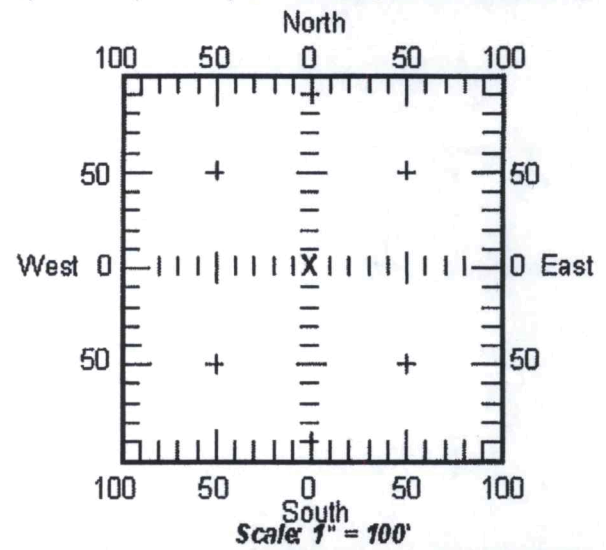

SUMMARY ORDER APPROVING APPLICATION FOR CHANGE AND IMPOSING CONDITIONS

This Summary Order is issued under authority of K.S.A. 82a-708b, as amended, and K.A.R. 5-14-3 and other applicable provisions of the *Kansas Water Appropriation Law*, K.S.A. 82a-701 et. seq., and rules and regulations promulgated thereunder, K.A.R. 5-1-1 et. seq. With the exception of those conditions expressly contained herein, this Summary Order does not change the terms, conditions and limitations of File No. 42757.

1. A change application was received on 11/3/16 requesting that the place of use and / or point of diversion authorized under the above-referenced file number be changed as described in the application.
2. On and after the effective date of this summary order, the authorized place(s) of use shall be located substantially as shown on the topographic map accompanying the application to change the place of use. Applicable Not Applicable
3. The change in point of diversion shall not impair existing rights and shall be limited to the same source or sources of water as previously authorized. 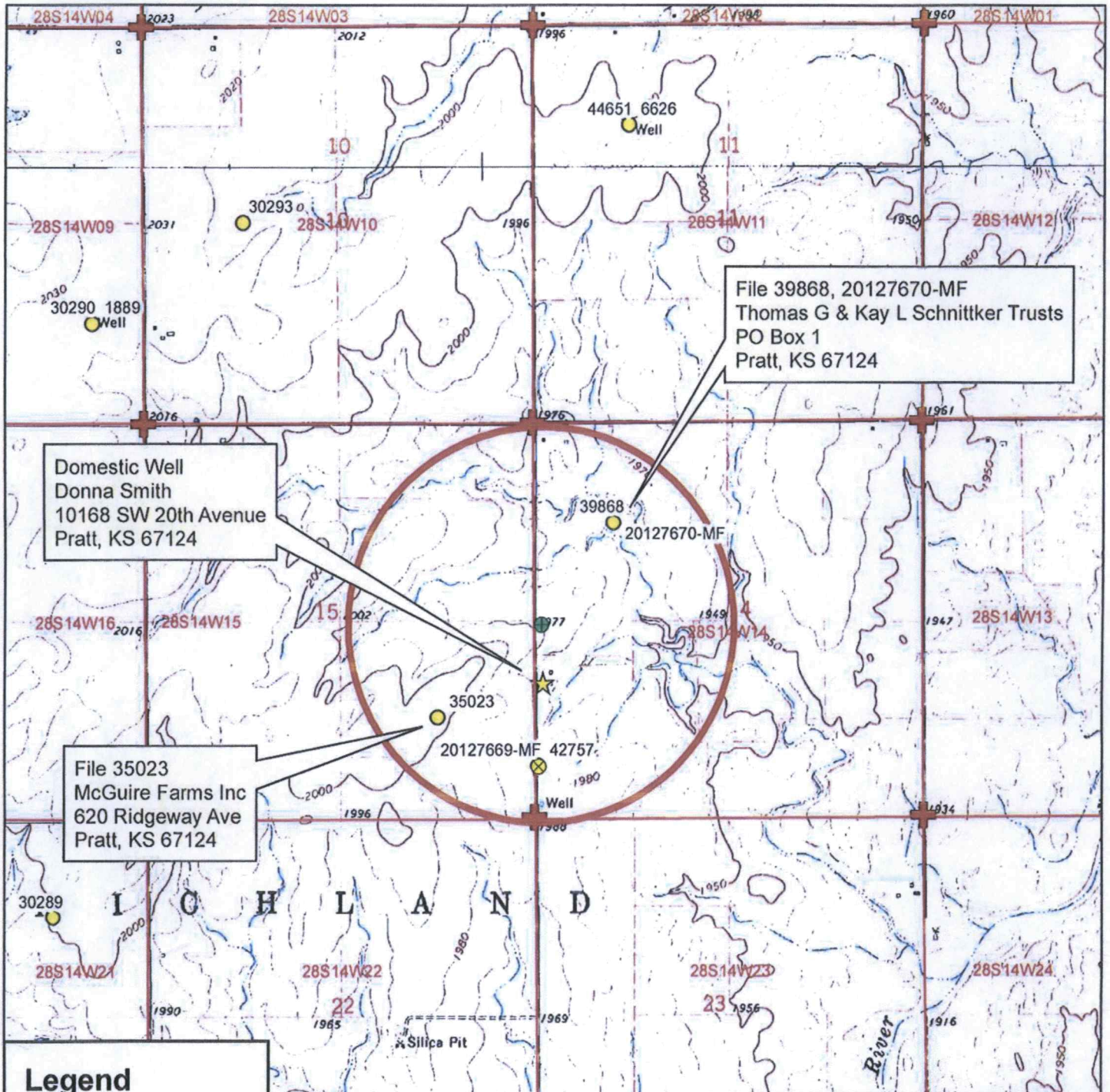

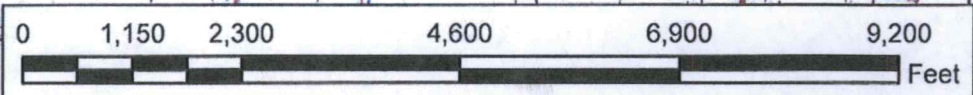

If the meter is replaced, then an acceptable **anti-reverse totalizing** water flowmeter must be installed on your well before any water is applied. A copy of the approved list of certified water flowmeters as well as the regulations regarding the installation of flowmeters, measurement tubes and check valves can be found at www.ksda.gov/includes/document_center/dwr/Forms/ApprovalPack.pdf. If you do not have access to the internet, please contact this office and we will send you a paper copy of this information.

As authorized by K.S.A. 82a-736, the authorized point of diversion for a multi-year flex account term permit will change automatically upon approval of an application to change the point of diversion under the base water right.
