Clint Morrison on behalf of Santa Fe Feeders LLC, owner of the referenced water right has filed an application for approval to change the point of diversion, use made of water and place of use. The application was received on November 23, 2020. After review it was determined the limitation on this file would require the quantity under the senior files, File Nos. 37,205; 37,206 and 39,560 to be reduced to provide quantity for the proposed use. The reductions are summarized under a separate memo.

The referenced file appears to be in good standing, as per K.S.A. 82a-718 and 82a-732.

File No. 39,561 is authorized stockwater use at 3.75 million gallons (11.51 acre-feet) and is limited to 19.23 million gallons per year when combined with Water Right, File Nos. 37,205, 37,206 & 39,560 at the feedlot located in the Southeast Quarter (SE $\frac{1}{4}$) of Section 22 and the Southwest Quarter (SW $\frac{1}{4}$) of Section 23, all in Township 26 South, Range 28 West, Gray County. The well is located in the Northeast Quarter of the Northeast Quarter of the Southeast Quarter (NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$) of Section 22, approximately 2,473 feet North and 120 feet West of the Southeast corner. The file is located within the Arkansas River Intensive Groundwater Use Control Area (IGUCA) and Southwest Kansas Groundwater Management District No. 3. The proposed change is to move to an existing well due to the authorized well being listed as dry on the application.

The proposal was modified to comply with the IGUCA requirement to now move to a different existing well authorized by File No. 19,116, ID #6, located in the Northeast Quarter of the Northeast Quarter of the Southwest Quarter (NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$) of Section 23, approximately 2,255 feet North and 3,025 feet West of the Southeast corner, in Township 26 South, Range 28 West, Gray County.

The move 2,448 feet to the East will parallel the Arkansas River located approximately 8,500 feet North of both wells. The well authorized at 2,473 feet North and 120 feet West of the Southeast corner, (NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$) of Section 22, in Township 26 South, Range 28 West, Gray County will be plugged.

A review of the reported water use finds the currently authorized well has a reported depth of 246 feet. A WWC-5 log for the well (ID 1) authorized by File No. 19,116, records shale at 227 feet. It appears both wells are in the Ogallala Formation (Code 211) and the Arkansas River IGUCA (Code 75), the proposed change will not alter the local source of supply for the referenced file.

The requested change in use made of water is from stockwater to irrigation use. The change will be processed by K.A.R. 5-5-8, *Standards for approval of an application for change in the place of use and a change in the use made of water*. The stockwater use is considered to be totally consumptive by the nature of the use with irrigation being less consumptive. It appears the full quantity of 3.75 million gallons as 11.5 acre-feet, (AF) can be changed to irrigation use without any increase in consumptive use, thus meeting K.A.R. 5-5-3, *Change in consumptive use*.

The proposed existing well is authorized 250 acre-feet the change will increase the total quantity to 261.5 acre-feet. The increase in quantity will not alter the required well to well spacing of 1,600 feet to non-domestic wells per K.A.R. 5-23-3, *Minimum well spacing requirements: high plains aquifer*.

The well to well spacing found a nearby non-domestic under File No. 46,562 authorized for stockwatering approximately 714 feet away, but this well is classified as a Confined Dakota well and considered a different source of supply from that of the proposed well. The other well under the proposed file, File No. 19,116, is located approximately 1,661 feet away and meets the required spacing for the 232 acre-feet authorized. It appears the non-domestic well to well spacing is met.

The original proposed point of diversion had three domestic wells located within one-half mile. These owners were notified of the requested change with no reply of any kind received. The modification of the proposed point of diversion shifted the notification area resulting in three additional domestic notifications. All of the domestic wells are the required 660 feet from the proposed existing well. The notification of these nearby well owners resulted in a call from Gary Schadegg owner of a 1995 completed domestic well in the Northwest Quarter of the Southeast Quarter of the Southeast Quarter (NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$) of Section 23, and located approximately 2,500 feet to the Southeast of the proposed existing well. This domestic well has a depth of 190 feet and had a static water level of 109 feet. He indicated this domestic well was used for pasture cattle but has been dry for several years and that he needed to get it drilled, but for now it is cheaper to haul water when needed. My request for written comments did not result in any written correspondence.

