Richard Dwyer, on behalf of the Catholic Diocese of Wichita, owner of the referenced water right, filed an application for approval to change the point of diversion, place of use and use made of water from thermal exchange to irrigation use.

The referenced file number does not appear abandoned as per K.S.A. 82a-718.

File No. 44,681, authorized for thermal exchange in the Cow Creek drainage basin, has no overlap in the authorized point of diversion, described as one (1) well located in Southwest Quarter of the Southwest Quarter of the Southwest Quarter (SW½ SW½ SW½) of Section 5, more particularly described as being near a point 311 feet North and 4,982 feet West of the Southeast corner of said section, in Township 23 South, Range 5 West, Reno County. There are no overlaps in the authorized place of use located in the Southwest Quarter of the Southwest Quarter (SW½ SW½) of Section 5. Paragraph No. 3 of the application indicates the presently authorized well is no longer used for thermal exchange at Trinity Catholic Junior Senior High School in Hutchinson, that the water right owners now propose to irrigate 7.3 acres of athletic fields and grounds at the school, and that the authorized rate and quantity will be moved to a new existing well.

The proposal appears to meet K.A.R. 5-5-3 Change in consumptive use and K.A.R. 5-5-8 Standards for approval of an application for a change in the place of use and a change in the use made of water. This right should probably have been classified as industrial use instead of thermal exchange use since according to K.A.R. 5-1-1(gggg) thermal exchange is considered to be essentially non-consumptive to the source of supply. Paragraph No. 13 of the application indicates that the water right owner used the water for thermal exchange purposes and then discharged the wastewater into the Arkansas River via a storm ditch. The originating source of water is the Equus Beds Aquifer (190) so if the use made of water is changed to irrigation use at the school, it appears that the consumptive use of the right will be decreased.

The 9.2 acre-feet to be authorized appears reasonable for the proposed 7.3 acres and can potentially supply 1.26 acre-feet per acre, which is below the maximum reasonable quantity for irrigation in Reno County. The water right owner also proposes to move the authorized 9.2 acre-feet and 89 gallons per minute to an existing well located 650 feet North and 4,804 feet west of the Southeast corner of Section 5, approximately 383 feet from the originally authorized location.

Based on WRIS and the application map, there are several domestic wells and three non-domestic wells located within one-half mile of the proposed point of diversion. Nearby well owners were not notified by this office of the proposed change in point of diversion since the proposed distance move is small (383 feet), the new use made of water will be less consumptive than the authorized use, the quantity is small (9.2 acre-feet) and the move is to a well already in existence. In addition, quantity is being moved away from two of the three non-domestic wells and the nearby domestic well owners located within 660 feet signed letters granting permission to waive spacing to their domestic wells.

The same local source of supply will not change, previously determined to be Equus Beds (190).

In a letter dated May 15, 2017, Tim Boese, Manager of Equus Beds Groundwater Management District No. 2, indicated that the District recommends approval of the application after initially recommending the application for denial in a letter dated May 23, 2016.

In an e-mail dated May 25, 2017, Jeff Lanterman, Water Commissioner of the Stafford Field Office, indicated no objection to approval of the referenced change application.

A water flow meter is required and a check valve is required, if chemigating.

Based on the above discussion, that the changes are reasonable, that impairment to existing water rights is unlikely, and that no change in the local source of supply will occur, it has been recommended that the referenced application be approved.

a total of 7.30 acres in Township 23 South, Range 5 West, Reno County, Kansas, and the authorized location of the authorized point of diversion shall be:

one (1) well located in the Southwest Quarter of the Southwest Quarter of the Southwest Quarter (SW¼ SW¼ SW¼) of Section 5, more particularly described as being near a point 650 feet North and 4,804 feet West of the Southeast corner of said section, in Township 23 South, Range 5 West, Reno County, Kansas, at a diversion rate not in excess of 89 gallons per minute (0.20 c.f.s.) and a quantity of water not to exceed 9.20 acre-feet of water per calendar year,

located substantially as shown on the map accompanying the application to change the place of use, point of diversion and the use made of water.

Installation of the works for diversion of water shall be completed on or before December 31, 2017, or within any authorized extension of time. The water right owner shall notify the Chief Engineer of the Division of Water Resources, Kansas Department of Agriculture, when construction of the works for diversion has been completed.

All diversion works into which any type of chemical or other foreign substance will be injected into the water pumped from the diversion works shall be equipped with an in-line, automatic, quick-closing check valve capable of preventing pollution of the source of the water supply. The type of valve installed shall meet specifications adopted by the Chief Engineer and shall be maintained in an operating condition satisfactory to the Chief Engineer.

The water right owner shall properly install an acceptable water meter on the diversion works authorized under this water right, prior to the use of water, in strict accordance with the Kansas Administrative Regulations 5-1-4 through 5-1-12 adopted by the Chief Engineer. The water right owner shall notify the Chief Engineer when installation of the water meter has been completed. The water right owner shall maintain the water meter in an operating condition satisfactory to the Chief Engineer, at all times during diversion of water and shall maintain records from which the total quantity of water diverted may be determined. The water right owner shall also report the reading of said water meter and the total quantity of water diverted annually to the Chief Engineer. Such records shall be furnished to the Chief Engineer by March 1 following the end of each calendar year.

