Sharon Blank, has filed two applications for approval to change the place of use and two new applications to appropriate water for beneficial use, all for irrigation use. The files involved are Water Right, File Nos. 16,958 and 41,316 and New Application, File Nos. 49,805 and 49,806. The applications were received on May 26 & 27, 2017.

Change Application, File No. 41,316

The referenced file number do not appear to be abandoned as per K.S.A. 82a-718.

Water Right, File No. 41,316 is currently authorized 99 acre-feet of groundwater to be diverted at a maximum rate of 750 gallons per minute from one well located near the center of the Northwest Quarter (NC NW $\frac{1}{4}$) of Section 18, more particularly described as being near a point 3,690 feet North and 3,690 feet West of the Southeast corner of said section, in Township 22 South, Range 6 West, Reno County, Kansas.

The place of use is currently 105 acres in the Northwest Quarter (NW $\frac{1}{4}$) of Section 18. This application for change in place of use proposes to add 30 acres located in the Northwest Quarter (NW $\frac{1}{4}$) of Section 18 bring the total to 135 acres. This will create an overlap in place of use with Water Right, File No. 16,958 and New Application, File Nos. 49,805 & 49,806. The additional acres will be covered by the quantity appropriated under the new application files thus, there is no increase in consumptive use with the proposed change in place of use.

New Application, File No. 49,805 will overlap in point of diversion as well.

On February 10, 2016, GMD No. 2 conducted a filed inspection on the point of diversion. It was discovered that the location of the point of diversion was certified in the wrong location using the feet distances of the originally proposed well and not the actually completed well. The actual point of diversion should be located in the Southwest Quarter of the Northeast Quarter of the Northwest Quarter (SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$) of Section 18, more particularly described as being near a point 4,231 feet North and 3,775 feet West of the Southeast corner of said section, in Township 22 South, Range 6 West, Reno County, Kansas. The point of diversion will be updated to more accurately reflect this in the order accompanying this Change.

The applicant identified three nearby wells not owned by the applicant located within one-half mile of this existing well. Nearby letters were sent out on July 7, 2017 notifying about the proposed change in place of use and new applications. One call was received showing concern of the new appropriation but no formal opposition in writing was received.

The point of diversion is located within the boundaries of Equus Beds Groundwater Management District No. 2. In a letter dated September 25, 2017, Tim Boese, Manager, GMD No. 2, stated that the application complies with all rules and regulations of the GMD and recommended that the application be approved subject to the point of diversion be corrected.

In an October 10, 2017, e-mail, Jeff Lanterman, Water Commissioner, Stafford Field Office, recommended approval of the application.

Based on the above discussion, the change is reasonable, the application complies with consumptive use criteria, approval of the application will not impair senior water rights nor prejudicially or unreasonably affect the public interest. It is recommended that the referenced change application be approved to create a complete overlap with Water Right, File No. 16,958 and New Application, File Nos. 49,805 and 49,806.



one (1) well located in the Southwest Quarter of the Northeast Quarter of the Northwest Quarter (SW¼ NE¼ NW¼) of Section 18, more particularly described as being near a point 4,227 feet North and 3,774 feet West of the Southeast corner of said section, in Township 22 south, Range 6 West, Reno County, Kansas.

All diversion works into which any type of chemical or other foreign substance will be injected into the water pumped from the diversion works shall be equipped with an in-line, automatic, quick-closing check valve capable of preventing pollution of the source of the water supply. The type of valve installed shall meet specifications adopted by the Chief Engineer and shall be maintained in an operating condition satisfactory to the Chief Engineer.

The water right owner shall properly install an acceptable water meter on the diversion works authorized under this water right, prior to the use of water, in strict accordance with the Kansas Administrative Regulations 5-1-4 through 5-1-12 adopted by the Chief Engineer. The water right owner shall notify the Chief Engineer when installation of the water meter has been completed. The water right owner shall maintain the water meter in an operating condition satisfactory to the Chief Engineer, at all times during diversion of water and shall maintain records from which the total quantity of water diverted may be determined. The water right owner shall also report the reading of said water meter and the total quantity of water diverted annually to the Chief Engineer. Such records shall be furnished to the Chief Engineer by March 1 following the end of each calendar year

In all other respects, the Certificate of Appropriation issued pursuant to Approval of Application, File No. 16,958, for permit to appropriate water for beneficial use, is as stated and set forth in the Certificate of Appropriation dated June 5, 2001.

RIGHT TO A HEARING AND TO ADMINISTRATIVE REVIEW

If you are aggrieved by this Order, then pursuant to K.S.A. 82a-1901, you may:

- 1) request an evidentiary hearing before the Chief Engineer, or
- 2) request administrative review by the Secretary of Agriculture.

