Irvin L. and Rose Yeager, water right owners, filed an application for approval to change the point of diversion for the referenced file number, authorized groundwater for stockwatering use. The referenced file number does not appear to be abandoned as per K.S.A. 82a-718. The drainage basin for File No. 20,460.01 will be corrected from the Smoky Hill River to Walnut Creek.

The referenced file number is authorized 1.821 million gallons (5.59 acre-feet) from one well for stockwatering use in a feedlot located in the Southeast Quarter (SE½) of Section 18, Township 18 South, Range 30 West, Lane County, Kansas. The authorized well has no overlaps but the place of use overlaps Water Right, File Nos. 18,322.01 and 39,547.01. The water right owners propose to move the entire rate and quantity of File No. 20,460.01 to an existing well authorized by File No. 39,547.01 approximately 906 feet northeast of the currently authorized location, at a point 2,376 feet North and 2,088 feet West of the Southeast corner of the aforementioned Section 18. The currently authorized well will be retained as a standby well.

A condition will be placed on the approval document limiting the standby well for use exclusively at such time the well identified as the primary well is inoperable due to mechanical, maintenance or power failure. Use of the standby well under these limiting conditions does not allow the authorized quantity of water or rate of diversion under this right to be exceeded.

WRIS indicates there are two irrigation wells authorized by Water Right File No. 10,698 within one-half mile of the proposed well, and one stockwatering well authorized by Water Right, File No. 18,322.01 all under common ownership. No domestic wells were indicated on the application map.

In a letter dated December 12, 2017, received December 15, 2017 Kyle Spencer, Manager of Western Kansas Groundwater Management District No. 1, indicated that the Board of Directors recommended approval of the referenced application with a waiver of K.A.R. 5-21-3.

In an e-mail dated December 18, 2017 Michael Meyer, Water Commissioner of the Garden City Field Office, recommended approval of the referenced application.

Water flow meters are required. Check valves are required if any chemical or foreign substance is injected into the water through the diversion works.

Based on the above discussion, that the changes are reasonable, that impairment to existing water rights is unlikely, that no change in the local source of supply will occur, and if the Chief Engineer waives K.A.R. 5-21-3 it has been recommended the referenced application be approved.

APPROVAL OF APPLICATION FOR CHANGE IN POINT OF DIVERSION AND ORDER CORRECTING THE DRAINAGE BASIN WATER RIGHT FILE NO. 20,460.01

The Chief Engineer, Division of Water Resources, Kansas Department of Agriculture, after due consideration of the written application of Irvin L. and Rose Yeager, P.O. Box 130, 115 West Highway 96, Dighton, Kansas 67839, received in this office on October 2, 2017, for approval of a change in the location of the point of diversion under the certificate of appropriation issued pursuant to the application for permit to appropriate water for beneficial use, as modified and amended by the Order of the Chief Engineer dated December 10, 1991, approving the application to change the use made of water, finds that the change is reasonable and will not impair existing rights, and that the application should be and is hereby approved.

The effective date of the change shall be the date this order is executed by the Chief Engineer, after which the authorized locations of the points of diversion shall be:

one (1) well located in the Northwest Quarter of the Northwest Quarter of the Southeast Quarter (NW½ NW½ SE½) of Section 18, more particularly described as being near a point 2,376 feet North and 2,088 feet West of the Southeast corner of said section (primary well), and

one (1) well located in the Southwest Quarter of the Northwest Quarter of the Southeast Quarter (SW½ NW½ SE½) of Section 18, more particularly described as being near a point 1,650 feet North and 2,635 feet West of the Southeast corner of said section (standby well),

both in Township 18 South, Range 30 West, Lane County, Kansas,

located substantially as shown on the map accompanying the application to change the point of diversion, and corrects the drainage basin for Water Right, File No. 20,460.01 to Walnut Creek.

The well described herein as the standby well shall be used exclusively at such time the well herein described as the primary well is inoperable due to mechanical, maintenance or power failure. Use of the standby well under these limiting conditions does not allow the authorized quantity of water or rate of diversion under this file to be exceeded.

Installation of the works for diversion of water shall be completed on or before December 31, 2018, or within any authorized extension of time. The water right owner shall notify the Chief Engineer of the Division of Water Resources, Kansas Department of Agriculture, when construction of the works for diversion has been completed.

All diversion works into which any type of chemical or other foreign substance will be injected into the water pumped from the diversion works shall be equipped with an in-line, automatic, quick-closing check valve capable of preventing pollution of the source of the water supply. The type of valve installed shall meet specifications adopted by the Chief Engineer and shall be maintained in an operating condition satisfactory to the Chief Engineer.

The water right owner shall properly install an acceptable water meter on the diversion works authorized under this water right, prior to the use of water, in strict accordance with the Kansas Administrative Regulations 5-1-4 through 5-1-12 adopted by the Chief Engineer. The water right owner shall notify the Chief Engineer when installation of the water meter has been completed. The water right owner shall maintain the water meter in an operating condition satisfactory to the Chief Engineer, at all times during diversion of water and shall maintain records from which the total quantity of water diverted may be determined. The water right owner shall also report the reading of said water meter and the total quantity of water diverted annually to the Chief Engineer. Such records shall be furnished to the Chief Engineer by March 1 following the end of each calendar year.

