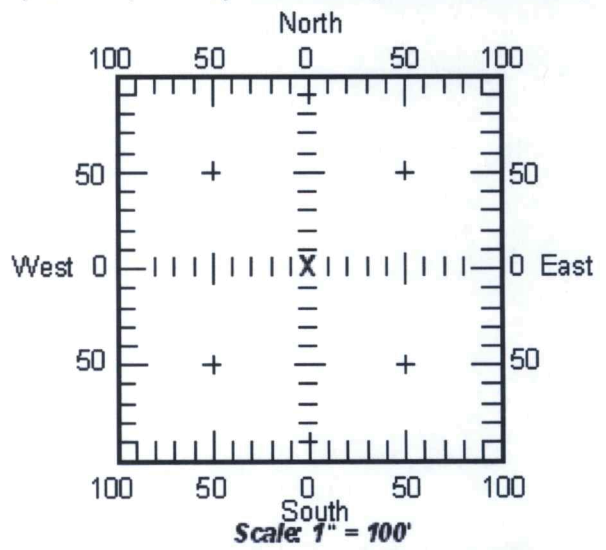

**SUMMARY ORDER APPROVING APPLICATION FOR CHANGE AND IMPOSING CONDITIONS**

This Summary Order is issued under authority of K.S.A. 82a-708b, as amended, and K.A.R. 5-14-3 and other applicable provisions of the *Kansas Water Appropriation Law, K.S.A. 82a-701 et. seq.*, and rules and regulations promulgated thereunder, K.A.R. 5-1-1 *et. seq.* With the exception of those conditions expressly contained herein, this Summary Order does not change the terms, conditions and limitations of File No. 35103.

- 1. A change application was received on 3/14/17 requesting that the place of use and / or point of diversion authorized under the above-referenced file number be changed as described in the application.
- 2. On and after the effective date of this summary order, the authorized place(s) of use shall be located substantially as shown on the topographic map accompanying the application to change the place of use.  Applicable  Not Applicable
- 3. The change in point of diversion shall not impair existing rights and shall be limited to the same source or sources of water as previously authorized. 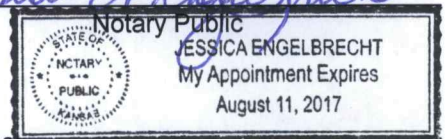

