**FROM:** Leslie Ireland **RE:** Water Right, File No. 23,956

Grant Morgan, Manager for Poky Feeders, Inc., and Greg Glunz, CEO, Fairleigh Corp., filed an application for approval to change the place of use and use made of water for operation as dual use from irrigation to irrigation and stockwatering. The application was received on February 8, 2021. The feedlot appears to need more water due to expansion of the feedlot.

The water right does not appear to be abandoned as per K.S.A. 82a-718, *Abandonment of water rights* and the right is in compliance with K.A.R. 82-732, *Annual water use report required; penalty for violations*. The application complies with K.A.R. 5-5-2a, *Complete change application*.

The owners are requesting a change in use made of water per K.A.R. 5-5-9, *Criteria for the approval of an application for a change in the use made of water from irrigation to any other type of beneficial use of water,* to authorize a limited "dual use" of irrigation and stockwatering This right is also requesting a change in place of use to add the stockwatering facility while maintaining the irrigated place of use.

File No. 23,956 authorizes two points of diversion each with assigned quantity and rate, for irrigation use on a two complete circle pivots with a total of 299.32 acres located in the South Half of Section 30, Township 20 South, Range 32 West, Scott County. There are no overlaps and no additional limitations. The East well is owned by Poky feeders who is requesting the change in use made of water with the consumptive use for the requested change applied specifically to their point in preparation for the division of the referenced file. The East Well is authorized 297 acre-feet (AF) but with the authorization of dual irrigation and stockwatering uses will be reduced. The consumptive use factor of 81.8 percent for Scott County allows a reduced quantity to be changed to another use.

While operated for dual use the quantity at the East well will be temporarily reduced to 243 AF (79.26 million gallons) per year (mgy), assuring compliance with K.A.R. 5-5-3, *Change in consumptive use*. The portion remaining for irrigation use remains as currently authorized.

The proposed 79.26 mgy authorized for stockwatering at the existing feedlot located in The place of use will authorize the existing stockwatering use located in the Southwest Quarter (SW  $\frac{1}{4}$ ) of Section 17, South Half (S $\frac{1}{2}$ ) Section 18, East Half Section 19, and a portion of the Southwest Quarter (SW  $\frac{1}{4}$ ) of Section 20, all in Township 20 South, Range 31 West, Scott County. This place of use was recently authorized by File Nos 8869 & 22,396 that resulted in The addition of the 215.87 AF (70.34 mgy) will result in 1,482.23 AF to be authorized under File Nos. 8630; 12,594; 13,938; 24,894; 26,218; 36,291; 36,292; 34,908; 9,488; 15,843; 8,869 & 22,398, providing 85% of the justified quantity for stockwatering use. As the authorized quantity for stockwatering will not permanently change in use made of water and will be operated at a reduced quantity the requested change complies with K.A.R. 5-5-3 *Change in consumptive use*.

As just one point of diversion is being changed and the quantity and rate are assigned, the change appears to comply with K.A.R. 5-5-9, a total change, and no rate test would be needed. The authorized rate of 1,280 gallons per minute is enough to divert the stockwatering and irrigation uses.

Should the total 243.24 AF (79.26 mgy) for stockwatering use be added to the existing stockwatering rights, a total of 562.225 mgy or 1,725.47 AF under all of files authorized for stockwatering use. This should help with the peak demands and will provide another point of diversion for stockwatering. A submitted stockwatering use supplemental sheet indicated a water budget of 1,742.59 AF for the combined stockwatering needs of this facility of beef feeder cattle and swine ranging from nursery to finishing stock. It appears the allotted quantity complies with K.A.R 5-3-22, *Maximum reasonable quantity of water for livestock and poultry*.

The irrigation portions will authorize the same acres as developed in the South Half of Section 30, Township 20 South Range 32 West, Scott County, Kansas. The East pivot will provide land for the Nutrient Management Plan for Poky Feeders. The minor reduction in irrigation quantity will still result in an irrigation ratio of 1.78 AF/acre. This appears to be reasonable for Scott County that has a net irrigation requirement of 1.33 AF/acre at the 80% change of rainfall per K.A.R. 5-5-12.

