RE: Water Right, File No. 21,921

Scott & Trudy K Reiss submitted an application to change in point of diversion. The application for this irrigation right was received on March 14, 2022.

The referenced file was found to be in good standing, as per K.S.A. 82a-718 and 82a-732. The change is proposed to add an additional well per K.A.R. 5- 5-16 in the Crooked Creek Basin, Seward County and in the Southwest Kansas Groundwater Management District No. 3 (GMD 3).

Water Right, File No. 21,921 authorizes one (1) well at a rate of 2,000 gallons per minute and a quantity of 750 acre-feet (AF) for the irrigation of 408 acres, all in Section 34, Township 31, Range 31 West. The point of diversion and place of use have no overlaps. The source of supply for the well has been determined to be the Ogallala Formation, (Code 211).

A June 8, 2022, letter by me, informed the applicant the application would need updating to bring the application into compliance with the additional well regulation, specifically the rate test completed by GMD3 may need to be redone, the quantity will need to be reduced to 628.6 AF and reassigned to the proposed wells. All owners would need to sign as it appears a Wanda Mae Reiss, Reiss Family Investment LLC is an owner and did not sign the application. The applicant was requested to contact the Garden City Field office or the GMD for assistance and return the updated application by July 19, 2022

On July 19, 2022 after discussing the application by phone with Scott Reiss, and extension was granted to August 19, 2022, to return the application for further processing. Additionally, the application was reviewed with Michael Meyer, Water Commissioner Garden City, (GCFO) to coordinate a new rate test and the needed updates to the application. After discussion of the original rate test a new test would be needed as the GMD test was not acceptable as the well was surging during the test.

On August 15, 2022. the applicant submitted via email additional deed information per a 2007 deed received on August 15, 2022. In an August 18, 2022, reply email acknowledged the receipt of the deed and he was requested to sign on behalf of the LLC, should he have the authority to do so. The email also afforded an extension to August 31, 2022 to return the application to the Manhattan office.

It appears the applicant did not contact the GCFO nor was the application returned.

It appears the March 14, 2022, application to change the point of diversion for File No. 21,921, should be dismissed and its priority forfeited for failure to return the application with the requested information.

### FINDINGS AND ORDER IN THE MATTER OF THE DISMISSAL OF APPLICATION FOR APPROVAL TO CHANGE THE AUTHORIZED POINT OF DIVERSION UNDER WATER RIGHT, FILE NO. 21,921

After due consideration, the Chief Engineer, Division of Water Resources, Kansas Department of Agriculture (hereinafter referred to as the "Chief Engineer"), makes the following findings and order:

# FINDINGS

- 1. That on July 18, 1988, the Chief Engineer in accordance with K.S.A. 82a-714, issued a Certificate of Appropriation pursuant to Water Right, File No. 21,921, for permit to appropriate water for irrigation use.
- 2. That on March 14, 2022, an Application for Approval to Change the Authorized Point of Diversion Under an Existing Water Right, (Application) was receive by the Division of Water Resources, (DWR), Office of the Chief Engineer under the water right descried in paragraph No. 1 of these findings.
- 3. That in a letter dated June 8, 2022, DWR returned the Application and informed the applicant, the Application as proposed, would need to be updated to comply with K.A.R. 5- 5-16, *Additional well* and to supply additional information, modify and return the application or request additional time in which to provide information prior to the Application being submitted to the Chief Engineer for final action.
- 4. That on August 18, 2022, further action on the Application was delayed until August 31, 2022, to allow the applicant to return the application and supply additional information to render the Application complete per K.A.R. 5- 5-2a, *Complete change application*.
- 5. That no additional information or written correspondence regarding the Application has been submitted to DWR, nor has the applicant requested additional time to supply information to DWR prior to the extended deadline of August 31, 2022.

6. The Application for File No. 21,921 should be dismissed, and its priority forfeited in accordance with the requirements of K.S.A. 82a-708b(a) and K.A.R. 5-3-4c of the Kansas Water Appropriation Act.

#### ORDER

NOW, THEREFORE, It is the decision and order of the Chief Engineer, Division of Water Resources, Kansas Department of Agriculture, that effective the date of this order, in accordance with the law, the Application for Approval to Change the Point of Diversion Under an Existing Water Right, File No. 21,921, received on March 14, 2022, is herewith dismissed and the priority assigned to it is considered to be forfeited.

In all other respects, the Certificate of Appropriation for Beneficial Use of Water, issued pursuant to File No. 21,921, dated July 18, 1988, remains as authorized, as modified and amended by the order of the Chief Engineer dated January 29, 2018.

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
