### MEMORANDUM

On April 4, 2022, applications to change the irrigated place of use located in Bear Creek Basin were submitted for the referenced files with a reduction request for File No. 88. The representatives of the A.K. Coral Cay Family Trust stated as E.J. DeGroot and Kathleen R. DeGroot as Co-Trustees along with the June 30, 2022 signature of Todd Wycoff President of the Board of Trustees of the Saint John Lodge of the Independent Order of Odd Fellows Lodge No. 539, all as owners have signed the applications. Quit claim deeds by Manfred Quentel, Manager, Quentel Ranches, LLC and Zachary T. Gale on behalf of E Z FARMS, LLC and Brenda Westeman along with Boyd and Michelle Westeman were submitted with the applications.

The reduction request lists the Johnson COOP with the reference of surface owner no water right ownership. My review couldn't find they owned a portion of any of the currently authorized place of use per the ORKA records or WRIS. A signature on behalf of the Johnson COOP was not submitted with the request, but it appears a signature or quit claim are also not needed.

File No. 88 authorizes the irrigation of 890 acres with 1,780 acre-feet (AF) at a maximum rate of 3,815 gallons per minute. The reduction request proposes to reduce the irrigated acres to 623.5 acres and the quantity to 1,247 acre-feet. This will remove the place of use overlap with File No. 15,731 and affording the removal of the quantity limitation of 533 AF with File No. 88, on the junior file. The requested reduction appears to comply with K.A.R. 5-3-23, Maximum reasonable annual quantity approvable for irrigation use for an application for change in place of use and a request to reduce a water right. The reduction will result in the A.K. Coral Cay Family Trust owning 401.5 acres and the S. John Lodge of the Independent Order of Odd Fellows Lodge No. 539 owning 222 acres, a total of 623.5 acres, all in Sections 10, 11,12 & 14, Township 26 South, Range 42 West, Hamilton County.

The referenced water rights are considered in compliance with both K.S.A. 82a-718 and K.S.A. 82a-732. As required by K.S.A. 82a-1906, with the changes proposing new acres added the identified nearby well owner was informed by letter dated August 1, 2022. No comment was received.

<u>File No. 88</u> developed 890 "base acres" per K.A.R. 5- 5-11, the requested reduction to 623.5 acres will reduce the base acres to 623.5 acres per the standard practice and is representative of the requested reduction in quantity to 1,247 acre-feet. The change proposes to retain acres in Sections 10, 11 & 14 with acres added in the North Half of Section 2, all totaling 623.5 acres.

The change application evaluated according to part (b)(1) of K.A.R. 5-5-11(b) *Applications* for change in places of use for irrigation purposes, found there will be no net increase in authorized acres above the reduced base acres. The change appears to comply with K.A.R. 5-5-3, Change in consumptive use. The 1,247 AF will provide 2 AF per acre which complies with K.A.R. 5-3-19, *Maximum reasonable annual quantity of water for irrigation use*.

The land between the noncontiguous acres and the points of diversion are owned by Cay Trust, so it appears no easements would be needed. The reduced 1,247 AF at a rate of 3,815 gallons per minute can be diverted from two wells located in the NW¼ SW¼ SE¼ or the NE¼ NW¼ SE¼ of Section 10. The well locations will have the feet distances updated to 824 feet North

and 2,570 feet West (ID5) and 1,665 feet North and 2,586 feet West. Both updates are less than 300 feet and appear to comply with K.A.R. 5-5-6, *Failure to construct diversion works at authorized location*.

<u>File No. 15,731</u> authorizes the irrigation of 266.5 acres with 532 acre-feet (AF) with the additional limitation with File No. 88. The reduction in quantity to File No. 88 will afford the additional limitation on the quantity to be removed. The base acres were determined to be 266.5 acres with irrigation occurring in Sections 11, 12 and 14. The proposal is to remove the irrigation of the acres in Section 12. The applicant requests two(2) pivots to be authorized. One in the Southwest Quarter

(SW½) of Section 11 and one in the Northeast Quarter (NE½) of Section 14, all in Township 26 South, Range 42 West, totaling 276 acres all on land currently owned by the 100F Lodge No. 539.

The change application evaluated according to part (b)(1) of K.A.R. 5-5-11(b) *Applications* for change in places of use for irrigation purposes, found the 9.5 acre increase in authorized acres above the base acres complies with the regulation. The change appears to comply with K.A.R. 5-5-3, *Change in consumptive use*. The 532AF will provide 1.92 AF per acre complying with K.A.R. 5- 3-19, *Maximum reasonable annual quantity of water for irrigation use* and appears to be reasonable.

In a letter dated August 15, 2022, Jason Norquest, on behalf of the Southwest Kansas Groundwater Management District No. 3, reviewed the applications and recommend approval.

Michael Meyer, Water Commissioner of the Garden City Field Office, recommended approval of the changes per his email dated September 6, 2022.

Water flow meters will be required per as the changes do not meet K.A.R. 5-5-11(e). If the rights will chemigate they will be required to install and maintain check valves. Water level measurement tubes are not applicable to these changes, as no new wells have been authorized.

Based on the above discussion, that the changes are reasonable, there will be no significant increase in the consumptive use and impairment of existing water rights is unlikely, it is recommended that the referenced applications for change in place of use be approved.



located substantially as shown on the topographic map accompanying the application to change the place of use, and the location of the authorized points of diversion shall be better described as:

one (1) well located in the Northwest Quarter of the Southwest Quarter of the Southeast (NW½ SW½ SE½) of Section 10, more particularly described as being near a point 824 feet North and 2,570 feet West of the Southeast corner of said section, and

one (1) well located in the Southwest Quarter of the Northwest Quarter of the Southeast (SW½ NW½ SE½) of Section 10, more particularly described as being near a point 1,665 feet North and 2,586 feet West of the Southeast corner of said section,

both in Township 26 South, Range 42 West, Hamilton County, Kansas.

All diversion works into which any type of chemical or other foreign substance will be injected into the water pumped from the diversion works shall be equipped with an in-line, automatic, quick-closing check valve capable of preventing pollution of the source of the water supply. The type of valve installed shall meet specifications adopted by the Chief Engineer and shall be maintained in an operating condition satisfactory to the Chief Engineer.

The water right owner shall properly install an acceptable water meter on each of the diversion works authorized under this water right, prior to the use of water, in strict accordance with the Kansas Administrative Regulations 5-1-4 through 5-1-12 adopted by the Chief Engineer. The water right owner shall notify the Chief Engineer when installation of the water meter has been completed. The water right owner shall maintain the water meter in an operating condition satisfactory to the Chief Engineer, at all times during diversion of water and shall maintain records from which the total quantity of water diverted may be determined. The water right owner shall also report the reading of said water meter and the total quantity of water diverted annually to the Chief Engineer. Such records shall be furnished to the Chief Engineer by March 1 following the end of each calendar year

In all other respects, the Certificate of Appropriation issued pursuant to Approval of Application the, File No. 88 for permit to appropriate for beneficial use, is as stated and set forth in the Certificate of Appropriation dated June 19, 1951, as modified and amended by the aforementioned orders.

If you are aggrieved by this Order, then pursuant to K.S.A. 82a-1901, you may request an evidentiary hearing before the Chief Engineer, or request administrative review by the Secretary of Agriculture. If you choose to appeal this decision or any finding or part thereof, you must do so by filing a petition for review in the manner prescribed by the Kansas Act for Judicial Review and Civil Enforcement of Agency Actions (KJRA K.S.A. 77 601 et seq.) within 30 days of service of this order. Your appeal must be made with the appropriate district court for the district of Kansas.
