Darren Irons, owner of File No. 48,657 has filed an application for approval to change the place of use and a new application to appropriate water for beneficial use, File No. 49,730 for irrigation use. The applications were received on November 14, 2016.

Change Application File No. 48,657

The referenced file number do not appear to be abandoned as per K.S.A. 82a-718.

File No. 48,657 is currently authorized 208 acre-feet of groundwater to be diverted at a maximum rate of 800 gallons per minute from a battery of wells with a geographic center located in the Northeast Quarter of the Northeast Quarter of the Southeast Quarter (NE¼ NE¼ SE¼) of Section 27, more particularly described as being near a point 2,015 feet North and 576 feet West of the Southeast corner of said section, in Township 32 South, Range 2 East, Sumner County, Kansas. New Application, File No. 49,730 will create a complete overlap in point of diversion and place of use.

The place of use is currently 160 acres in the Southeast Quarter (SE $\frac{1}{2}$) of Section 27. This application for change in place of use proposes to add 155 acres located in the Southwest Quarter (SW $\frac{1}{2}$) of Section 27. This will create an overlap in place of use with New Application, File No. 49,730. The additional acres will be covered by the quantity appropriated under File No. 49,730 thus there is no increase in consumptive use with the proposed change in place of use.

The applicant identified three (3) nearby wells not owned by the applicant located within one-half mile of this existing well. Nearby well owner letters were sent out on April 4, 2017, referencing the proposed change application and new application. No response of any kind has been received.

Based on the above discussion, the change is reasonable, the application complies with consumptive use criteria, approval of the application will not impair senior water rights nor prejudicially or unreasonably affect the public interest. It is recommended that the referenced application be approved to create a complete overlap with New Application, File No. 49,730.

All diversion works into which any type of chemical or other foreign substance will be injected into the water pumped from the diversion works shall be equipped with an in-line, automatic, quick-closing check valve capable of preventing pollution of the source of the water supply. The type of valve installed shall meet specifications adopted by the Chief Engineer and shall be maintained in an operating condition satisfactory to the Chief Engineer.

The water right owner shall properly install an acceptable water meter on the diversion works authorized under this water right, prior to the use of water, in strict accordance with the Kansas Administrative Regulations 5-1-4 through 5-1-12 adopted by the Chief Engineer. The water right owner shall notify the Chief Engineer when installation of the water meter has been completed. The water right owner shall maintain the water meter in an operating condition satisfactory to the Chief Engineer, at all times during diversion of water and shall maintain records from which the total quantity of water diverted may be determined. The water right owner shall also report the reading of said water meter and the total quantity of water diverted annually to the Chief Engineer. Such records shall be furnished to the Chief Engineer by March 1 following the end of each calendar year

In all other respects, the Approval of Application, File No. 48,657, for permit to appropriate water for beneficial use, is as stated and set forth in the Approval of Application and Permit to Proceed dated May 12, 2015.

RIGHT TO A HEARING AND TO ADMINISTRATIVE REVIEW

If you are aggrieved by this Order, then pursuant to K.S.A. 82a-1901, you may:

- 1) request an evidentiary hearing before the Chief Engineer, or
- 2) request administrative review by the Secretary of Agriculture.

Failure to request an evidentiary hearing before the Chief Engineer does not preclude your right to administrative review by the Secretary.

To obtain an evidentiary hearing before the Chief Engineer, a written request for hearing must be filed within 15 days after service of this Order as provided in K.S.A. 77-531 (i.e., within a total of 18 days after this Order was mailed to you), with: Kansas Department of Agriculture, Attn: Legal Section, 1320 Research Park Drive, Manhattan, KS 66502, FAX (785) 564-6777.

If you do not file a request for an evidentiary hearing before the Chief Engineer, you may petition for administrative review of the Order by the Secretary of Agriculture. A petition for review shall be in writing and state the basis for requesting administrative review. The request for hearing may be denied if the request fails to clearly establish factual or legal issues for review. See K.S.A. 77-527. The petition must be filed within 30 days after service of this Order as provided in K.S.A. 77-531 (i.e., within a total of 33 days after this Order was mailed to you), and be filed with: Secretary of Agriculture, Attn: Legal Division, Kansas Department of Agriculture, 1320 Research Park Drive, Manhattan, KS 66502, FAX (785) 564-6777.

