Douglas Thiessen on behalf of Triple T Livestock LLC, filed applications for approval to change the place of use authorized for stockwatering use. The applications for change were received in the Office of the Chief Engineer on February 27, 2017.

The applications are to correct the place of use that is utilized for a cattle and swine operation watering on land that is not authorized. Additionally, the somewhat old compliance investigation, 2009, determined the actual location of the wells comprising the battery of three (3) wells. The geographic center authorized by both of the reference files will be corrected by the change approval. The rights comply with K.S.A. 82a-718 and K.S.A. 82a-732 and the applications are in compliance with K.A.R 5-5-2a.

File No. 28,286.05 authorizes 10.843 million gallons (46.2 acre-feet) at 120 gallons per minute with the overlapping right, File No. 46,373, authorized to divert additional quantity at a higher rate but not to exceed 24.88 million gallons (76.354 acre-feet) per year at 300 gallons per minute when combined with File No. 28,286.05. An extension to perfect has been approved thru 2017. The place of use has historically been described as being located in the North half of Section 16, Township 21 South, Range 3 East, Butler County. The maps which were referenced by the previous approvals depicted the place of use more in the center of the north half of the section. The place of use will be updated for their feedlot & swine facility for the stockwatering in the West Half of the Northeast Quarter (W1/2 NE1/4) and the East Half of the Quarter (E1/2 NW1/4) rights that cover this place of use.

The applications will increase the place of use but should not result in an increase in consumptive use as required by K.A.R. 5-5-3, *Consumptive use* as stockwatering is considered 100% consumptive. A review of their water use found only a maximum of approximately 60% of the total authorized quantity had been diverted.

The actual location of the points of diversion were determined by GPS. The largest difference was 243 feet from the currently authorized well. The GPS correction of each well will shift the geographic center of the battery of three (3) wells approximately 18 feet. The history of the file indicates the location should be corrected as allowed by part (a) of K.A.R. 5-5-6. The correction is a clerical action, so the local source of supply will not change.

The applicant indicated that there are no water wells construct within one-half (1/2) mile of the actual geographic center of the battery of wells. No notices were set.

The proposed changes meet the requirements of the rules and regulations, Jeff Lanterman, Water Commissioner of the Stafford Field Office were contacted for a comment. In an e-mail dated April 27, 2017 he recommended approval.

A condition of the approvals will be the requirement of a flow meters pursuant to K.S.A. 82a-706c. A check valve will be required if there will be any chemigation. A notice and completion of the diversion works will not be required as the order is to only correct the wells to their actual location and update the geographic center of the battery.

Based on the above discussion, that the changes are reasonable, consumptive use will not increase, impairment of existing water rights is unlikely, and that no change in the local source of supply will occur, it is recommended that the referenced applications for change be approved.

Please be reminded that reports of water usage must be submitted to this office annually. The owner, or his or her legally designated agent, is held responsible for submitting annual water use reports. Failure to file an accurate water use report is a violation of law which makes you subject to civil penalties.

The Chief Engineer, Division of Water Resources, Kansas Department of Agriculture, after due consideration of the written application of Douglas Thiessen on behalf of Triple T Livestock, LLC, 14429 NW 100th Street, Whitewater, Kansas 67154, received in this office on February 27, 2017, for approval of change in the location of the place of use under the Approval of Application, File No. 46,373, for permit to appropriate water for beneficial use, as modified and amended by the Order of the Chief Engineer, dated April 9, 2007, approving the application to change the point of diversion, finds that the change is reasonable and will not impair existing rights, and that the application should be and is hereby approved.

The effective date of the change shall be the date this order is executed by the Chief Engineer, after which the authorized location of the place of use shall be:

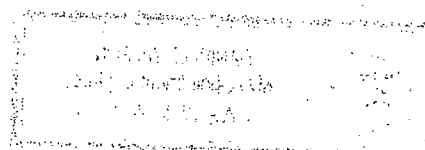
a feedlot located in the West Half of the Northeast Quarter ($W\frac{1}{2} NE\frac{1}{4}$) and the East Half of the Northwest Quarter ($E\frac{1}{2} NW\frac{1}{4}$), all in Section 16, Township 24, Range 3 East, Butler County, Kansas,

located substantially as shown on the topographic map accompanying the application to change the place of use.