In all other respects, the Certificate of Appropriation issued pursuant to Approval of Application, File No. 44,681, for permit to appropriate water for beneficial use, is as stated and set forth in the Certificate of Appropriation dated January 19, 2010.

This Order shall become a final agency action, as defined by K.S.A. 77-607(b), without further notice to the parties, if a request for hearing or a petition for administrative review is not filed as set forth below.

Request for Hearing. According to K.A.R. 5-14-3(c), any party who desires a hearing must submit a request within 15 days after the date shown on the Certificate of Service attached to this Order. Filing a request for a hearing will give you the opportunity to submit additional facts for consideration, contest any findings made by the Chief Engineer or present any other information you believe should be considered in this matter. A timely-filed request for hearing will stay the deadline for requesting administrative review of this Order pending the outcome of the hearing.

Petition for Review. Any person aggrieved by this Order may petition for administrative review, pursuant to K.S.A. 82a-708b(a) and K.S.A. 82a-1901(a). The petition must be filed within 30 days after the date shown on the Certificate of Service attached to this Order and must set forth the basis for the review, unless stayed by the timely filing of a request for hearing.

Jeff, this is a p/d, p/u, umw change to go from thermal exchange to irrigation of 7.3 acres of ball fields and school grounds at Trinity Junior High School in Hutchinson. The current use is thermal exchange for the school but that system is no longer used. The thermal exchange right authorizes 9.2AF @ 89gpm and with approval of this they will utilize an existing well for irrigation. Less than 100gpm, so no measurement tube required. This was a pump and dump system.

GMD has recommended approval of this after originally denying it. The original denial was based on not meeting spacing of 660' to nearby domestic wells and it was over the max quantity per acre in Reno County. The application was modified to include more acreage and the 4 nearby domestic owners sent in domestic consent forms. GMD#2 then recommended approval. (I've attached the nearby owner list and a map of nearby wells from docuware)

The proposed irrigation place of use is the football field and green space around the track and tennis courts.

There has been no reported use from this well from 2012-2016 which is 5 years of non-use. The applications to change the p/d, p/u, and umw were filed in 2015 so non-use is a non-issue as these apps have been in process for an entire year of the non-use period.

I think this change packet can be recommended for approval, with the waiver of spacing to the 3 nearby domestic wells. Please pass on to Richelle if you agree. This is fixing a problem cause I assume they have been illegally watering

the ball fields for a long time, it's nice to be able to use an existing right of the schools to cover an ongoing unauthorized use.

First, I would like to begin by saying thank you for our conversation this morning concerning Trinity Catholic Jr/Sr High School's water well rights on an existing well located on the campus of the school. You were most helpful and it is much appreciated.


Per our conversation, as principal of the school and a representative of the Wichita Diocese, I am asking requesting additional time beyond the 15 days to submit and research additional information. I hope you can accommodate us as we come up with the best solution for this matter.

It is my understanding that the issue is that we do not comply with the Maximum Reasonable Quantity for Beneficial Use Rule and Regulations as the proposed water to land ratio of approximately 1.61 acre-feet per acre exceeds the maximum allowable of 1.4 acre-feet per acre for Reno County. Again, I am asking that this application is adopted and we are able to irrigate the proposed land. The reasons are listed below:

- The proposed land that is being irrigated by the well is the school's football field that is used for athletic events as well as physical education purposes.
- Enough water must be allowed to ensure a safe surface for all activities and participates.
- The type of grass planted must have a certain amount of water to stay alive and be healthy.
- New seed is planted each year in the fall and must have enough water to ensure a good stand of new grass.
- As indicated on the Google map, the well is also meant to irrigate the practice football field to the east of the main field. Due to irrigation issues and limited space, this field is not watered on a regular basis.

Dear Mr. Boese,

First, I would like to begin by saying thank you for our conversation this morning concerning Trinity Catholic Jr/Sr High School's water well rights on an existing well located on the campus of the school. You were most helpful and it is much appreciated.

Per our conversation, as principal of the school and a representative of the Wichita Diocese, I am asking requesting additional time beyond the 15 days to submit and research additional information. I hope you can accommodate us as we come up with the best solution for this matter.

It is my understanding that the issue is that we do not comply with the Maximum Reasonable Quantity for Beneficial Use Rule and Regulations as the proposed water to land ratio of approximately 1.61 acre-feet per acre exceeds the maximum allowable of 1.4 acre-feet per acre for Reno County. Again, I am asking that this application is adopted and we are able to irrigate the proposed land. The reasons are listed below:

- The proposed land that is being irrigated by the well is the school's football field that is used for athletic events as well as physical education purposes.
- Enough water must be allowed to ensure a safe surface for all activities and participates.
- The type of grass planted must have a certain amount of water to stay alive and be healthy.
- New seed is planted each year in the fall and must have enough water to ensure a good stand of new grass.
- As indicated on the Google map, the well is also meant to irrigate the practice football field to the east of the main field. Due to irrigation issues and limited space, this field is not watered on a regular basis.

