SUMMARY ORDER APPROVING APPLICATION FOR CHANGE AND IMPOSING CONDITIONS

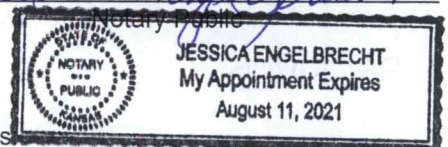

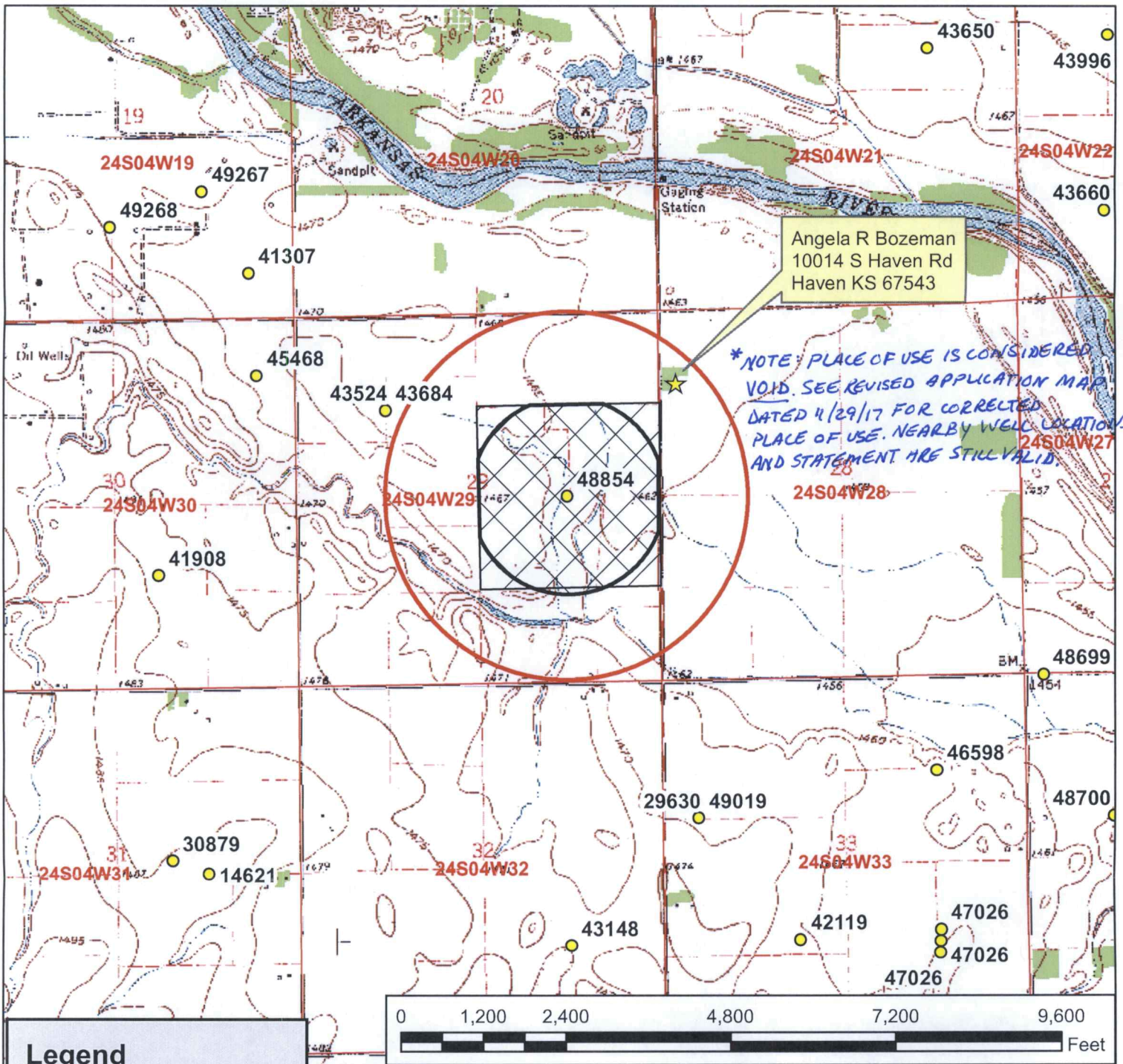

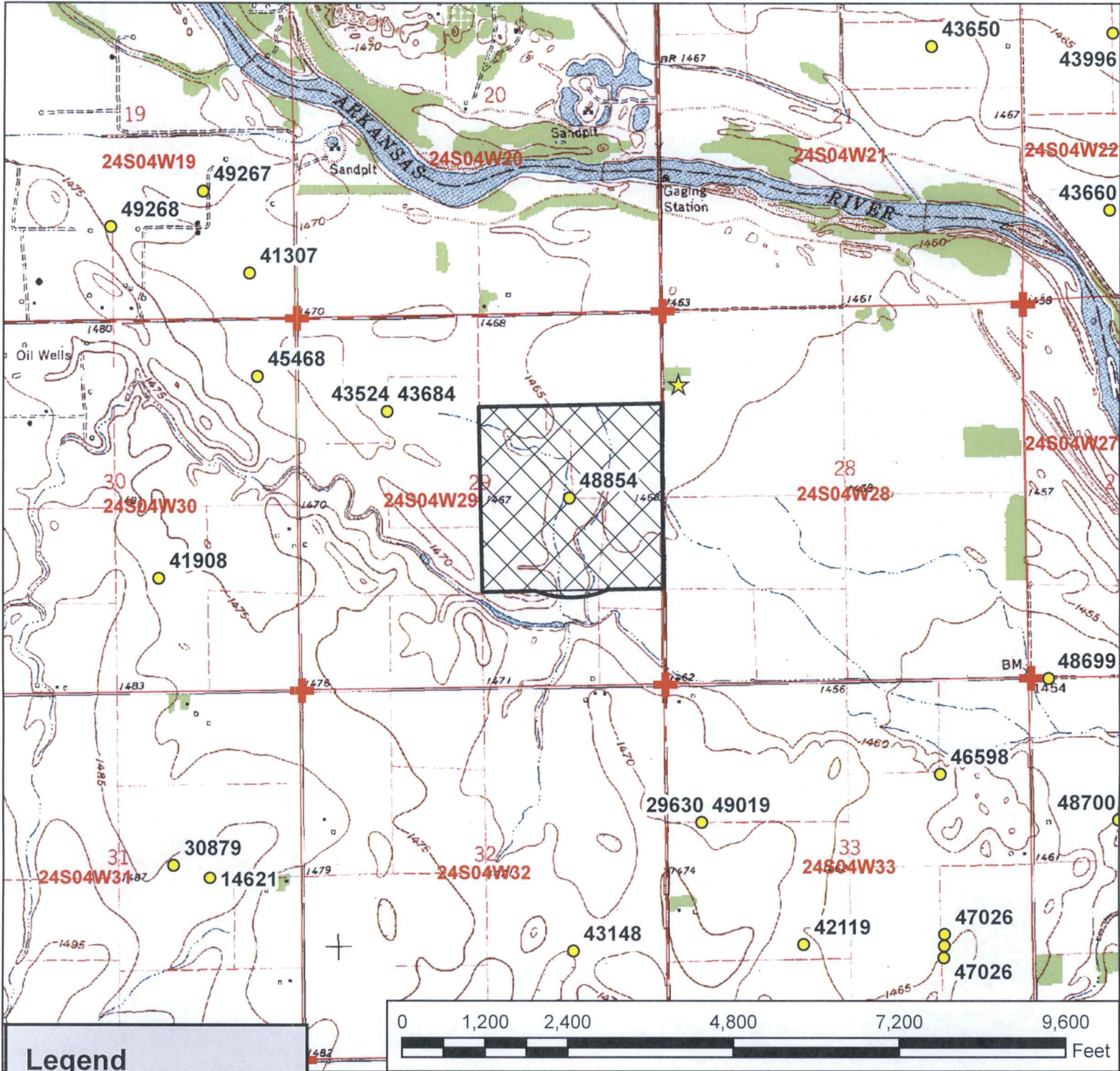

The Equus Beds Groundwater Management District No. 2 reviewed the referenced change in place of use application on December 19, 2017, using the District's Revised Management Program (effective May 1, 1995) and Rules and Regulations K.A.R. 5-22-1 through 5-22-17.

The change application proposes to increase the place of use from 160 acres to 162 acres, which is an increase of 2 acres located immediately south of the currently authorized place of use. The proposed place of use results in a water to land ratio of 1.38 acre-feet per acre.

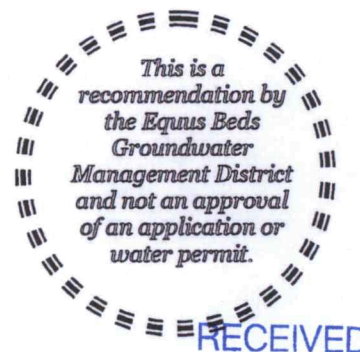
The District's review found that the change application complies with the Revised Aquifer Management program approved by the Chief Engineer and with the District's Rules and Regulations K.A.R. 5-22-1 through 5-22-17.