Failure to request an evidentiary hearing before the Chief Engineer does not preclude your right to administrative review by the Secretary.

To obtain an evidentiary hearing before the Chief Engineer, a written request for hearing must be filed within 15 days after service of this Order as provided in K.S.A. 77-531 (i.e., **within a total of 18 days after this Order was mailed to you**), with: Kansas Department of Agriculture, Attn: Legal Section, 1320 Research Park Drive, Manhattan, KS 66502, FAX (785) 564-6777.

If you do not file a request for an evidentiary hearing before the Chief Engineer, you may petition for administrative review of the Order by the Secretary of Agriculture. A petition for review shall be in writing and state the basis for requesting administrative review. The request for hearing may be denied if the request fails to clearly establish factual or legal issues for review. See K.S.A. 77-527. The petition must be filed within 30 days after service of this Order as provided in K.S.A. 77-531 (i.e., **within a total of 33 days after this Order was mailed to you**), and be filed with: Secretary of Agriculture, Attn: Legal Division, Kansas Department of Agriculture, 1320 Research Park Drive, Manhattan, KS 66502, FAX (785) 564-6777.

If neither a request for an evidentiary hearing nor a petition for administrative review is filed as set forth above, then this Order shall be effective and become a final agency action as defined in K.S.A. 77-607(b). Failure to timely request either an evidentiary hearing or administrative review may preclude further judicial review under the Kansas Judicial Review Act.

Any request for hearing or petition for administrative review shall be in writing and shall be submitted to the attention of: Chief Legal Counsel, Kansas Department of Agriculture, 1320 Research Park Drive, Manhattan, Kansas 66502, Fax: (785) 564 - 6777.



Any use of water that is not as authorized by the water right or permit to authorize water **before** the chief engineer approves this application is a violation of the Kansas Water Appropriation Act for which criminal or civil penalties may be assessed. Such violation is a class C misdemeanor, punishable by a fine not to exceed \$500 and/or a term of confinement not to exceed one month in the county jail. K.S.A. 82a-728(b). Civil penalties shall be not less than \$100 nor more than \$1,000 per violation. In the case of a continuing violation, each day such violation continues may be deemed a separate violation. 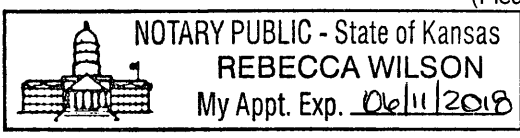

