<u>MEMORANDUM</u>

Satanta Farms LLC as owner of File Nos. 14492 & 16882, have submitted applications for approval to change the use made of water from irrigation use to irrigation and stockwatering use and to change their place of use. The applications were received on July 14, 2021.

The referenced files appear to be in good standing, as per K.S.A. 82a-718 and 82a-732. The applications comply with K.A.R. 5-5-2a, *Complete change application*.

Water Right, File No. <u>14492</u>, authorizes one (1) well to divert 640 acre-feet (AF) at a maximum rate of 900 gallons per minute (gpm) (2.00 c.f.s). The well is located in the Southeast Quarter of the Northwest Quarter of the Southwest Quarter (SE½ NW¼ SW¼) of Section 4, Township 28 South, Range 33 West, Haskell County, Kansas, located in the Arkansas River Basin. The place of use is 320 irrigated acres in the South Half of Section 4, Township 28 South, Range 33 West, Greeley County. There are no overlaps to the irrigation place of use. The proposed place of use for the stockwater portion is a feedlot located in the West Half (W½) of Section 9, Township 28 South, Range 33 West, Haskell County. Water Right File Nos. 14091; 16955; 23410; 34236; 34553 and 34554 currently overlap the stockwater place of use. The right is not located in a special use area but is located in the Southwest Kansas Groundwater Management District No. 3, (GMD 3). The source of supply for this right has been determined to be the Ogallala Formation / Unconfined Dakota Formation (Code 211 / 331).

The water right owner proposes a dual use of water that will allow them to retain the original 640 acre-feet for irrigation but will limit the total annual use to 543.36 acre-feet in any year when water is used for stockwatering during the duration of the dual use stockwater/irrigation dual use permit. Should the stockwatering use ever cease, the applicant will request to revert back to irrigation for the full original quantity of 640 acre-feet. The temporary reduced quantity is based on K.A.R. 5-5-9 calculation. The irrigation place of use will not change.

Water Right, File No. <u>16882</u>, authorizes one (1) well to divert 412 acre-feet (AF) at a maximum rate of 1275 gallons per minute (gpm) (2.84 c.f.s). The well is located in the Southeast Quarter of the Northwest Quarter of the Southeast Quarter (SE½ NW½ SE½) of Section 4, Township 28 South, Range 33 West, Haskell County, Kansas, located in the Arkansas River Basin. The place of use is 940.54 irrigated acres in Sections 8 and 9, both in Township 28 South, Range 33 West, Haskell County. Water Right, File Nos. 16882; 18659; 23409; 23410 and 31093 overlap the irrigation place of use. The proposed place of use for the stockwater portion is a feedlot located in the West Half (W½) of Section 9, Township 28 South, Range 33 West, Haskell County. Water Right File Nos. 14091; 16955; 23410; 34236; 34553 and 34554 currently overlap the stockwater place of use. The right is not located in a special use area but is located in the Southwest Kansas Groundwater Management District No. 3, (GMD 3). The source of supply for this right has been determined to be the Ogallala Formation / Unconfined Dakota Formation (Code 211 / 331). Irrigated place of use in Section 8 is owned by F&E Cox

Formation / Unconfined Dakota Formation (Code 211 / 331). Irrigated place of use in Section 8 is owned by F&E Cox Farms but is reserved from the WR. li/dwr

The water right owner proposes a dual use of water that will allow them to retain the original 412 acre-feet for irrigation but will limit the total annual use to 349.788 acre-feet in any year when water is used for stockwatering during the duration of the dual use stockwater/irrigation dual use permit. Should the stockwatering use ever cease, the applicant will request to revert back to irrigation for the full original quantity of 412 acre-feet. The temporary reduced quantity is based on K.A.R. 5-5-9 calculation. The irrigation place of use will not change.

Under File Nos. 14492 & 16882, the change in use made of water from irrigation to stockwater/irrigation complies with K.A.R. 5-5-3, Change in consumptive use with the stated temporary reduction in quantity.

File No. 16882 *There is one (1) well located within one-half (½ mile) of the proposed existing wells which are not owned by the applicant. Nearby notification letter was sent out on February 21, 2022. There was no response of any kind as of todays date.

In a letter dated March 11, 2022, Jason Norquest, Assistant Manager of Southwest Kansas Groundwater Management District No. 3 recommended approval of the applications.

Mike Meyer, Water Commissioner, Garden City Field Office was contacted for a comment on the proposed change. He recommended approval of the proposed change per his email dated March 28, 2022.

Conditions of the approval will require the installation of a water flowmeters for each use and check valves if anything is injected into the water through the diversion works according to K.A.R.5-3-5(c), *Check valves*. Water level measurement tubes and WWC-5 information are not applicable to the changes.

Based on the above discussion, it appears the requested changes are not unreasonable, will not result in an increase in consumptive use, impairment of existing rights unlikely, and the source of supply will remain the same, it is recommended that the referenced applications be approved.

