The Chief Engineer, Division of Water Resources, Kansas Department of Agriculture, after due consideration of the written application of Justin Vyn, on behalf of Vyn Land & Cattle, 1194 Road Y, Lakin, Kansas 67860, received in this office on August 17, 2023, for approval of a change in the location of the place of use and point of diversion, under the certificate of appropriation issued pursuant to the permit to appropriate water for beneficial use, as modified and amended by the Orders of the Chief Engineer dated April 20, 2005, and May 25, 2017, approving the applications to change the place of use, finds that the changes are reasonable and will not impair existing rights, and that the application should be and are hereby approved.

The effective date of the changes shall be the date this order is executed by the Chief Engineer, after which the authorized location of the irrigation place of use shall be:

one (1) well located in the Northwest Quarter of Northwest Quarter of the Southeast Quarter (NW½ NW½ SE½) of Section 36, more particularly described as being near a point 2,532 feet North and 2,535 feet West of the Southeast corner of said section, at a diversion rate not in excess of 1,700 gallons per minute (3.79 c.f.s.) and a quantity not to exceed 778 acre-feet of water per calendar year,

both in Township 33 South, Range 38 West, Stevens County, Kansas,

located substantially as shown on the maps accompanying the application to change the place of use and point of diversion.

Installation of the works for diversion of water shall be completed on or before December 31, 2024, or within any authorized extension of time. The water right owner shall notify the Chief Engineer of the Division of Water Resources, Kansas Department of Agriculture, when construction of the works for diversion has been completed.

The water right owner shall properly install acceptable water meters on the diversion works authorized under this water right, prior to the use of water, in strict accordance with the Kansas Administrative Regulations 5-1-4 through 5-1-12 adopted by the Chief Engineer. The water right owner shall notify the Chief Engineer when installation of the water meters has been completed. The water right owner shall maintain the water meters in an operating condition satisfactory to the Chief Engineer, at all times during diversion of water and shall maintain records from which the total quantity of water diverted may be determined. The water right owner shall also report the reading of said water meters and the total quantity of water diverted annually to the Chief Engineer. Such records shall be furnished to the Chief Engineer by March 1 following the end of each calendar year.

All diversion works shall be equipped with an in-line, automatic, quick-closing check valve capable of preventing pollution of the source of the water supply. The type of valve installed shall meet specifications adopted by the Chief Engineer and shall be maintained in an operating condition satisfactory to the Chief Engineer.

In all other respects, the Certificate of Appropriation issued pursuant to Approval of Application, File No. 27,994, for permit to appropriate water for beneficial use, is as stated and set forth in the Certificate of Appropriation, dated February 21, 2001, as modified and amended by the aforementioned orders.

Enclosed are the orders executed by the Chief Engineer, Division of Water Resources, Kansas Department of Agriculture, approving the applications for change under the above referenced files.

Your attention is directed to the enclosures and to the terms, conditions, and limitations specified in these approvals. The additional existing limitations on the referenced files remain as detailed in the certificate and previous orders. A condition of the approvals is that acceptable water flowmeters must be installed on the diversion works authorized under the referenced files. Records in this office indicate that meters are installed on the authorized points of diversion. If a meter has been replaced, you must contact our staff at the Garden City Field Office at 620-276-2901.

Since these orders modify the original documents referred to above, they should be recorded with the Register of Deeds as other instruments affecting real estate.

An annual water use report must be filed with the Chief Engineer by March 1, following the end of each calendar year. If a complete annual water use report is not received by the deadline, then a fine may be assessed and all water use under such permit or right may be suspended. Reports submitted in paper form will be assessed a \$20 per file number paper filing fee. In order to avoid this filing fee, you may submit your reports online at www.kswaterusereport.org.

RIGHT TO A HEARING AND TO ADMINISTRATIVE REVIEW

If you are aggrieved by this Order, then pursuant to K.S.A. 82a-1901, you may request an evidentiary hearing before the Chief Engineer or request administrative review by the Secretary of Agriculture. Failure to request an evidentiary hearing before the Chief Engineer does not preclude your right to administrative review by the Secretary.

To obtain an evidentiary hearing before the Chief Engineer, a written request for hearing must be filed within 15 days after service of this Order as provided in K.S.A. 77-531 (i.e., within a total of 18 days after this Order was mailed to you), with the Kansas Department of Agriculture, Attn: Legal Section, 1320 Research Park Drive, Manhattan, Kansas 66502, or by FAX (785) 564-6777.

If you do not file a request for an evidentiary hearing before the Chief Engineer, you may petition for administrative review of the Order by the Secretary of Agriculture. A petition for review shall be in writing and state the basis for requesting administrative review. The request for review may be denied if the request fails to clearly establish factual or legal issues for review. See K.S.A. 77-527. The petition must be filed within 30 days after service of this Order as provided in K.S.A. 77-531 (i.e., within a total of 33 days after this Order was mailed to you), and be filed with the Secretary of Agriculture, Attn: Legal Division, Kansas Department of Agriculture, 1320 Research Park Drive, Manhattan, Kansas 66502, or by FAX (785) 564-6777.

If neither a request for an evidentiary hearing nor a petition for administrative review is filed as set forth above, then this Order shall be effective and become a final agency action as defined in K.S.A. 77-607(b). Failure to timely request either an evidentiary hearing or administrative review may preclude further judicial review under the Kansas Judicial Review Act.
