Kay Berghaus, Trustee, of the Dean Berghaus Living Trust and Kay Berghaus Living Trust, along with Marc and Jeanne Berghaus, Tereda Cook and Charles Jeffery Twist as owners submitted applications on September 24, 2018, to change the irrigated place of use. The signature of Charles Jeffery Twist was determined to be on behalf of Twist Family Farms, LLC per the documents submitted and Meade County register of Deeds. While the Twist signature does not appear to be needed after the division of File No. 13,158, resulting in their portion to be held separately under 13,158-D2, a portion of Section 30 is also authorized by File Nos. 3,149 and 28,580.

The referenced water rights appear to be in compliance with K.S.A. 82a-732 and the applications comply with K.A.R. 5-5-2a, with the updates to the ownership and addresses supplied by the applicants.

The referenced files are authorized separate portions with several complete and incomplete overlaps in place of use with a total of 1,473.51 acres authorized. The only additional limitation is on the rate of diversion under File No. 13,158-D1 that the rate is limited to 1,190 gallons per minute with File No. 3,149. Originally the apps proposed a total of 1,475.51 acres to be irrigated eliminating all incomplete overlaps, but with no acres that had not been authorized, but didn't take into account the base acres. The place of use will remain within what is currently authorized but eliminating the incomplete overlaps as there is no justification of K.A.R. 5-3-5n, *Authorized place of use*. Additionally, the division of File No. 13,185, will also eliminate a large incomplete overlap, allowing these separate owners to operate independently. The applications required a modification due to the referenced files base acres totaling 1,224.5 acres. A review of the base acres by Mike Meyer, Water Commissioner, Garden City Field Office determined 1,224.5 acres under File Nos. 3,149; 9,982; 13,158-D1; 14,309; 25,031; 28,580 & 30,950. As allowed per K.A.R. 5-5-11(b)(1), each right base acres can be increased ten acres or ten percent whichever is less as allowed. As four different base acres were developed that would allow ten acres to be added each was afforded its ten acres or a total of 1,264.5 acres to be proposed by the complete overlap of the referenced files.

The November 27, 2018, modifications to the applications by Kay Berghaus will propose a total of 1,264.02 acres authorized complying with K.A.R. 5-5-11, *Applications for change in place of use for irrigation purposes*. No increase in the consumptive should occur thus complying with K.A.R. 5-5-3, *Change in consumptive use*.


Historically the 1,473.51 acres developed an irrigation ration of 1.88 acre-foot per acre with the 2,778 acre-feet authorized by the referenced files. The change will result in an irrigation ratio of 2.20 acre-foot per acre. This exceeds the standard 2.00 acre-foot per acre as allowed by K.A.R. 5-3-23, *Maximum reasonable annual quantity approvable for irrigation use for an application for change in place of use and a request to reduce a water right*. To allow flexibility an additional limitation will be placed on File Nos. 25,031; 28,580 and 30,950 limiting the 2,778 acre-feet authorized to a maximum annual quantity of 2,528.04 acre-feet when combined with the senior files.

In a letter dated October 25, 2018, Jason Norquest, Assistant Manager, Southwest Kansas Groundwater Management District No. 3, recommend approval of the applications, if they complied with K.A.R. 5-5-11.

Michael Meyer, Water Commissioner of the Garden City Field Office area reviewed the proposed applications. In an email dated December 3, 2018, he recommended approval of the change applications.

Water flowmeters will be required for the change approvals. The water use correspondent will be updated to Kay Berghaus Living Trust for all of the referenced files. A check valve will be required, if chemigating. As no new wells will be drilled a water level measurement tube and WWC-5 will not be a condition of the approvals.

Based on the above discussion, that the change to the place of use authorized by all of the referenced files will make a complete overlap and not substantially increase the acres above what is currently authorized and with no increase in the historical consumptive use, it is recommended that the referenced applications be approved.

7. Respondent represents that it has made a good-faith effort to revise its operating and management procedures regarding the Water Right and that Respondent will comply fully with the KWAA and the related expectations of DWR going forward.
8. Respondent and DWR agree that the Penalty Order and the original sanctions imposed therein shall be modified as follows:
  - a. The assessed civil penalties are reduced from the sum of \$10,000, down to **\$1,000**.
  - b. The temporary reduction in the total authorized quantity for the Water Right for the 2019 calendar year is modified from a reduction of 255.012 acre-feet of water, to a reduction of 85.004 (i.e., a reduction of 1x the amount overpumped in 2017, instead of 3x). **Accordingly, for calendar year 2019 only, the total authorized quantity of water that may be diverted under the Water Right is a maximum of 26.996 acre-feet.**
  - c. **Before the end of 2018, Respondent shall cause an anti-reverse totalizing water flowmeter to be installed** on the subject well for the Water Right, which meter and its installation meets or exceeds specifications adopted by the Chief Engineer.
  - d. Any and all other provisions and sanctions provided in the Penalty Order and not modified herein or inconsistent with this Agreement are incorporated herein and shall remain in full force and effect.
9. Respondent agrees that for any future violations caused or allowed by Respondent regarding the Water Right, the violations alleged in the Penalty Order and stipulated, agreed, and admitted to herein shall be considered prior violations for the purpose of imposing any future sanctions against Respondent for any future violations concerning the Water Right.
10. Respondent represents that it understands the terms of this Agreement and that Respondent has had the opportunity to discuss this Agreement with a lawyer before signing it.
11. DWR expressly reserves and maintains the right, authority, and jurisdiction to enforce the terms of this Agreement.