Frank Mercurio, Rural Resources Consulting LLC, who assisted with the owners with the application identified only one non-domestic well within one-half (½) mile of the well proposing to change. The owners of the well authorized by File Nos. 9,488-D2 and 40,072 were notified of by letter of the proposed change. No reply inquiry or comment was received. It appears the processing of the application follows K.S.A. 82a-1906.

A Compliance Investigation completed in 2021 determined the actual well locations. The well located in the Southwest Quarter is approximately 84 feet from authorized and the well in the Southeast Quarter is approximately 33 feet. The approval will update the feet distances of the SW well from 2,500 feet North and 4,360 feet West to 2,573 feet North and 4,318 feet West of the Southeast corner of Section 30. The well descriptors will be updated to show Lot 3 (NW¼ SW ¼). The well in the Southeast Quarter will be updated to

In a letter dated May 6, 2021, a copy of the application was sent to Kyle Spencer of Western Kansas Groundwater Management District No. 1 (GMD 1) along with a request to make a recommendation. In a letter dated May 10, 2021, GMD 1, recommended approval of the application.

Mike Meyer, Water Commissioner of the Garden City Field Office, indicated that he recommended approval of the application and temporary reduction, by email May 12, 2021.

Due to the penalty requiring the instillation of totalizing meters and seals the change approval will require the same conditions with a flow meter for each use authorized, pursuant to K.S.A. 82a-706c. A check valve will be required if chemigation occurs. The water use correspondents will remain as designated.

Based on the above discussion, that the change is reasonable, consumptive use will not increase, impairment of existing water rights is unlikely, and that no change in the local source of supply will occur, it is recommended that the referenced application for change be approved.

# APPROVAL OF APPLICATION FOR CHANGE IN PLACE OF USE USE MADE OF WATER ORDER IN THE MATTER OF THE AUTHORIZED QUANTITY OF WATER AND ORDER BETTER DESCRIBING THE AUTHORIZED POINTS OF DIVERSION WATER RIGHT FILE NO. 23,956

The Chief Engineer, Division of Water Resources, Kansas Department of Agriculture, after due consideration of the written application of Greg Glunz, CEO, Fairleigh Corporation, 207 E. Bellevue, PO Box 560, Scott City, Kansas 67871 and Grant Morgan, Manager, Poky Feeders Incorporated, 600 East Road 30, Scott City, Kansas, 67871, received in this office on February 8, 2021, for approval of a change in the location of the place of use and use made of water under the certificate of appropriation issued pursuant to the permit to appropriate water for beneficial use, finds that the change is reasonable and will not impair existing rights, and that the application should be and is hereby approved.

The authorized quantity of water under this right will remain 592 acre-feet (192.904 million gallons). This order effectively limits the authorized quantity of water to 538 acre-feet (175.308 million gallons) per calendar year for both stockwatering and irrigation uses combined. That the limitation on the quantity of water shall exist until such a time that the quantity of water for stockwatering use authorized by this approval is no longer required.

The effective date of the change shall be the date this order is executed by the Chief Engineer, after which the portion authorized for both irrigation and stockwatering uses shall be authorized from the following dual use point of diversion:

one (1) well located in Northeast Quarter of the Southwest Quarter of the Southeast Quarter (NE½ SW½ SE½) of Section 30, more particularly described as being near a point 796 feet North and 1,371 feet West of the Southeast corner of said section, in a quantity not to exceed to 297 acre-feet (96.778 million gallons) per calendar year at a rate of diversion not in excess of 1,280 gallons per minute (2.85 c.f.s), further limited to a quantity not to exceed 243 acre-feet (79.182 million gallons) per calendar year for both stockwatering and irrigation uses combined,

in Township 20 South, Range 32 West, Scott County, Kansas,

and the point of diversion to remain authorized solely for irrigation use shall be:

one (1) well located in Lot 3 (NW¼ SW¼) of Section 30, more particularly described as being near a point 2,573 feet North and 4,318 feet West of the Southeast corner of said section, in a quantity not to exceed to 295 acre-feet (91.126 million gallons) per calendar year at a rate of diversion not in excess of 1,310 gallons per minute (2.92 c.f.s),

the portion changed to stockwatering shall authorize the place of use at the location described as being:

the Southwest Quarter (SW½) of Section 8, the Southwest Quarter (SW½) of Section 17, the South Half (S½) of Section 18, the East Half (E½) of Section 19, and the West Half of the Southwest Quarter (W½ SW½) of Section 20, all in Township 20 South, Range 32 West, Scott County, Kansas,

all located substantially as shown on the map accompanying the application to change the place of use and use made of water.

