**FROM:** Leslie Ireland **RE:** Water Right, File No. 6,193

Nathan and Sarah Kells along with Vance Kells all on behalf of Circle Bar Heifer Ranch LLC as owners of the referenced right have filed an application for approval to change the point of diversion authorized for stockwatering use, while the irrigation portion of the referenced file will remain unchanged. The application for change was received in the office of the Chief Engineer on January 22, 2021.

The referenced water right is considered not to be abandoned as per K.S.A. 82a-718 and also appears to comply with K.S.A. 82a-732. The application appears to comply with K.A.R. 5-5-1a and is complete. It appears the requirements of K.S.A. 82a-1906 were met with the notification of the owners of File No. 17,862. No comments were received.

The change in point of diversion application appears to comply with part (e)(1) of K.A.R. 5-5-1, Filing an application for change and is also in compliance with K.A.R. 5-5-2a, *Complete change application*. The referenced file is authorized dual use as irrigation and stockwatering is limited 638 acre-feet (208.04 million gallons) per year with a maximum rate of 1,615 gallons per minute(gpm), but was developed as 752 acre-feet for irrigation use from the well located in the NW½ SE½ SW¼ of Section 19, approximately 2,098 feet North and 3,735 feet West of the Southeast corner in Township 27 South, Range 33 West, Haskell County (19-27-33W). A Compliance Investigation completed January 28, 2021, determined the actual location to be 2,152 feet North and 3,601 feet West of the Southeast corner, approximately 145 feet from the authorized and remaining in the NW½ SE½ SW¼ of the section.

The applicants are proposing to add a standby well for the stockwatering use by authorizing the existing irrigation well authorized by File No. 12,520, located approximately 1,420 feet to the South and described as being located in the NW¼ SE¼ SW¼ approximately 680 feet North and 3,498 feet West of the Southeast corner of 19-27-33W. A Compliance Investigation completed November 2018, determined the actual location to be 689 feet North and 3,586 feet West of the Southeast corner of 19-27-33W and remaining in the NW¼ SE¼ SW¼. This location will be updated by separate Memo & Order. The stockwatering use has been authorized by Term Permits, File Nos. 20179057 & 20199002 providing an authorized 65.17 mgy for the currently authorized stockwatering.

The source of supply for the currently authorized point of diversion has been determined to be the Ogallala Formation (Code 211) and the Dakota Formation (Code 331). The proposed standby well source of supply is indicated by WRIS to be the Tertiary System (Code 200) the Ogallala Formation (Code 211) and the Dakota Formation (Code 331). It appears the standby well is in the same local source of supply.

According to the application map and WRIS, the only other well within one-half (½) mile of the proposed standby well is the irrigation well under File No. 17,862. The nearby well owner was notified by a letter dated September 29, 2021; no response has been received as of today's date.

RE: File No. 6,193

In a letter dated April 30, 2021, Jason Norquest, Assistant Manager of Southwest Kansas Groundwater Management District No. 3, indicated the District stated the proposed change is reasonable due in part to the Term Permits and the standby well will operate only then the primary well is unable to operate. The District recommended approval of the application with the standby status and metering by use.

In an e-mail dated October 7, 2021, Michael Meyer, Water Commissioner of the Garden City Field Office, recommended approval of the referenced application with the primary well location updated and the addition of the standby well.

Water flow meters on the standby well and primary well will be required for each use also the wells will required to have a check valve if any chemical or foreign substance is injected into the water through the diversion works according to K.A.R. 5-3-5(c). A water level measurement tube will not be required. A notice of completion will be required for the standby well that will be authorized. The standby well will also be restricted to be operated only when the primary is inoperable as required by K.A.R. 5-1-2, *Standby well*.

Based on the above discussion, that the change is reasonable, that impairment to existing water rights is unlikely, and that no change in the local source of supply will occur, it has been recommended that the referenced application be approved.

Any use of water that is not as authorized by the water right or permit to authorize water <u>before</u> the chief engineer approves this application is a violation of the Kansas Water Appropriation Act for which criminal or civil penalties may be assessed. Such violation is a class C misdemeanor, punishable by a fine not to exceed \$500 and/or a term of confinement not to exceed one month in the county jail. K.S.A. 82a-728(b). Civil penalties shall be not less than \$100 nor more than \$1,000 per violation. In the case of a continuing violation, each day such violation continues may be deemed a separate violation. In addition to these penalties the water right may be modified or suspended. K.S.A. 82a-737, as amended.



### APPROVAL OF APPLICATION FOR CHANGE IN POINT OF DIVERSION WATER RIGHT FILE NO. 6,193

The Chief Engineer, Division of Water Resources, Kansas Department of Agriculture, after due consideration of the written application of Nathan and Sarah Kells, and Vance Kells, Circle Bar Heifer Ranch, L.L.C., 842 Road 60, Satanta, Kansas 67870, received in this office on January 22, 2021, for approval of a change in the point of diversion under the certificate of appropriation issued pursuant to the application for permit to appropriate water for beneficial use, as modified and amended by the Order of the Chief Engineer dated May 9, 1994, approving the application to change the place of use, the Findings and Order of the Chief Engineer dated May 30, 2007, reducing the authorized quantity and place of use and removing an additional quantity limitation, and by the Order of the Chief Engineer dated July 22, 2019, approving the application to change the point of diversion, and by the Order of the Chief Engineer dated September 17, 2019, approving the application to change the place of use and use made of water, finds that the change is reasonable and will not impair existing rights and that the application should be and is hereby approved.