#### **E. DUTIES OF RESPONDENT**

1. Respondent shall **fully execute and return this Agreement, along with payment of the modified civil penalties in the amount of \$1,000, within 14 days** from the day that DWR mails or otherwise transmits this Agreement to Respondent or its agent.
2. Respondent shall comply with all of the terms and conditions of this Agreement and with all provisions of the Penalty Order not modified herein or otherwise made inconsistent by this Agreement.



The Chief Engineer, Division of Water Resources, Kansas Department of Agriculture, after due consideration of the written application of Kay Berghaus, Trustee, of the Dean Berghaus Living Trust and Kay Berghaus Living Trust, PO Box 602, Meade, Kansas 67864, along with Marc and Jeanne Berghaus, PO Box 838, Meade, Kansas 67864, along with Charles Jeffery Twist on behalf of Twist Family Farms LLC, 130 Iroquois Road, Boulder, Colorado 80303-4214, and Teresa Cook, 12845 W. Hendryx Court, Wichita, Kansas 67235-1724, received in the office of the Chief Engineer on September 24, 2018, for approval of a change in the location of the place of use under the certificate of appropriation issued pursuant to the permit to appropriate water for beneficial use, finds that the change is reasonable and will not impair existing rights, and that the application should be and is hereby approved.

The quantity of water authorized under this water right is further limited to the quantity which combined with Water Right, File Nos. 3,149; 9,982; 13,158-D1; 14,309; 25,031 & 28,580, will provide a total not to exceed 2,528.04 acre-feet of water per calendar year.

The effective date of the change shall be the date this order is executed by the Chief Engineer, after which the authorized location of the place of use shall be:

located substantially as shown on the topographic map accompanying the application to change the place of use.

All diversion works into which any type of chemical or other foreign substance will be injected into the water pumped from the diversion works shall be equipped with an in-line, automatic, quick-closing check valve capable of preventing pollution of the source of the water supply. The type of valve installed shall meet specifications adopted by the Chief Engineer and shall be maintained in an operating condition satisfactory to the Chief Engineer.



The owners of the authorized place of use shall properly install an anti-reverse totalizing water flowmeter which meets or exceeds specifications adopted by the Chief Engineer and said meter shall be installed on the diversion works authorized under this water right, prior to the use of water, in strict accordance with the Kansas Administrative Regulations 5-1-4 through 5-1-12 adopted by the Chief Engineer. The water right owner shall notify the Chief Engineer when installation of the water meter has been completed. The water right owner shall maintain the water meter in an operating condition satisfactory to the Chief Engineer, at all times during diversion of water and shall maintain records from which the total quantity of water diverted may be determined. The water right owner shall also report the reading of said water meter and the total quantity of water diverted annually to the Chief Engineer. Such records shall be furnished to the Chief Engineer by March 1 following the end of each calendar year.

A seal shall be placed on the water flowmeter by the Division of Water Resources in such a manner as to render the meter non-removable from the measuring chamber without breaking the seal. If the seal is broken without the written permission of the chief engineer, this shall create a rebuttable presumption that the point of diversion had been unlawfully operated in violation of the order of the chief engineer and that the water right holder had been acting in violation of the conditions of his or her water right.

In all other respects, the Certificate of Appropriation issued pursuant to Approval of Application, File No. 30,950, for permit to appropriate water for beneficial use, is as stated and set forth in the Certificate of Appropriation dated June 4, 1987.

**RIGHT TO A HEARING AND TO ADMINISTRATIVE REVIEW**

If you are aggrieved by this Order, then pursuant to K.S.A. 82a-1901, you may:

- 1) request an evidentiary hearing before the Chief Engineer, or
- 2) request administrative review by the Secretary of Agriculture.

Failure to request an evidentiary hearing before the Chief Engineer does not preclude your right to administrative review by the Secretary.

To obtain an evidentiary hearing before the Chief Engineer, a written request for hearing must be filed within 15 days after service of this Order as provided in K.S.A. 77-531 (i.e., **within a total of 18 days after this Order was mailed to you**), with: Kansas Department of Agriculture, Attn: Legal Section, 1320 Research Park Drive, Manhattan, KS 66502, FAX (785) 564-6777.

If you do not file a request for an evidentiary hearing before the Chief Engineer, you may petition for administrative review of the Order by the Secretary of Agriculture. A petition for review shall be in writing and state the basis for requesting administrative review. The request for hearing may be denied if the request fails to clearly establish factual or legal issues for review. See K.S.A. 77-527. The petition must be filed within 30 days after service of this Order as provided in K.S.A. 77-531 (i.e., **within a total of 33 days after this Order was mailed to you**), and be filed with: Secretary of Agriculture, Attn: Legal Division, Kansas Department of Agriculture, 1320 Research Park Drive, Manhattan, KS 66502, FAX (785) 564-6777.

If neither a request for an evidentiary hearing nor a petition for administrative review is filed as set forth above, then this Order shall be effective and become a final agency action as defined in K.S.A. 77-607(b). Failure to timely request either an evidentiary hearing or administrative review may preclude further judicial review under the Kansas Judicial Review Act.