I hope you will consider everything that I have mentioned in my letter. Please call or email if you have any questions. Again, thank you for your help.

Reference is made to the application for approval of the Chief Engineer to change the place of use, point of diversion and use made of water under the referenced file number which was received in the office of the Chief Engineer on November 5, 2015.

We have received a recommendation from Equus Beds Groundwater Management District No. 2 that the referenced change application for File No. 44,681 be denied. This recommendation is based upon the rules and regulations effective within the district and the groundwater management program adopted by the district and approved by the Chief Engineer, Division of Water Resources, Kansas Department of Agriculture. The District's review found that the application does not comply with the Well Spacing Rule and Regulation K.A.R. 5-22-2(a)(2), as the proposed point of diversion appears to be located less than the required minimum spacing distance of 660 feet to one or more domestic wells. In addition, the District's review found that the application does not comply with Maximum Reasonable Quantity for Beneficial Use Rule and Regulation K.A.R. 5-22-14(a)(2), as the proposed water to land ratio of approximately 1.61 acre-feet per acre exceeds the maximum allowable of 1.4 acre-feet per acre for Reno County.

For the reasons given above, it will be recommended to the Chief Engineer that Application, File No. 44,681 be denied and dismissed due to the failure to comply with K.A.R. 5-22-2(a)(2) and K.A.R. 5-22-14(a)(2).

We are advising you of this recommendation in order to allow you an opportunity to consult with the district regarding their recommendation if you have not already done so. If you have already contacted the district regarding their recommendation, then we are allowing you this opportunity to submit to this office any additional information you wish to have considered before the Chief Engineer. You have a period of 15 days (until June 21, 2016) to either (1) submit additional information to our office or (2) to request additional time beyond the 15 days to submit additional information. If you wish to request additional time, you must do so in writing, before the 15 day period expires. Such a request should state what steps are being taken to obtain the information and the amount of time you will need to supply the information to our office.

If you do not request more time within the 15 day period, or if your request is not granted, the above-referenced application will be submitted to the Chief Engineer for final decision based on the recommendations stated above. If you do submit additional information within the 15 day period (or any authorized extension), that information will be given due consideration prior to final action on the application.

The Equus Beds Groundwater Management District No. 2 reviewed the referenced change in point of diversion application on May 23, 2016, using the District's Revised Management Program (effective May 1, 1995) and Rules and Regulations K.A.R. 5-22-1 through 5-22-17.

The District's review found that the application does not appear to comply with the Well Spacing Rule and Regulation K.A.R. 5-22-2(a)(2), as the proposed point of diversion appears to be located less than the required minimum spacing distance of 660 feet to one or more domestic wells. Please note that the District could not determine the exact location of nearby domestic wells, as the map submitted with the application did not identify nearby wells.

The District's review also found that the application does not comply with the Maximum Reasonable Quantity for Beneficial Use Rule and Regulation K.A.R. 5-22-14(a)(2), as the proposed water to land ratio of approximately 1.61 acre-feet per acre exceeds the maximum allowable of 1.4 acre-feet per acre for Reno County.

Additionally, it appears that the proposed point of diversion location described on the application is in error. A District inspection found that the proposed point of diversion is an existing well and a GPS of the well by the District found the well to be located approximately 650' N & 4804' W of the southeast section corner, which is approximately 132 feet from the location described on the application (631' N & 4935' W).

Based upon the review findings, the application is recommended for denial by the Equus Beds Groundwater Management District.

A District decision may be appealed to the District Board of Directors by submitting a written petition to the District office within 30 days from date of this notification, pursuant to K.A.R. 5-22-12. An appeal petition must state the basis for the appeal and must include information/documentation supporting the appeal.

As a matter of record, the Division of Water Resources has on hand a large number of applications awaiting processing. Therefore to be fair to all concerned, and so that we can process those applications on hand in the order they were received, we intend to concentrate on the backlog of applications until the issue is resolved. You will be contacted regarding this application as soon as it has been examined.

In accordance with the provisions of the Kansas Water Appropriation Act, a portion of which is included below, the use of water prior to approval of the application is unlawful. You should not proceed and divert water as indicated by your plans in your application for a change for this file until you receive approval for this change from the Chief Engineer. Once approved, compliance with the terms, conditions and limitations of the permit is necessary. Conservation of the water resources of Kansas is required.

Section 82a-728 of the Kansas Water Appropriation Act, provides (a) except for the appropriation of water for the purpose of domestic use, . . . it shall be unlawful for any person to appropriate or threaten to appropriate water from any source without first applying for and obtaining a permit to appropriate water in accordance with the provisions of the Water Appropriation Act or for any person to violate any condition of a vested right, appropriation right or an approved application for a permit to appropriate water for beneficial use.

(b) (1) The violation of any provision of this section by any person is a class C misdemeanor...

A class C misdemeanor is punishable by a fine not to exceed \$500 and/or a term of confinement not to exceed one month in the county jail. Each day that the violation occurs constitutes a separate offense.