The Chief Engineer, Division of Water Resources, Kansas Department of Agriculture, after due consideration of the written application of William L Graham, Vice-President, Satanta Farms LLC, PO Box 15568, Amarillo, Texas 79101-5568 and Donald Gales, Chairman and Chief Executive Officer, Friona Industries LP, 500 S. Taylor, Suite 601, Amarillo, Texas 79101, received in this office on July 14, 2021, for approval of a change in the use made of water and location of the place of use under the certificate of appropriation issued pursuant to the application for permit to appropriate water for beneficial use, as modified and amended by the Order of the Chief Engineer dated January 5, 2015, determining the authorized place of use, and dated September 13, 2021, approving the application to change the point of diversion, finds that the changes are reasonable and will not impair existing rights, that the changes relate to the same local source of supply and that the application should be and is hereby approved.

The authorized quantity of water under this right will remain 412 acre-feet (134.25 million gallons). This order effectively limits the authorized quantity of water to 349.788 acre-feet (113.978 million gallons) per calendar year for both stockwatering and irrigation uses combined. That the limitation on the quantity of water shall exist until such a time that the quantity of water for stockwatering use authorized by this approval is no longer required.

The effective date of the change shall be the date this order is executed by the Chief Engineer, after which the authorized quantity for dual use as irrigation and stockwatering use shall be:

one (1) well located in the Southeast Quarter of the Northwest Quarter of the Southeast Quarter (SE½ NW½ SE½) of Section 4, more particularly described as being near a point 1,475 feet North and 1,629 feet West of the Southeast corner of said section, in Township 28 South, Range 33 West, Haskell County, Kansas at a quantity not to exceed to 349.788 acre-feet (113.978 million gallons) per calendar year at a rate of diversion not in excess of 1,275 gallons per minute (2.84 c.f.s), for both stockwatering and irrigation uses combined.

The authorized location of the place of use for irrigation use shall be:

a total of 940.54 acres in Sections 8 and 9, both in Township 28 South, Range 33 West, Haskell County, Kansas and the place of use authorized for stockwater use shall be:

a feedlot located in the West Half (W½) of Section 9, Township 28 South, Range 33 West, Haskell County Kansas,

all located substantially as shown on the topographic map accompanying the application to change the use made of water and place of use.

The water right owner shall properly install a separate acceptable water meter for each use made of water for the diversion works authorized under this water right, prior to the use of water, in strict accordance with the Kansas Administrative Regulations 5-1-4 through 5-1-12 adopted by the Chief Engineer. The water right owner shall notify the Chief Engineer when installation of the water meter has been completed. The water right owner shall maintain the water meter in an operating condition satisfactory to the Chief Engineer, at all times during diversion of water and shall maintain records from which the total quantity of water diverted for irrigation and stockwatering use may be determined. The water right owner shall also report the reading of said water meter and the total quantity of water diverted annually to the Chief Engineer. Such records shall be furnished to the Chief Engineer by March 1 following the end of each calendar year.

All diversion works into which any type of chemical or other foreign substance will be injected into the water pumped from the diversion works shall be equipped with an in-line, automatic, quick-closing check valve capable of preventing pollution of the source of the water supply. The type of valve installed shall meet specifications adopted by the Chief Engineer and shall be maintained in an operating condition satisfactory to the Chief Engineer.

In all other respects, the Certificate of Appropriation issued pursuant to Approval of Application, File No. 16,882, for permit to appropriate water for beneficial use, is as stated and set forth in the Certificate of Appropriation dated August 30, 1983, as modified and amended by the aforementioned orders.

RIGHT TO A HEARING AND TO ADMINISTRATIVE REVIEW

If you are aggrieved by this Order, then pursuant to K.S.A. 82a-1901, you may:

- 1) request an evidentiary hearing before the Chief Engineer, or
- 2) request administrative review by the Secretary of Agriculture.

Failure to request an evidentiary hearing before the Chief Engineer does not preclude your right to administrative review by the Secretary.

To obtain an evidentiary hearing before the Chief Engineer, a written request for hearing must be filed within 15 days after service of this Order as provided in K.S.A. 77-531 (i.e., within a total of 18 days after this Order was mailed to you), with: Kansas Department of Agriculture, Attn: Legal Section, 1320 Research Park Drive, Manhattan, KS 66502, FAX (785) 564-6777.

If you do not file a request for an evidentiary hearing before the Chief Engineer, you may petition for administrative review of the Order by the Secretary of Agriculture. A petition for review shall be in writing and state the basis for requesting administrative review. The request for hearing may be denied if the request fails to clearly establish factual or legal issues for review. See K.S.A. 77-527. The petition must be filed within 30 days after service of this Order as provided in K.S.A. 77-531 (i.e., within a total of 33 days after this Order was mailed to you), and be filed with: Secretary of Agriculture, Attn: Legal Division, Kansas Department of Agriculture, 1320 Research Park Drive, Manhattan, KS 66502, FAX (785) 564-6777.

If neither a request for an evidentiary hearing nor a petition for administrative review is filed as set forth above, then this Order shall be effective and become a final agency action as defined in K.S.A. 77-607(b). Failure to timely request either an evidentiary hearing or administrative review may preclude further judicial review under the Kansas Judicial Review Act.

Any request for hearing or petition for administrative review shall be in writing and shall be submitted to the attention of: Chief Legal Counsel, Kansas Department of Agriculture, 1320 Research Park Drive, Manhattan, Kansas 66502, Fax: (785) 564 – 6777.