If neither a request for an evidentiary hearing nor a petition for administrative review is filed as set forth above, then this Order shall be effective and become a final agency action as defined in K.S.A. 77-607(b). Failure to timely request either an evidentiary hearing or administrative review may preclude further judicial review under the Kansas Judicial Review Act.

Any request for hearing or petition for administrative review shall be in writing and shall be submitted to the attention of: Chief Legal Counsel, Kansas Department of Agriculture, 1320 Research Park Drive, Manhattan, Kansas 66502, Fax: (785) 564 – 6777.



Such violation is a class C misdemeanor, punishable by a fine not to exceed \$500 and/or a term of confinement not to exceed one month in the county jail. K.S.A. 82a-728(b). Civil penalties shall be not less than \$100 nor more than \$1,000 per violation. In the case of a continuing violation, each day such violation continues may be deemed a separate violation. In addition to these penalties the water right may be modified or suspended. K.S.A. 82a-737, as amended.

The application must be signed by all owners of the place of use authorized under the water right and his or her spouse, if married. Please indicate if there is no spouse. If land is being purchased under contract, the seller must sign as landowner until such time as the contract is completed.

In the event that all applicants cannot appear before one notary public, they may as necessary sign separate copies of the application before any notary public conveniently available to them. All copies signed in this manner shall be considered to be valid parts of the application.



After reviewing your comments, my safe yield calculation has been re-run and confirm the numbers Matt used. I was reading the USGS model wrong and incorrectly placed the PD within the enhanced recharge area. Attached is my revised memo with the correct SY calculation. Although the owner might have difficulty trying to perfect both rights together, impairment to other rights in the area is unlikely. Mr. Irons will just have to see what he actually perfects during the perfection period.

Austin, can you please re look at the SY on this one? Matt called this outside the Lower Ark enhanced recharge area. I looked again at the map we have and agree that this one is outside the Lower Ark area. Per Matt's previous SY analysis, he used 6692 acres, 3.2", and 100% available. Can you please double check this and if you agree that it's outside the Lower Ark area, can you redo your SY analysis and make sure it confirms the numbers Matt used.

The original application had several Premier test logs, the <u>best of which</u> showed 27' of saturated thickness. Based on this log, and the fact that spacing was good to any surrounding wells, the senior application did not have to submit additional information that proved the requested rate and quantity was available from the source. Based on the original log, I think the owner may have a difficult time trying to perfect these 2 rights.

It appears that all nearby wells were notified. There were comments from a domestic well on the senior file, but no comments on this change and new application.

I think both the new application and change in place of use application can be recommended for approval as long as the competing SY analysis between this and the senior file have been cleaned up and are matching.

An application for approval of the Chief Engineer to change the following condition or conditions of the file number referred to above has been received:

As a matter of record, the Division of Water Resources has on hand a large number of applications awaiting processing. Therefore to be fair to all concerned, and so that we can process those applications on hand in the order they were received, we intend to concentrate on the backlog of applications until the issue is resolved. You will be contacted regarding this application as soon as it has been examined.

In accordance with the provisions of the Kansas Water Appropriation Act, a portion of which is included below, the use of water prior to approval of the application is unlawful. You should not proceed and divert water as indicated by your plans in your application for a change for this file until you receive approval for this change from the Chief Engineer. Once approved, compliance with the terms, conditions and limitations of the permit is necessary. Conservation of the water resources of Kansas is required.

Section 82a-728 of the Kansas Water Appropriation Act, provides (a) except for the appropriation of water for the purpose of domestic use, . . . it shall be unlawful for any person to appropriate or threaten to appropriate water from any source without first applying for and obtaining a permit to appropriate water in accordance with the provisions of the Water Appropriation Act or for any person to violate any condition of a vested right, appropriation right or an approved application for a permit to appropriate water for beneficial use.

(b) (1) The violation of any provision of this section by any person is a class C misdemeanor... A class C misdemeanor is punishable by a fine not to exceed \$500 and/or a term of confinement not to exceed one month in the county jail. Each day that the violation occurs constitutes a separate offense.