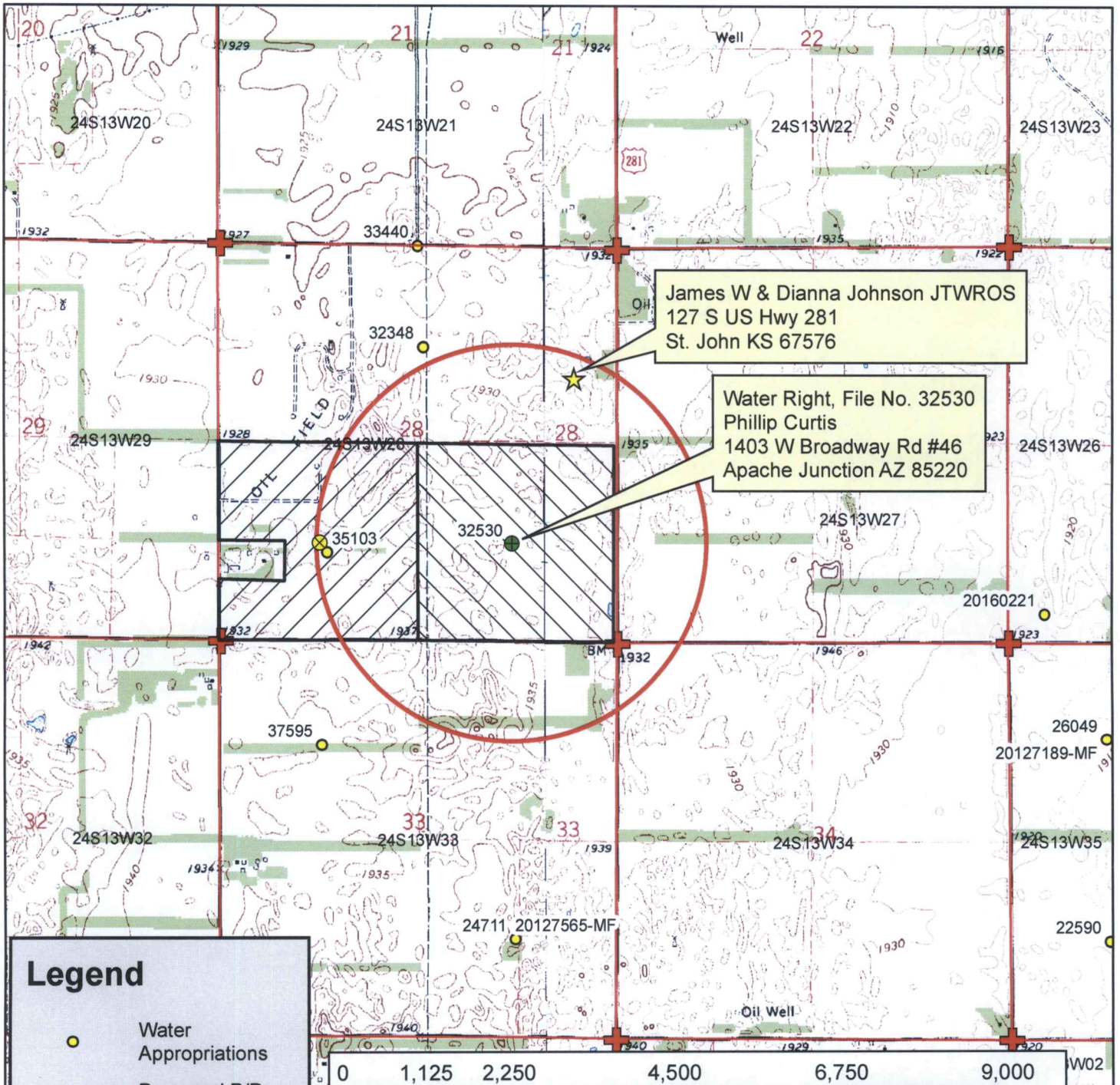

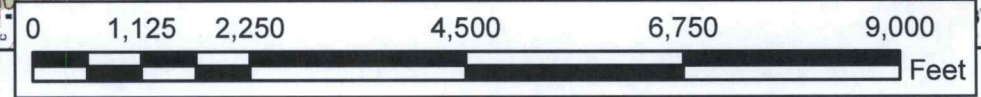
The effective date of the change approval to change the point of diversion shall be the date this order is executed by the Chief Engineer.

- 10a. A seal shall be placed on the water flowmeter by the Division of Water Resources or the Groundwater Management District in such a manner as to render the meter non-removable from the measuring chamber without breaking the seal. If the seal is broken without the permission of the chief engineer, this shall create a rebuttable presumption that the point of diversion had been unlawfully operated in violation of the order of the chief engineer and that the water right holder had been acting in violation of the conditions of his or her water right.

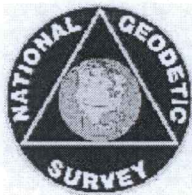





Nearby Owner Notification

On March 14, 2017, two (2) surrounding well owners were notified of the proposed place of use and point of diversion change applications filed by Ron Weber. These notifications had a deadline to submit comments to the Stafford Field Office by no later than March 29, 2017.

On March 17, 2017, Phillip Curtis called the office to discuss a letter dated March 14, 2017 regarding the proposed place of use and point of diversion application for File No. 35,103 (Phillip Curtis is the owner of Water Right, File No. 32,530). Mr. Curtis said that he was calling to request a copy of the application be sent to his address in Arizona. During the conversation, he mentioned that his brother had been in contact with Mr. Weber. He asked that if, at a later time, the changes could be reverted back. He stated that he did not think a reversion would be necessary, but he wanted to know either way. I explained that if this change was approved, the authorized place of use would be moved from Mr. Weber's (SW) quarter to his (SE) quarter. If a change application was filed after the current one is approved, the owner of the authorized place of use (in this case it would be Mr. Curtis) must sign the application. He said he did not foresee that he would have any problems with this plan and that all he needs is a copy of the filed application sent to him.

On March 22, 2017, Dianna Johnson came into the office to discuss a letter she received dated March 14, 2017 regarding the proposed place of use and point of diversion application for File No. 35,103. Dianna wanted an explanation of the changes. She was checking with our office to ensure that the water level in her domestic well would not be affected. I explained the terminology found in the letter and the spacing regulations that Mr. Weber must meet. She expressed no other concerns when she left the office.

On March 22, 2017, Phillip Curtis called the office and said he had not yet received the change application copy which was mailed from the Stafford Field Office on March 17, 2017. While on the phone, it was discovered that the zip code from the county's parcel search website was incorrect and should be listed as "85120". Mr. Curtis originally requested that a second copy be sent to this corrected address and the deadline for nearby owner comments be extended 10 days. During a second phone call, Mr. Curtis seemed confused by the application and notification process. I explained that by receiving a letter, he was simply being notified of the proposed change which had already been filed by Mr. Weber. Once he realized that he was not required to fill out or sign any type of document or application, he stated that he had no concerns and that the second copy / extension would not be necessary. - During this phone

conversation, I discussed some conditions of the proposed change applications referenced above. I explained in detail to Mr. Curtis that, if approved, the overlap of Mr. Weber's water right file (35,103) will bring with it a new meter order and a meter seal requirement. He did not have any other concerns at the end of our conversation.

No other comments were submitted to the Stafford Field Office regarding the proposed changes.

This application can be moved on to GMD #5 for further review and recommendation.