As the proposal will not increase the number of wells and the currently authorized point of diversion will be requested to be plugged, K.A.R. 5-5-16, *Additional wells* will not apply.

The proposed irrigation use with the change in place of use is to irrigate the existing 272 acres authorized by File No. 19,116, located in the West Half of Section 23. The total combined quantity 493.5 AF will result in 1.81AF per acre under File Nos. 19,116 and 39,561. It appears the change complies with K.A.R. 5-3-23, *Maximum reasonable annual quantity approvable for irrigation use for an application for change in place of use and a request to reduce a water right*.

The current stockwatering use quantity is limited to 19.23 million gallons when combined with File Nos. 37,205; 37,206 & 39,560. The reduction request for these senior files and modification of the limitations will afford quantity for the referenced file. The shift away from stockwatering by the referenced file should not result in a lack of quantity for the stockwatering as the Dakota sourced well under File No. 46,562, provides additional quantity and is an alternate point of diversion.

The Southwest Kansas Groundwater Management District No. 3 reviewed the application. In an April 1, 2022 dated letter by Jason Norquest, Assistant Manager of the District the application for change has recommended for approval.

Mike Meyer, Water Commissioner of the Garden City Field Office indicated by E-mail on November 9, 2022, that he has no objection to the approval of the proposed change and agrees with the needed reductions to the senior files.

A water flow meter is required for the approved change. A check valve is required if chemigating. A water level measurement tube and WWC-5 are not applicable, as the proposed well is existing and completed. A notice of completion and plugging of the currently authorized well will be requirement of this change.

Based on the above discussion, that the change is reasonable, consumptive use should not increase, that impairment to existing water rights is unlikely and that no change in the local source of supply will occur, it is recommended that the referenced application be approved.

Such violation is a class C misdemeanor, punishable by a fine not to exceed \$500 and/or a term of confinement not to exceed one month in the county jail. K.S.A. 82a-728(b). Civil penalties shall be not less than \$100 nor more than \$1,000 per violation. In the case of a continuing violation, each day such violation continues may be deemed a separate violation. In addition to these penalties the water right may be modified or suspended. K.S.A. 82a-737, as amended.

The application must be signed by all owners of the place of use authorized under the water right and his or her spouse, if married. Please indicate if there is no spouse. If land is being purchased under contract, the seller must sign as landowner until such time as the contract is completed.

