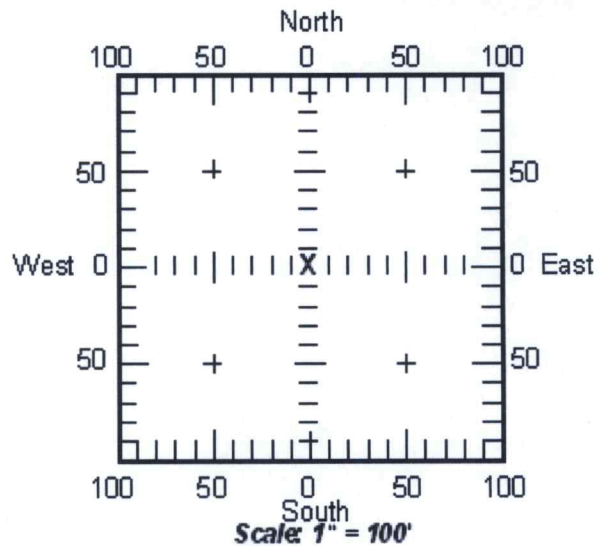

SUMMARY ORDER APPROVING APPLICATION FOR CHANGE AND IMPOSING CONDITIONS

This Summary Order is issued under authority of K.S.A. 82a-708b, as amended, and K.A.R. 5-14-3 and other applicable provisions of the *Kansas Water Appropriation Law, K.S.A. 82a-701 et. seq.*, and rules and regulations promulgated thereunder, K.A.R. 5-1-1 *et. seq.* With the exception of those conditions expressly contained herein, this Summary Order does not change the terms, conditions and limitations of File No. 49,286.

On February 16, 2017, Dennis Woods filed an application for approval to change the authorized point of diversion under File No. 49,286 on behalf of the Dennis W Woods Revocable Trust. This file is for irrigation use in the Arkansas River Basin and there are no overlaps.

File No. 49,286 authorizes a battery of four (4) wells in the Southeast quarter of Section 24, Township 28S, Range 2W. The proposed change will move the geographic center approximately 1094 feet southeast of the currently authorized geographic center location of 1425 north and 1760 west of the southeast corner of Section 24.

The proposed well location appears to meet K.A.R. 5-4-4 *Well spacing* to other nearby wells. The application map indicates seven (7) nearby domestic wells and two nearby (2) non-domestic water wells within one-half mile of the proposed geographic center. Notification letters were sent to each well owner with a response deadline of 15 days; one response was received. Details of the response from Charles Walton (domestic well) are outlined in an email correspondence on file dated February 24, 2017 from Assistant Water Commissioner Cameron Conant.

Based on available information, the local source of supply appears to be Quaternary System (100) and this source of supply will not change. Two test hole logs have been provided and are on file. Because the file has not yet been formally completed, a safe-yield was run at the proposed geographic center location. The analysis determined that the application meets safe-yield requirements.

The file is not in a groundwater management district.

A water flow meter is required. A check valve is required if any chemical or foreign substance is injected into the water through the diversion works.

Based on the above discussion, that the change is reasonable, that impairment to existing water rights is unlikely, and that no change in the local source of supply will occur, it has been recommended that the referenced application be approved.