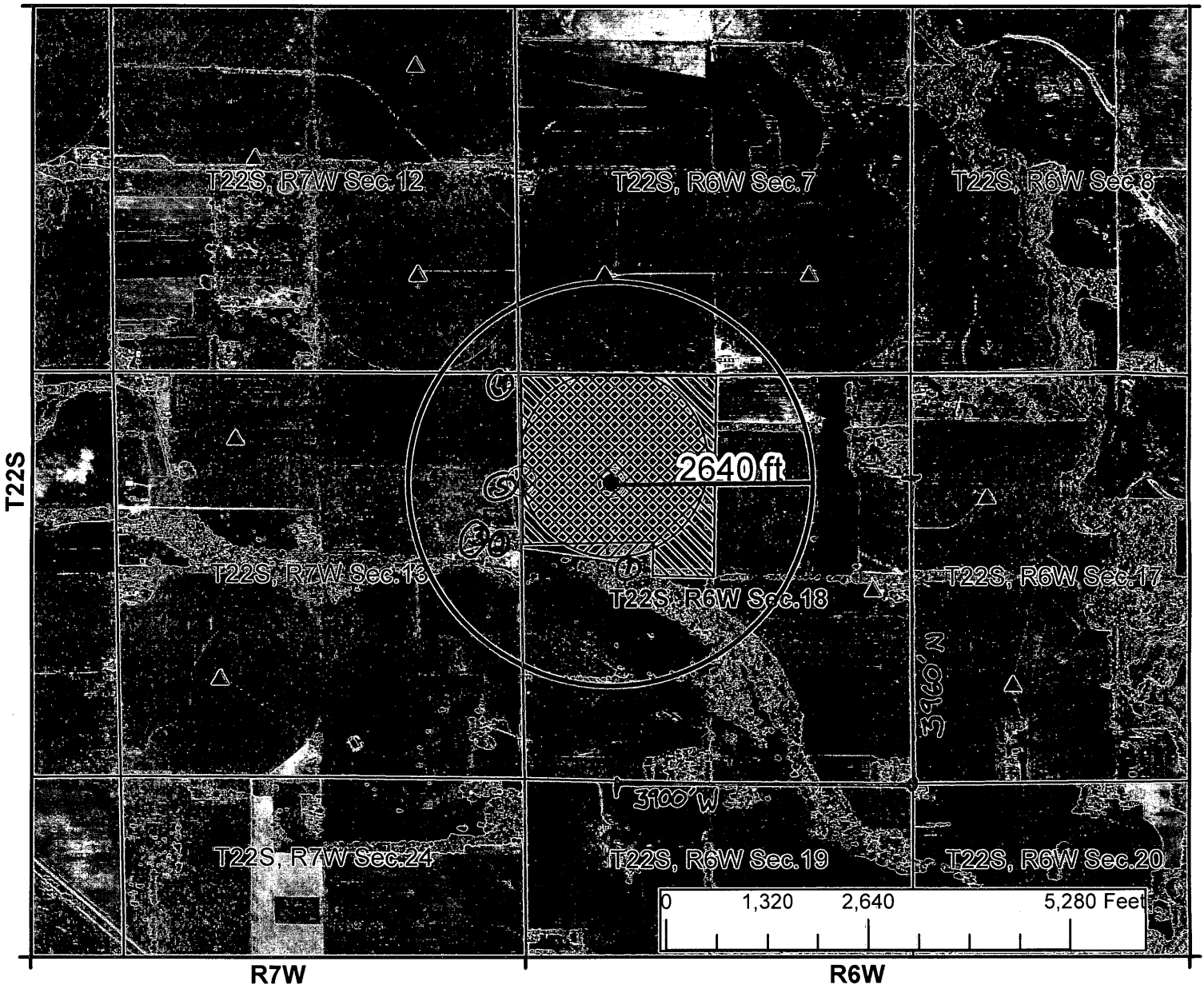

Jeff, here is a quick summary: 16958 is authorized only 14 acres and 22AF (2 owners). 41316 is authorized a different 105 acres and 99AF. The applicant is proposing p/u changes on both existing rights to completely overlap 138 acres owned by a single owner as well as new applications for additional rate and quantity from both existing wells to total a limited 1.4AF/acre. Both new apps propose 193.2 AF limited to 193.2 AF when combined with all the other files.

Per GMD#2 this meets spacing, SY, ect. It appears that all nearby wells were noted on the map. Please note that 16958 currently is located ~750' from a domestic well. Currently the well is authorized to pump 22AF @ 800gpm. This proposal would allow this well to pump 193.2AF @ 800gpm from this well (WRIS shows they do pump this well at near the full quantity of 22AF almost every year and report 550gpm).

http://hercules.kgs.ku.edu/geohydro/wizard/wizardwelldetail.cfm?usgs_id=380825098015601 (this is the well authorized by 16958 & 49806) 50' deep. Pretty handy to have this on the network!!! Shows pretty stable water levels at this time (again, pumping 22AF from this well, not 193.2AF)

Nearby domestic wells appeared to be drilled from 37'-50' deep and are completed in medium sand. Other area wells appear to be drilled to 70-80' depth and are still in sand.

I think this whole package can be recommended for approval based on meeting all current regulations and requirements. Honestly, I don't like how close we are to the domestic well south of 16958 & 49806 simply b/c of the increased quantity that could be pumped from this well. I doubt they pump the full quantity from this well, likely it will be a split between the two wells, but if approved they have the legal ability to pump the full 193.4AF from that well. Do you want to request an OBS well 660' straight south of 16958, or with the current water level and annual measurement are you inclined to go with what we have? I would love to clean this whole thing up and dismiss the two senior files but we can't really request that be done. Once certified we will have odd quantities and rates on the junior and senior files but we (and they) are probably just going to have to live with that aspect.

Please pass on to Austin if you agree that both new apps and the p/u changes and the p/d location modification can be approved. If you want we can discuss additional conditions about a monitoring well.

The Equus Beds Groundwater Management District No. 2 reviewed the referenced change in place of use application on September 21, 2017, using the District's Revised Management Program (effective May 1, 1995) and Rules and Regulations K.A.R. 5-22-1 through 5-22-17.

The change application proposes to increase the place of use from 105 acres to 138 acres and creates an identical place of use overlap with the change in place of use application filed on Water Right No. 16958, and new Application Nos. 49805 and 49806. The combined water to land ratio is 1.4 acre-feet per acre.