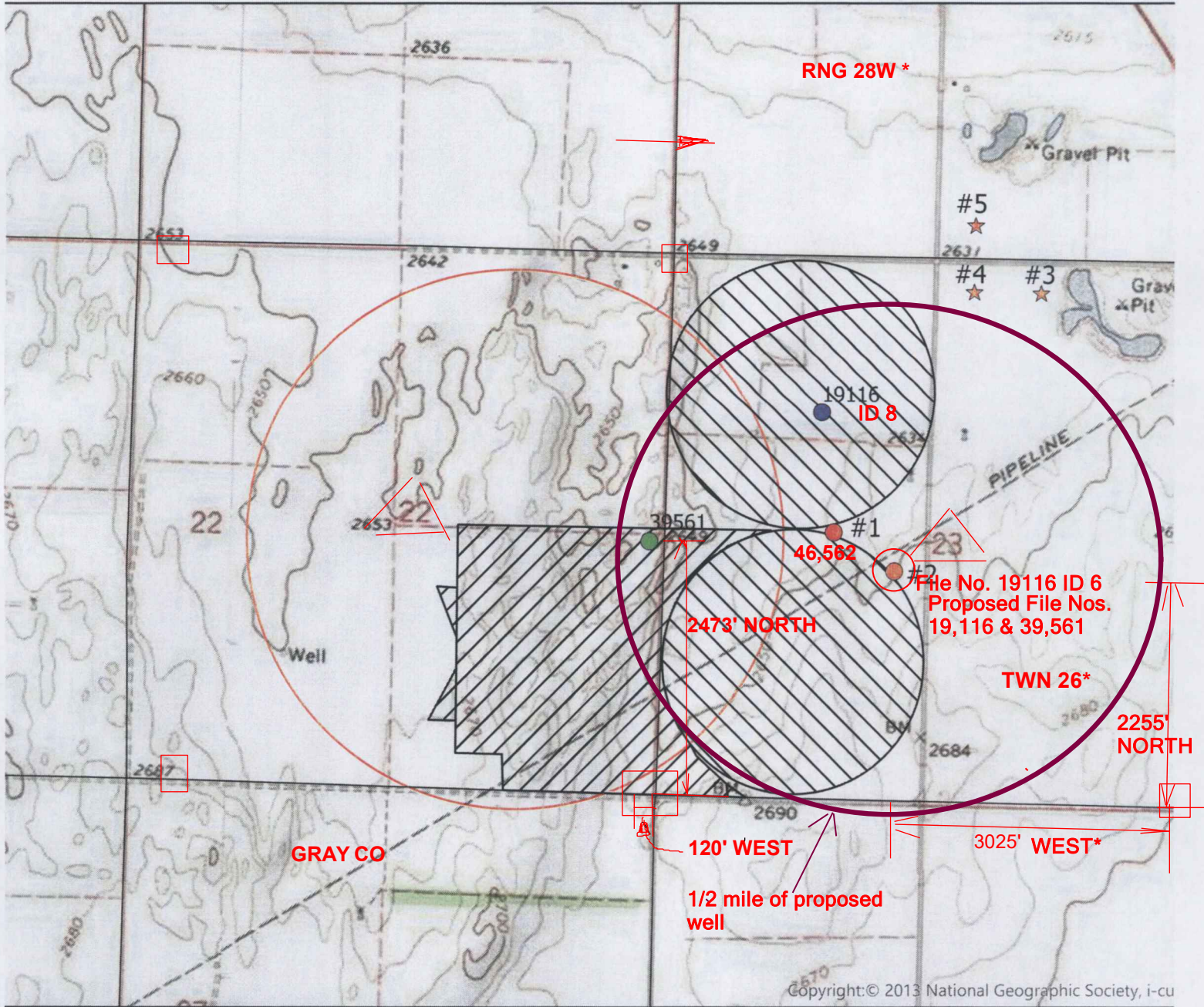

The water right owner shall notify the Chief Engineer when installation of the water meter has been completed. The water right owner shall maintain the water meter in an operating condition satisfactory to the Chief Engineer, at all times during diversion of water and shall maintain records from which the total quantity of water diverted may be determined. The water right owner shall also report the reading of said water meter and the total quantity of water diverted annually to the Chief Engineer. Such records shall be furnished to the Chief Engineer by March 1 following the end of each calendar year.

Installation of the works for diversion of water shall be completed on or before December 31, 2023, or within any authorized extension of time. The applicant shall notify the Chief Engineer of the Division of Water Resources, Kansas Department of Agriculture, when construction of the works for diversion has been completed.

In all other respects, the Certificate of Appropriation issued pursuant to Approval of Application, File No. 39,561, for permit to appropriate water for beneficial use, is as stated and set forth in the Certificate of Appropriation dated December 23, 1997, as modified and amended by the aforementioned order.

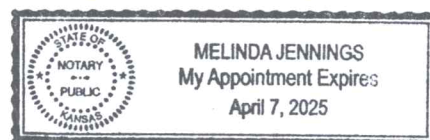

If you do not file a request for an evidentiary hearing before the Chief Engineer, you may petition for administrative review of the Order by the Secretary of Agriculture. A petition for review shall be in writing and state the basis for requesting administrative review. The request for review may be denied if the request fails to clearly establish factual or legal issues for review. See K.S.A. 77-527. The petition must be filed within 30 days after service of this Order as provided in K.S.A. 77-531 (**i.e., within a total of 33 days after this Order was mailed to you**), and be filed with: Secretary of Agriculture, Attn: Legal Division, Kansas Department of Agriculture, 1320 Research Park Drive, Manhattan, Kansas 66502, FAX 785-564-6777.

If neither a request for an evidentiary hearing nor a petition for administrative review is filed as set forth above, then this Order shall be effective and become a final agency action as defined in K.S.A. 77-607(b). Failure to timely request either an evidentiary hearing or administrative review may preclude further judicial review under the Kansas Judicial Review Act.
