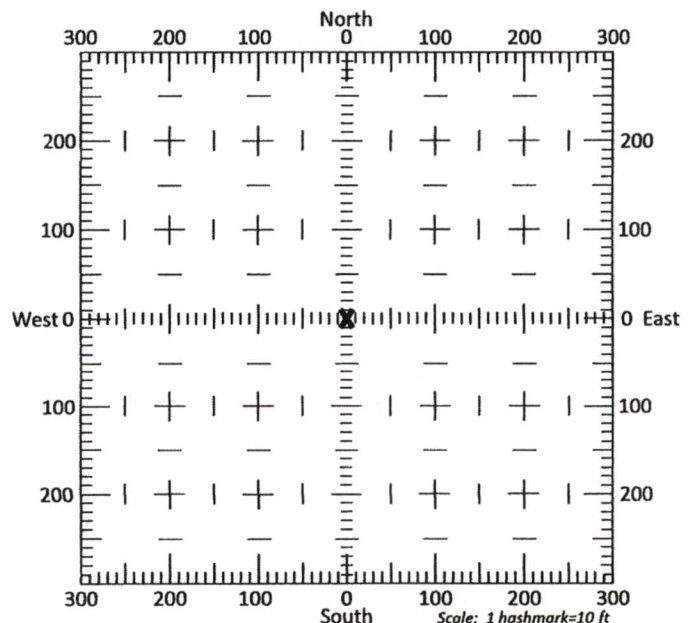



SUMMARY ORDER APPROVING APPLICATION FOR CHANGE AND IMPOSING CONDITIONS

This Summary Order is issued under authority of K.S.A. 82a-708b, as amended, and K.A.R. 5-5-1, *et seq.* and other applicable provisions of the *Kansas Water Appropriation Law, K.S.A. 82a-701 et seq.*, and rules and regulations promulgated thereunder, With the exception of those conditions expressly contained herein, this Summary Order does not change the terms, conditions and limitations of File No. 36263

1. A change application was received on March 10, 2023 requesting that the place of use and / or point of diversion authorized under the above-referenced file number be changed as described in the application.

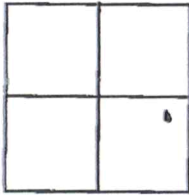

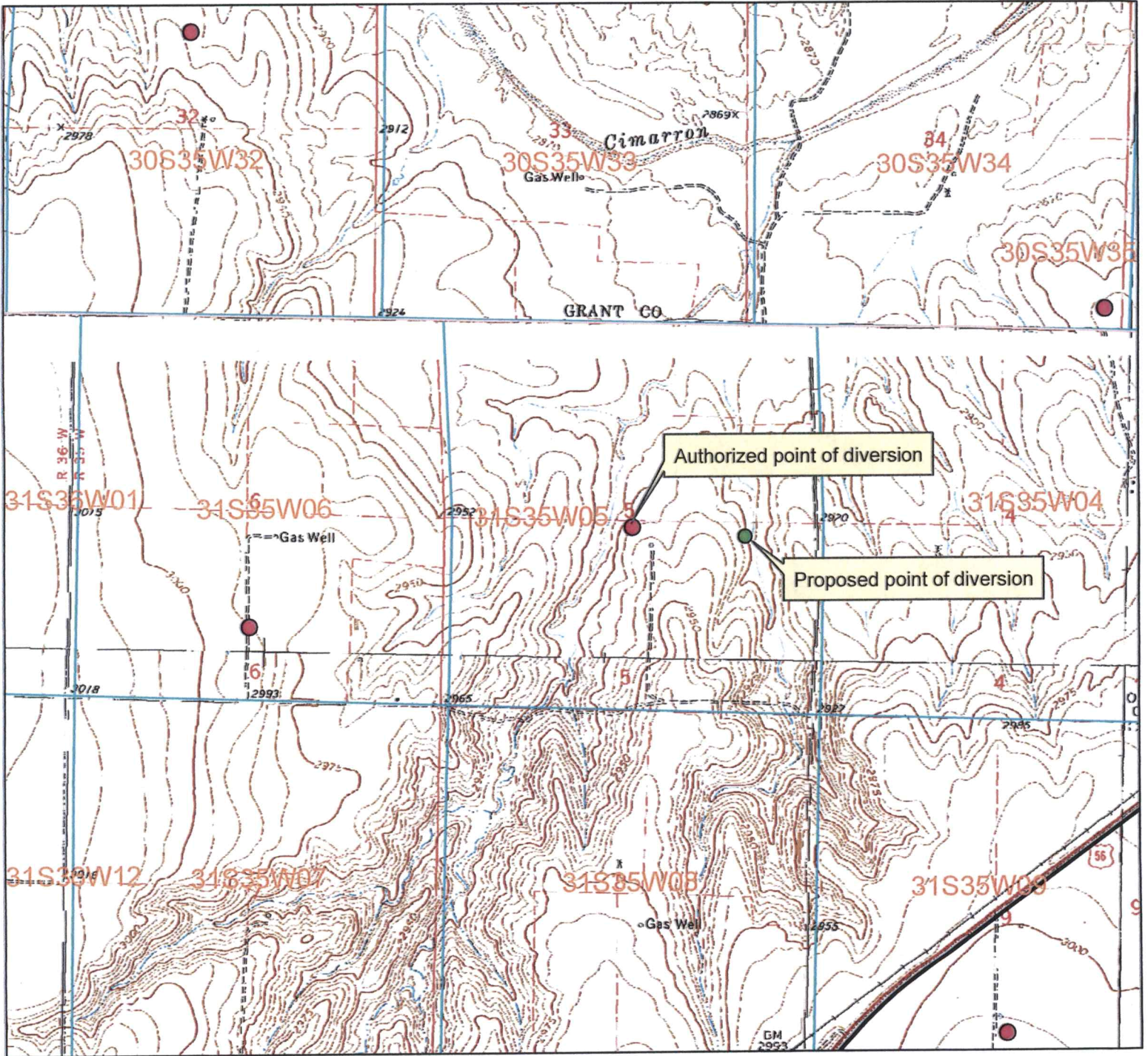

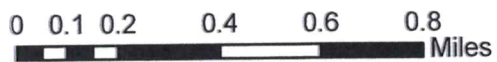

● Authorized point of diversion

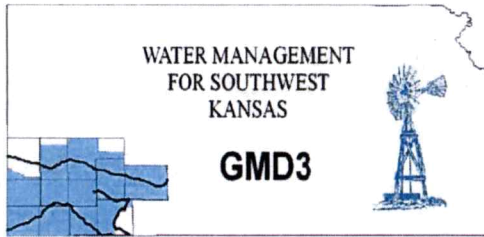
● Proposed point of diversion


We have completed a review of the application for the above referenced water right. The proposed change in point of diversion is in accordance with current area rules, K.A.R. 5-23-3, as it pertains to minimum spacing to neighboring wells and distance moved.

Well evaluations were not conducted to estimate possible effects of the proposal on the supply of other wells with water rights prior to the proposal per K.S.A. 82a-708b, and the management program. In this case, We did not find any wells within the area on the analysis to determine possible effects. We noted that this diversion had a change approved 2022 with little pumping in 2022. The move would still be within area rules from the previous point of diversion also. So it was determined that the analysis was not needed in this case.

Therefore, GMD3 sees this move as meeting current area rules and would recommend approval. If aquifer conditions change or there is a change to the water right in the future, we would be happy to evaluate the effects at that time.