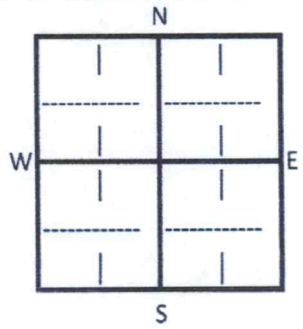

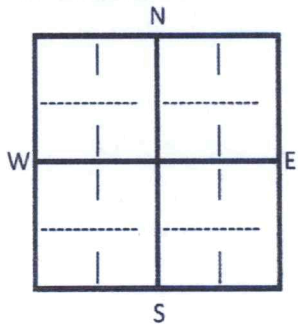

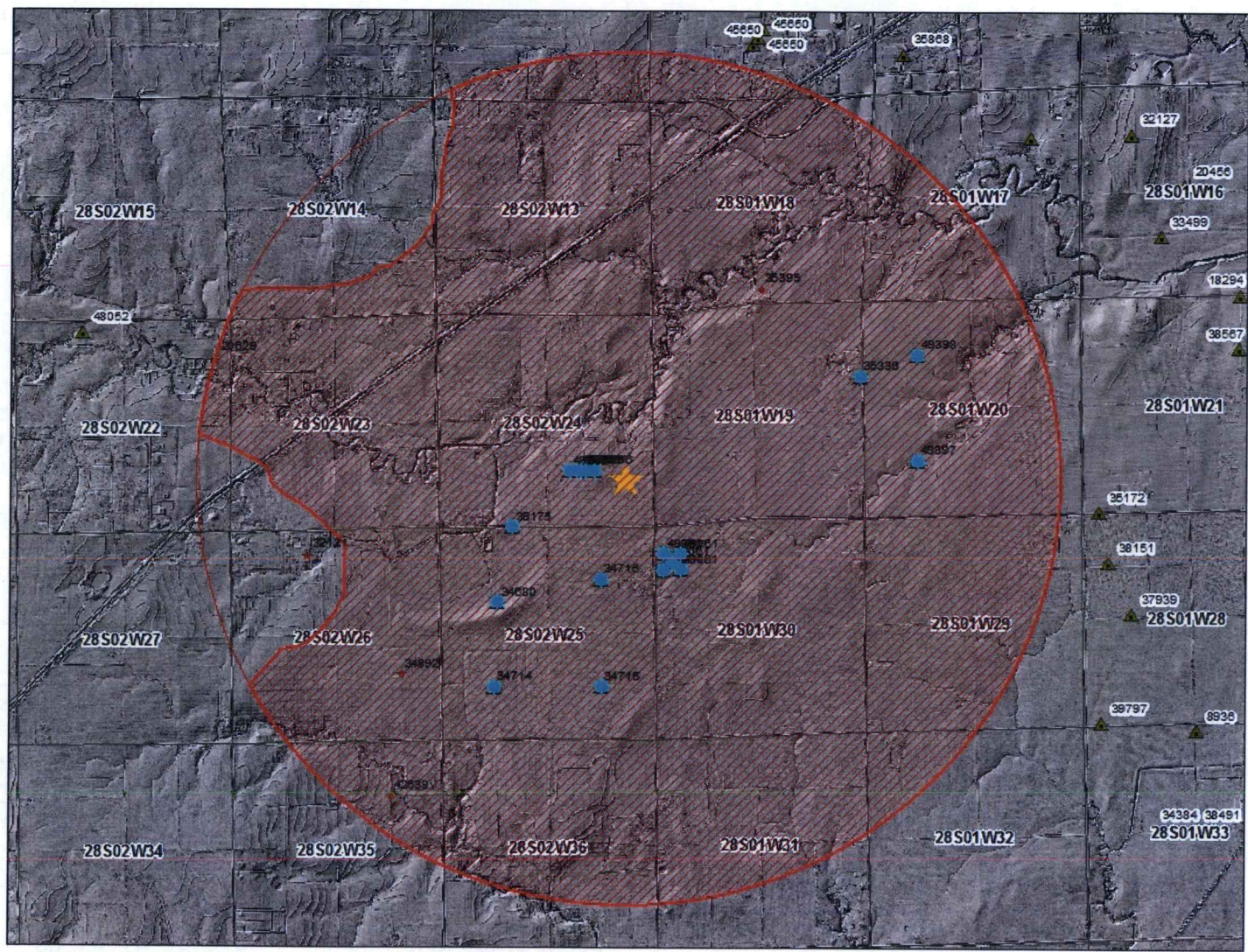

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W. DENNIS WOODS TRUST

THIS TRUST AGREEMENT is made and entered into this 20th day of APRIL, 2000, between W. DENNIS WOODS, the Grantor, and W. DENNIS WOODS of Wichita, Kansas, as Trustee. By execution of this Agreement, the Grantor transfers to the Trustee the property described in Schedule "A", and the Trustee accepts such property as the initial Trust Estate. The Trustee shall hold and dispose of the Trust Estate upon the terms of Trust set forth in this Agreement. Part I disposes of the Trust Estate; Part II contains definitions, powers of the Trustee and other formal provisions.

PART I: TRUST ESTATE

1. NAME AND JURISDICTION. This Trust shall be known as the W. DENNIS WOODS TRUST, and shall be governed by the laws of the State of Kansas.

2. TRUST REVOCABLE BY W. DENNIS WOODS. This Agreement may be amended from time to time, and may be revoked partially or fully by W. DENNIS WOODS during his lifetime by a writing delivered to the Trustee, which shall specify the terms of such amendment or revocation. No other person shall have the right to alter, amend, revoke, or terminate the Trust in whole or in part at any time. By his signature hereto, W. DENNIS WOODS consents not only to the foregoing provision, but to the entire Trust Agreement. No amendment shall increase the duties and responsibilities of the Trustee without his consent.

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3. TRUSTEES BASIC DUTIES. During the term of the Trust, the Trustee shall hold, manage, invest, and reinvest the Trust Estate, collect the income and profits from it, pay the necessary expenses of Trust administration and the Trustee may at the Trustee's sole discretion, pay to Grantor or her designee, all of the net income of the Trust Estate and such portion of the principal thereof or, otherwise, as she directs during her lifetime. In the event that W. DENNIS WOODS, during his lifetime, resigns in writing as Trustee or is determined unable to act as Trustee by reason of incapacity as determined by three (3) persons duly licensed to practice medicine and surgery by the State Board of Healing Arts, BEVERLY K. WOODS, wife of the Grantor, is hereby appointed as Successor Trustee and shall be governed all of the provisions contained herein. In the event that BEVERLY K. WOODS is unable or unwilling to serve in said capacity, then Bryce, Ian and Katelin Woods are hereby appointed as Successor Co-Trustees and he or she shall be governed by all of the provisions contained herein.
