Dear whom it may concern,

After a preliminary review of your above referenced application for permit to appropriate water received in this office on June 15, 2023, it is being returned to you for additional information. In your original application, you requested a 60-day period of time in which to determine the precise location for your point of diversion within a specified quarter section tract of land described as the Northwest Quarter (NW ¼) of Section 1, Township 6 South, Range 23 West, Graham County, Kansas. Due to our delay in returning the original applications to you, the 60-day period of time will start as of the date of this letter.

Once you've determined the precise location for your point of diversion, complete the rest of Paragraph No. 5 of your application by providing the description for the 10-acre tract location of the point of diversion as well as the feet distances North and West of the Southeast corner of the Section. In the case of a battery of wells, please provide the description of the location of the proposed geographic center of the well battery, as well as **the location for each of the individual wells comprising the battery of wells**.

The locations of all other water wells of every kind within one-half mile ($\frac{1}{2}$) of the point of diversions must be plotted on the topographical map as well. Each well should be identified as to its use (e.g. domestic, irrigation, industrial, etc.) and must **include the name and mailing address of the well owner**. A signed statement should be included on the map declaring that all wells within one-half mile ($\frac{1}{2}$) of the point of diversions have been plotted, or it should declare that none exist. Please provide this information once you have established your point of diversion.

Paragraph No. 13 of the application requests well information so the source of supply of the proposed well may be determined. Pursuant to K.A.R. 5-3-4d, this office requires a stratigraphic log of a well or test hole within 300 feet of the proposed points of diversion. Please supply the indicated information and a test hole log or a driller's log with the returned application.

In order to retain its priority of filing, the original applications and attachments must be returned to this office with the requested information on or before **August 20, 2023**, or within any authorized extension of time thereof. According to law, default in refiling of the completed applications and attachments within the time allowed shall constitute forfeiture of priority date and dismissal of the application.

FINDINGS AND ORDER IN THE MATTER OF THE DISMISSAL OF APPLICATION FILE NO. 51,055

After due consideration, the Chief Engineer, Division of Water Resources, Kansas Department of Agriculture (hereinafter referred to as the "Chief Engineer"), makes the following findings and order:

FINDINGS

- 1. That on June 15, 2023, the Chief Engineer received an application from Sean Katz, for a permit to appropriate groundwater for beneficial use, assigned File No. 51,055, proposing the appropriation of 189.75 acre-feet of water, at a maximum requested diversion rate of 800 gallons per minute, for irrigational use.
- 2. That in accordance with K.A.R. 5-3-1, the application was accepted for filing provided the applicant supply a more specific location for the proposed point of diversion within the nominal legal quarter-section in the Northwest Quarter (NW¼) of Section 1, Township 6 South, Range 23 West, Graham County, Kansas, within 60 days.
- 3. That upon receipt and examination, the application was also determined to be otherwise defective, inadequate or insufficient to determine the nature and amount of the proposed appropriation.
- 4. That on June 20, 2023, a letter was mailed to the applicant, detailing the additional information which must be submitted in order to complete the application, including the specific well location, and giving the applicant until August 20, 2023, in which to provide the required information, and that the application would be dismissed if it was not submitted by that deadline, or within any authorized extension of time.
- 5. That the required information was not submitted by the August 20, 2023, deadline, nor did the applicant request an extension of time in which to do so.
- 6. That the incomplete application should be dismissed and its priority forfeited in accordance with K.S.A. 82a-710.

ORDER

NOW, THEREFORE, It is the decision and order of the Chief Engineer, Division of Water Resources, Kansas Department of Agriculture, that effective the date of this order, in accordance with the law, Application, File No. 51,055, is herewith dismissed and the priority assigned to it is considered to be forfeited.