All diversion works into which any type of chemical or other foreign substance will be injected into the water pumped from the diversion works shall be equipped with an in-line, automatic, quick-closing check valve capable of preventing pollution of the source of the water supply. The type of valve installed shall meet specifications adopted by the Chief Engineer and shall be maintained in an operating condition satisfactory to the Chief Engineer.

The owners of the authorized place of use shall properly install an anti-reverse totalizing water flowmeter which meets or exceeds specifications adopted by the Chief Engineer and said meter shall be installed on the diversion works authorized under this water right, prior to the use of water, in strict accordance with the Kansas Administrative Regulations 5-1-4 through 5-1-12 adopted by the Chief Engineer. The water right owner shall notify the Chief Engineer when installation of the water meter has been completed. The water right owner shall maintain the water meter in an operating condition satisfactory to the Chief Engineer, at all times during diversion of water and shall maintain records from which the total quantity of water diverted may be determined. The water right owner shall also report the reading of said water meter and the total quantity of water diverted annually to the Chief Engineer. Such records shall be furnished to the Chief Engineer by March 1 following the end of each calendar year.

A seal shall be placed on the water flowmeter by the Division of Water Resources in such a manner as to render the meter non-removable from the measuring chamber without breaking the seal. If the seal is broken without the written permission of the Chief Engineer, this shall create a rebuttable presumption that the point of diversion had been unlawfully operated in violation of the order of the Chief Engineer and that the water right holder had been acting in violation of the conditions of his or her water right.

In all other respects, the Certificate of Appropriation issued pursuant to Approval of Application, File No. 23,956, for permit to appropriate water for beneficial use, is as stated and set forth in the Certificate of Appropriation dated June 21, 1982.

## RIGHT TO A HEARING AND TO ADMINISTRATIVE REVIEW

If you are aggrieved by this Order, then pursuant to K.S.A. 82a-1901, you may:

- 1) request an evidentiary hearing before the Chief Engineer, or
- 2) request administrative review by the Secretary of Agriculture.

Failure to request an evidentiary hearing before the Chief Engineer does not preclude your right to administrative review by the Secretary.

To obtain an evidentiary hearing before the Chief Engineer, a written request for hearing must be filed within 15 days after service of this Order as provided in K.S.A. 77-531 (i.e., within a total of 18 days after this Order was mailed to you), with the Kansas Department of Agriculture, Attn: Legal Section, 1320 Research Park Drive, Manhattan, Kansas 66502, or by FAX (785) 564-6777.

If you do not file a request for an evidentiary hearing before the Chief Engineer, you may petition for administrative review of the Order by the Secretary of Agriculture. A petition for review shall be in writing and state the basis for requesting administrative review. The request for review may be denied if the request fails to clearly establish factual or legal issues for review. See K.S.A. 77-527. The petition must be filed within 30 days after service of this Order as provided in K.S.A. 77-531 (i.e., within a total of 33 days after this Order was mailed to you), and be filed with the Secretary of Agriculture, Attn: Legal Division, Kansas Department of Agriculture, 1320 Research Park Drive, Manhattan, Kansas 66502, or by FAX (785) 564-6777.

If neither a request for an evidentiary hearing nor a petition for administrative review is filed as set forth above, then this Order shall be effective and become a final agency action as defined in K.S.A. 77-607(b). Failure to timely request either an evidentiary hearing or administrative review may preclude further judicial review under the Kansas Judicial Review Act.

Any request for hearing or petition for administrative review shall be in writing and shall be submitted to the attention of: Chief Legal Counsel, Kansas Department of Agriculture, 1320 Research Park Drive, Manhattan, Kansas 66502, Fax: (785) 564 - 6777.