That information in the office of the Chief Engineer finds that the authorized point of diversion would more accurately be defined as:

a battery of three(3) wells with a geographic center located in the Northwest Quarter of the Northwest Quarter of the Northeast Quarter ($NW\frac{1}{4} NW\frac{1}{4} NE\frac{1}{4}$) of Section 16, more particularly described as being near a point 4,684 feet North and 2,055 feet West of the Southeast corner of said section, in Township 24 South, Range 3 East, Butler County, Kansas.

All diversion works into which any type of chemical or other foreign substance will be injected into the water pumped from the diversion works shall be equipped with an in-line, automatic, quick-closing check valve capable of preventing pollution of the source of the water supply. The type of valve installed shall meet specifications adopted by the Chief Engineer and shall be maintained in an operating condition satisfactory to the Chief Engineer.



The water right owner shall properly install an acceptable water meter on the diversion works authorized under this water right, prior to the use of water, in strict accordance with the Kansas Administrative Regulations 5-1-4 through 5-1-12 adopted by the Chief Engineer. The water right owner shall notify the Chief Engineer when installation of the water meter has been completed. The water right owner shall maintain the water meter in an operating condition satisfactory to the Chief Engineer, at all times during diversion of water and shall maintain records from which the total quantity of water diverted may be determined. The water right owner shall also report the reading of said water meter and the total quantity of water diverted annually to the Chief Engineer. Such records shall be furnished to the Chief Engineer by March 1 following the end of each calendar year.

In all other respects, the Approval of Application, File No. 46,373, for permit to appropriate water for beneficial use, is as stated and set forth in the approval dated February 7, 2007, as modified and amended by the aforementioned order.

This Order shall become a final agency action, as defined by K.S.A. 77-607(b), without further notice to the parties, if a request for hearing or a petition for administrative review is not filed as set forth below.

Request for Hearing. According to K.A.R. 5-14-3(c), any party who desires a hearing must submit a request within 15 days after the date shown on the Certificate of Service attached to this Order. Filing a request for a hearing will give you the opportunity to submit additional facts for consideration, contest any findings made by the Chief Engineer or present any other information you believe should be considered in this matter. A timely-filed request for hearing will stay the deadline for requesting administrative review of this Order pending the outcome of the hearing.

Petition for Review. Any person aggrieved by this Summary Order may petition for administrative review, pursuant to K.S.A. 82a-708b(a) and K.S.A. 82a-1901(a). The petition must be filed within 30 days after the date shown on the Certificate of Service attached to this Order and must set forth the basis for the review, unless stayed by the timely filing of a request for hearing.







Jeff, this is an application for 2 files to change the place of use and we will also modify the location of the wells based on GPS taken during a compliance check (46373 is still in the perfection period) at a stock facility in Butler County. See attached map showing the proposed place of use.

We determined that the current place of use was expanded and the facility had moved onto unauthorized ground. These changes fix that. The only odd thing about the changes is that they propose a place of use covering a whole quarter section while the actual facility is much smaller. Notes in the file indicate that authorizing an entire quarter seemed like a reasonable approach since one file was still in the perfection period and further expansion could still occur. Now, if the facility is expanded, further changes would not be necessary.

I think the proposed place of use makes sense and potentially could save us and the owner future work if the facility is expanded again. I think this p/u change can be recommended for approval. Please pass on to Leslie if you agree.

An application for approval of the Chief Engineer to change the following condition or conditions of the file number referred to above has been received:

- place of use PU
- point of diversion
- use made of water

As a matter of record, the Division of Water Resources has on hand a large number of applications awaiting processing. Therefore, to be fair to all concerned, and so that we can process those applications on hand in the order they were received, we intend to concentrate on the backlog of applications until the issue is resolved. You will be contacted regarding this application as soon as it has been examined.

In accordance with the provisions of the Kansas Water Appropriation Act, a portion of which is included below, the use of water prior to approval of the application is unlawful. You should not proceed and divert water as indicated by your plans in your application for a change for this file until you receive approval for this change from the Chief Engineer. Once approved, compliance with the terms, conditions and limitations of the permit is necessary. Conservation of the water resources of Kansas is required.

Section 82a-728 of the Kansas Water Appropriation Act, provides (a) except for the appropriation of water for the purpose of domestic use, . . . it shall be unlawful for any person to appropriate or threaten to appropriate water from any source without first applying for and obtaining a permit to appropriate water in accordance with the provisions of the Water Appropriation Act or for any person to violate any condition of a vested right, appropriation right or an approved application for a permit to appropriate water for beneficial use.

