Norquest, Assistant Manager of Southwest Kansas Groundwater Management District No. 3, indicated that application complies with the current management program and he further recommends approval of the applications at this time.

In an email on August 15, 2018, Mike Meyer, Water Commissioner of the Garden City Field Office, has recommended approval of the referenced term application.

Based on the above discussion, it appears that the proposed use of water is reasonable for irrigation use. Therefore, it is recommended that approval of the referenced term permit application to end on December 31, 2018.

Your application for a term permit to appropriate water for beneficial use has been examined, approved, and is being returned herewith for your records. Your attention is directed to the enclosures and to the terms, conditions, and limitations specified in Exhibit A of this permit. Please note the term period for this permit is from August 1, 2018 until December 31, 2018.

The approval of your application constitutes a term permit to appropriate water for beneficial use as set forth in the application. It does not constitute authority under K.S.A. 82a-301 through 305, to construct any dam or other obstruction; it does not give authority to any right-of-way, or authorize injury to, or trespass upon, public or private property, nor does it obviate the necessity of assent from federal or Local Governmental authorities, when necessary. Please be advised that K.S.A. 82a-728 sets forth, in essence, that it is unlawful to divert or threaten to divert water for the type of use you propose without first acquiring approval of the Chief Engineer of the Division of Water Resources.

An acceptable water meter is required and shall be installed on the diversion works authorized by this term permit in accordance with K.A.R. 5-1-4, and shall be installed prior to water being put to beneficial use. Notification of installation of the meter must be received in the office of the Chief Engineer within thirty (30) days of installation of the meter. A form for this purpose and for your convenience is enclosed. Accurate and complete records from which the quantity of water diverted during each calendar year may be readily determined, shall be maintained by the applicant, and the applicant shall file an annual water use report with the Chief Engineer by March 1, following the end of each calendar year. Failure to file the annual water use report by the due date, shall cause the applicant to be subject to a civil penalty.

## EXHIBIT "A" ADDITIONAL CONDITIONS OF TERM PERMIT FILE NO. 20189043

The approval of this term permit is subject to the following additional conditions:

That an acceptable water flow meter shall be installed on the diversion works authorized by this permit in accordance with the Kansas Administrative Regulations 5-1-4 through 5-1-12 adopted by the Chief Engineer. This water flow meter shall be used to provide an accurate quantity of water diverted as required by for the annual water use report.

That all wells with a diversion rate of 100 gallons per minute or more drilled under the authority of this permit shall have a tube or other device installed in a manner acceptable to, and in accordance with specifications adopted by, the Chief Engineer. This tube or device shall be suitable for making water level measurements and shall be maintained in a condition satisfactory to the Chief Engineer.

That all diversion works constructed under the authority of this permit into which any type of chemical or other foreign substance will be injected into the water pumped from the diversion works shall be equipped with an in-line, automatic quick-closing, check valve capable of preventing pollution of the source of the water supply. The type of valve installed shall meet specifications adopted by the Chief Engineer and shall be maintained in an operating condition satisfactory to the Chief Engineer.

That the well casing and other appurtenances to said well under this appropriation shall be maintained by the applicant to the satisfaction of the Chief Engineer, Division of Water Resources, Kansas Department of Agriculture. That in the event this application is dismissed or the well under this appropriation should become abandoned by the applicant, the applicant shall cause said well to be plugged in accordance with the requirements of article 30 of the rules and Regulations as adopted by the Kansas Department of Health and Environment.

That the quantity of water approved under this permit is further limited to the quantity which combined with Water Right, File No. 25,031, will provide a total not to exceed 626 acre-feet of water per calendar year, for irrigation use.

That the quantity of water and rate of diversion approved under this permit is further limited to the quantity which combined with Water Right, File No. 30,950, will provide a total not to exceed 242 acre-feet of water per calendar year at a total rate of diversion not exceed 1,200 gallons per minute (2.67 c.f.s.) from the point of diversion described herein for irrigation use on the following described property:

We have completed a review of the application for the above referenced term permit. The application is not in conflict with the Management Program of the Southwest Kansas Groundwater Management District No. 3 (GMD3). The applicant is requesting the term permit to finish out the 2018 season while working on a permanent solution for the past overpumping. The term permit will ensure that the current crop can make it through the season and not waste the water that has been applied. The base water right, 30950, will be suspended as penalty in the 2019 season. Spacing is still met to neighboring wells, even with the added 130AF request. We do not view this as new water being appropriated since usage is offset by water not pumped from another irrigation well in the system, water right 25031, which is within a half mile of this proposed well. The applicant will be reviewing possible changes to cropping practices and/or water rights to eliminate the overpumping in the future. It is therefore recommended that the application be approved at this time.


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