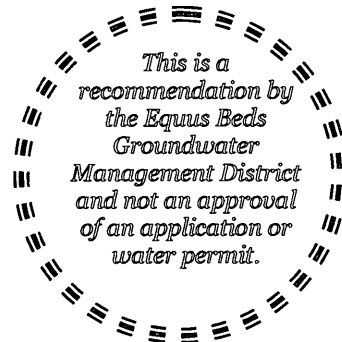

Section 82a-728 of the Kansas Water Appropriation Act, provides (a) except for the appropriation of water for the purpose of domestic use, . . . it shall be unlawful for any person to appropriate or threaten to appropriate water from any source without first applying for and obtaining a permit to appropriate water in accordance with the provisions of the Water Appropriation Act or for any person to violate any condition of a vested right, appropriation right or an approved application for a permit to appropriate water for beneficial use.

(b) (1) The violation of any provision of this section by any person is a class C misdemeanor...

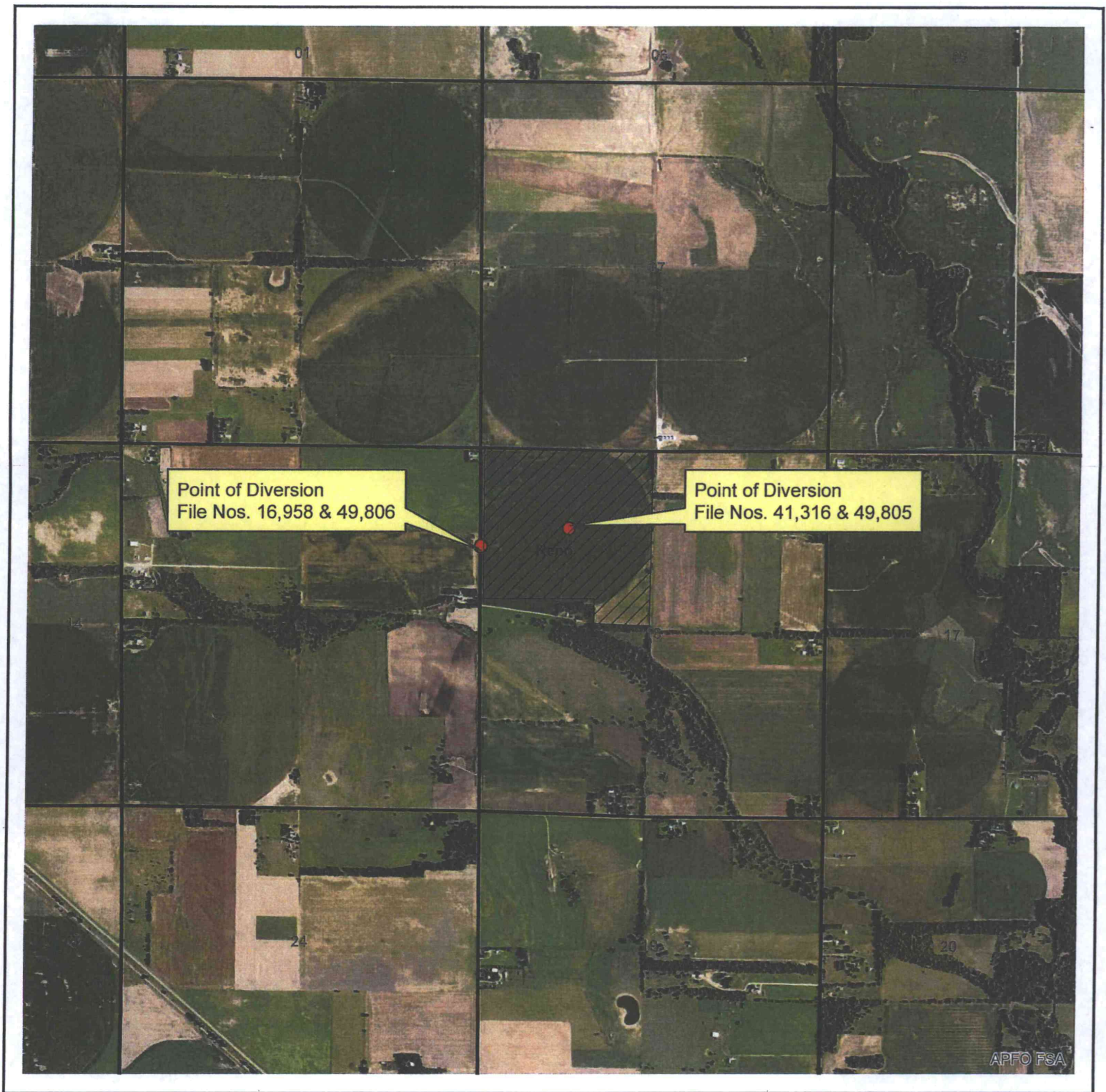
A class C misdemeanor is punishable by a fine not to exceed \$500 and/or a term of confinement not to exceed one month in the county jail. Each day that the violation occurs constitutes a separate offense.