(b) (1) The violation of any provision of this section by any person is a class C misdemeanor...

A class C misdemeanor is punishable by a fine not to exceed \$500 and/or a term of confinement not to exceed one month in the county jail. Each day that the violation occurs constitutes a separate offense.

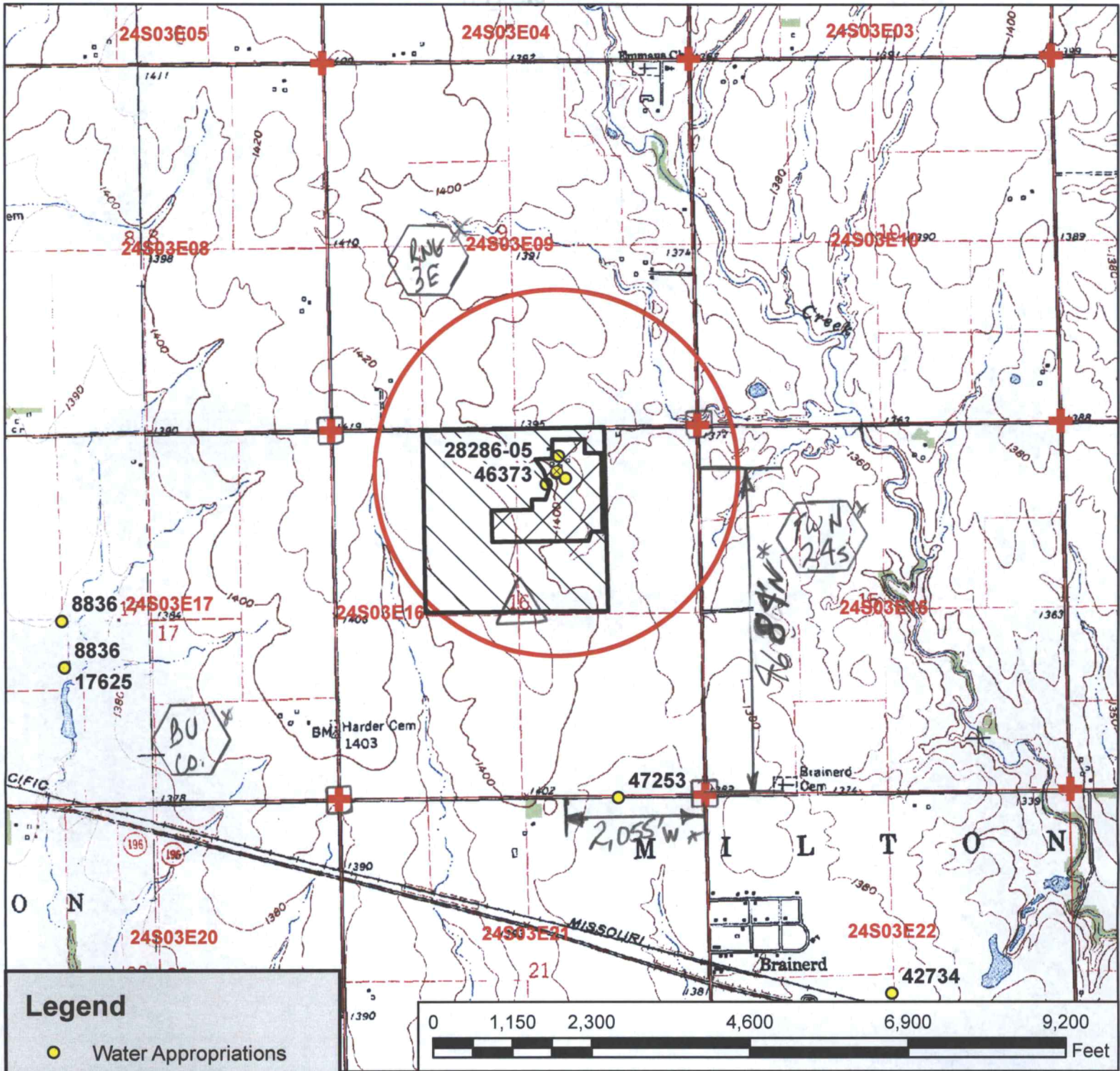