In all other respects, the Certificate of Appropriation issued pursuant to Approval of Application, File No. 20,460.01, for permit to appropriate water for beneficial use, is as stated and set forth in the Certificate of Appropriation dated October 23, 1991, as modified and amended by the aforementioned order.

RIGHT TO A HEARING AND TO ADMINISTRATIVE REVIEW

If you are aggrieved by this Order, then pursuant to K.S.A. 82a-1901, you may:

- 1) request an evidentiary hearing before the Chief Engineer, or
- 2) request administrative review by the Secretary of Agriculture.

Failure to request an evidentiary hearing before the Chief Engineer does not preclude your right to administrative review by the Secretary.

To obtain an evidentiary hearing before the Chief Engineer, a written request for hearing must be filed within 15 days after service of this Order as provided in K.S.A. 77-531 (i.e., within a total of 18 days after this Order was mailed to you), with: Kansas Department of Agriculture, Attn: Legal Section, 1320 Research Park Drive, Manhattan, KS 66502, FAX (785) 564-6777.

If you do not file a request for an evidentiary hearing before the Chief Engineer, you may petition for administrative review of the Order by the Secretary of Agriculture. A petition for review shall be in writing and state the basis for requesting administrative review. The request for hearing may be denied if the request fails to clearly establish factual or legal issues for review. See K.S.A. 77-527. The petition must be filed within 30 days after service of this Order as provided in K.S.A. 77-531 (i.e., within a total of 33 days after this Order was mailed to you), and be filed with: Secretary of Agriculture, Attn: Legal Division, Kansas Department of Agriculture, 1320 Research Park Drive, Manhattan, KS 66502, FAX (785) 564-6777.

If neither a request for an evidentiary hearing nor a petition for administrative review is filed as set forth above, then this Order shall be effective and become a final agency action as defined in K.S.A. 77-607(b). Failure to timely request either an evidentiary hearing or administrative review may preclude further judicial review under the Kansas Judicial Review Act.

Any request for hearing or petition for administrative review shall be in writing and shall be submitted to the attention of: Chief Legal Counsel, Kansas Department of Agriculture, 1320 Research Park Drive, Manhattan, Kansas 66502, Fax: (785) 564 - 6777.

WAIVER OF REGULATION K.A.R. 5-21-3(a) Well spacing requirements

Date: 1/4/19

Re: Water Right, File No. 20,460.01

- 1. That K.A.R. 5-21-3(a) states in part that the minimum well spacing requirement for non-domestic wells which propose the withdrawal of water from the Ogallala Formation shall be a minimum of 2.640 feet from all other non-domestic wells in the Ogallala aguifer.
- 2. That the application to change the point of diversion for Water Right, File No. 20,460.01 was received in the office of the Chief Engineer on October 2, 2017. The referenced file number, authorized for stockwatering use, has no overlap in the authorized point of diversion but overlaps in the place of use of Water Right, File Nos. 18,322.01 and 39,547.01. The referenced application proposes to add an existing well authorized by File No. 39,547.01 located 2,376 feet North and 2,088 feet West of the Southeast corner of Section 18, Township 18 South, Range 30 West, Lane County, Kansas, approximately 906 feet northeast of the presently authorized location. The water right owners propose to retain the presently authorized well as a standby well.
- 3. That the proposed primary well for File No. 20,460.01 does not meet well spacing requirements of K.A.R. 5-21-3(a) since it is located closer than 2,640 feet to the proposed existing standby well, two irrigation wells authorized by Water Right File No. 10,698 or to the stockwatering well authorized by Water Right, File No. 18,223.01. All wells in question are under common ownership.
- 4. That the Board of Directors of Western Kansas Groundwater Management District No. 1 has recommended approval of the application in a letter dated December 12, 2017 and a waiver of K.A.R. 5-21-3.
- 5. That the referenced application for File Nos. 20,460.01 should be approved with a waiver of the well spacing requirement of K.A.R. 5-21-3(a).
- 6. That a waiver of K.A.R. 5-21-3(a) will not prejudicially or unreasonably affect the public interest and should not impair any existing water rights.







As a matter of record, the Division of Water Resources has on hand a large number of applications awaiting processing. Therefore, to be fair to all concerned, and so that we can process those applications on hand in the order they were received, we intend to concentrate on the backlog of applications until the issue is resolved. You will be contacted regarding this application as soon as it has been examined.

In accordance with the provisions of the Kansas Water Appropriation Act, a portion of which is included below, the use of water prior to approval of the application is unlawful. You should not proceed and divert water as indicated by your plans in your application for a change for this file until you receive approval for this change from the Chief Engineer. Once approved, compliance with the terms, conditions and limitations of the permit is necessary. Conservation of the water resources of Kansas is required.

Section 82a-728 of the Kansas Water Appropriation Act, provides (a) except for the appropriation of water for the purpose of domestic use, . . . it shall be unlawful for any person to appropriate or threaten to appropriate water from any source without first applying for and obtaining a permit to appropriate water in accordance with the provisions of the Water Appropriation Act or for any person to violate any condition of a vested right, appropriation right or an approved application for a permit to appropriate water for beneficial use.

(b) (1) The violation of any provision of this section by any person is a class C misdemeanor... A class C misdemeanor is punishable by a fine not to exceed \$500 and/or a term of confinement not to exceed one month in the county jail. Each day that the violation occurs constitutes a separate offense.