The authorized quantity under this water right will remain 752 acre-feet (245.04 million gallons). This order effectively limits the authorized quantity of water to 638.45 acre-feet (208.04 million gallons) per calendar year for both stockwatering and irrigation uses combined. That the limitation on the quantity of water shall exist until such a time that the quantity of water for stockwatering use authorized by the September 17, 2019, approval is no longer required.

The effective date of the change shall be the date this order is executed by the Chief Engineer, after which the authorized locations of the points of diversion for stockwatering use shall be;

one (1) well located well in the Northwest Quarter of the Southeast Quarter of the Southwest Quarter (NW¼ SE¼ SW¼) of Section 19, more particularly described as being near a point 689 feet North and 3,586 feet West of the Southeast corner of said section, to be used as a standby well, and

one (1) well located in the Northwest Quarter of the Northeast Quarter of the Southwest Quarter (NW¼ NE¼ SW¼) of Section 19, more particularly described as being near a point 2,152 feet North and 3,601 feet West of the Southeast corner of said section, to be used as a primary well,

both in Township 27 South, Range 33 West, Haskell County, Kansas,

and the location of the authorized point of diversion for irrigation use shall be:

one (1) well located in the Northwest Quarter of the Northeast Quarter of the Southwest Quarter (NW¼ NE¼ SW¼) of Section 19, more particularly described as being near a point 2,152 feet North and 3,601 feet West of the Southeast corner of said section,

all in Township 27 South, Range 33 West, Haskell County, Kansas,

located substantially as shown on the map accompanying the application to change the point of diversion.

RE: Water Right, File No. 6,193

The well described herein as the standby well shall be used exclusively at such time the well herein described as the primary well is inoperable due to mechanical, maintenance or power failure. Use of the standby well under these limiting conditions does not allow the authorized quantity of water or rate of diversion under this file to be exceeded.

Installation of the works for diversion of water shall be completed on or before December 31, 2021, or within any authorized extension of time. The water right owner shall notify the Chief Engineer of the Division of Water Resources, Kansas Department of Agriculture, when construction of the works for diversion has been completed.

All diversion works into which any type of chemical or other foreign substance will be injected into the water pumped from the diversion works shall be equipped with an in-line, automatic, quick-closing check valve capable of preventing pollution of the source of the water supply. The type of valve installed shall meet specifications adopted by the Chief Engineer and shall be maintained in an operating condition satisfactory to the Chief Engineer.

The water right owner shall properly install a separate acceptable water meter for each use made of water for the diversion works authorized under this water right, prior to the use of water, in strict accordance with the Kansas Administrative Regulations 5-1-4 through 5-1-12 adopted by the Chief Engineer. The water right owner shall notify the Chief Engineer when installation of the water meters has been completed. The water right owner shall maintain the water meters in an operating condition satisfactory to the Chief Engineer, at all times during diversion of water and shall maintain records from which the total quantity of water diverted for irrigation and stockwatering use may be determined. The water right owner shall also report the reading of said water meters and the total quantity of water diverted annually to the Chief Engineer. Such records shall be furnished to the Chief Engineer by March 1 following the end of each calendar year.

In all other respects, the Certificate of Appropriation issued pursuant to Approval of Application, File No. 6,193, for permit to appropriate water for beneficial use, is as stated and set forth in the Certificate of Appropriation dated May 7, 1994, as modified and amended by the aforementioned orders.

### RIGHT TO A HEARING AND TO ADMINISTRATIVE REVIEW

If you are aggrieved by this Order, then pursuant to K.S.A. 82a-1901, you may:

- 1) request an evidentiary hearing before the Chief Engineer, or
- 2) request administrative review by the Secretary of Agriculture.

Failure to request an evidentiary hearing before the Chief Engineer does not preclude your right to administrative review by the Secretary.

To obtain an evidentiary hearing before the Chief Engineer, a written request for hearing must be filed within 15 days after service of this Order as provided in K.S.A. 77-531 (i.e., within a total of 18 days after this Order was mailed to you), with the Kansas Department of Agriculture, Attn: Legal Section, 1320 Research Park Drive, Manhattan, Kansas 66502, or by FAX (785) 564-6777.

If you do not file a request for an evidentiary hearing before the Chief Engineer, you may petition for administrative review of the Order by the Secretary of Agriculture. A petition for review shall be in writing and state the basis for requesting administrative review. The request for review may be denied if the request fails to clearly establish factual or legal issues for review. See K.S.A. 77-527. The petition must be filed within 30 days after service of this Order as provided in K.S.A. 77-531 (i.e., within a total of 33 days after this Order was mailed to you), and be filed with the Secretary of Agriculture, Attn: Legal Division, Kansas Department of Agriculture, 1320 Research Park Drive, Manhattan, Kansas 66502, or by FAX (785) 564-6777.

If neither a request for an evidentiary hearing nor a petition for administrative review is filed as set forth above, then this Order shall be effective and become a final agency action as defined in K.S.A. 77-607(b). Failure to timely request either an evidentiary hearing or administrative review may preclude further judicial review under the Kansas Judicial Review Act.
