

Conor Gillaspie, on behalf of CMG Outdoors, L.L.C., water right owner, filed an application for approval to change the use made of water from industrial to recreational use for File No. 48,052. The change is being processed in conjunction with the certification of the referenced file number.

File No. 48,052 is not abandoned pursuant to K.S.A. 82a-718.


The certificate for the referenced file number, located in the Arkansas River Basin, will be issued for a quantity not to exceed 1.79 million gallons (5.5 acre-feet) of water per calendar year for industrial use in a groundwater pit with a surface area of 3 acres located in the North Half of the Northwest Quarter (N½ NW¼) of Section 22, Township 28 South, Range 2 West, Sedgwick County, Kansas. WRIS shows no current overlaps. Paragraph No. 3 of the application indicates the pit has not been active since February 10, 2017. The application appears to comply with K.A.R. 5-5-8; this proposal does not appear to increase consumptive use. The proposed change in use made of water from industrial to recreational use will be for evaporative losses from the pit which has a surface area of 3 acres. Pursuant to K.A.R. 5-6-7, *Determination of average annual potential net evaporative loss:*

(3 acres x 22 inches) / 12 inches per foot = 5.5 acre-feet net evaporation from the pit.

WRIS indicated no nearby non-domestic wells. Nearby domestic well owners (based on DWR records and WWC-5 information) within one half-mile of the authorized point of diversion were notified of the proposed change in use made of water by letters dated April 20, 2018 in order to comply with K.S.A. 82a-1906.

In an e-mail dated May 15, 2018 Jeff Lanterman, Water Commissioner of the Stafford Field Office, indicated no objection to approval of the application.

Based on the above discussion, that the change is reasonable, that impairment to existing water rights is unlikely, and no change in the local source of supply will occur, it is recommended that the referenced application be approved.

The Chief Engineer, Division of Water Resources, Kansas Department of Agriculture, after due consideration of the written application of Conor Gillaspie, on behalf of CMG Outdoors, L.L.C., 4800 South 167th Street W, Clearwater, Kansas 67026-8532, received in this office on December 20, 2017, for approval of a change in the use made of water under the certificate of appropriation issued pursuant to the permit to appropriate water for beneficial use, finds that the change is reasonable and will not impair existing rights, and that the application should be and is hereby approved.

The effective date of the change shall be the date this order is executed by the Chief Engineer, after which the authorized use made of water shall be:

Recreational use in a groundwater pit with a surface area of 3 acres located in the North Half of the Northwest Quarter (N $\frac{1}{2}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$) of Section 22, Township 28 South, Range 2 West, Sedgwick County, Kansas,

located substantially as shown on the map accompanying the application to change the use made of water.

In all other respects, the Certificate of Appropriation issued pursuant to Approval of Application, File No. 48,052, for permit to appropriate water for beneficial use, is as stated and set forth in the Certificate of Appropriation dated *May 22, 2018*.

RIGHT TO A HEARING AND TO ADMINISTRATIVE REVIEW

If you are aggrieved by this Order, then pursuant to K.S.A. 82a-1901, you may:

- 1) request an evidentiary hearing before the Chief Engineer, or
- 2) request administrative review by the Secretary of Agriculture.

Failure to request an evidentiary hearing before the Chief Engineer does not preclude your right to administrative review by the Secretary.

To obtain an evidentiary hearing before the Chief Engineer, a written request for hearing must be filed within 15 days after service of this Order as provided in K.S.A. 77-531 (i.e., within a total of 18 days after this Order was mailed to you), with the Kansas Department of Agriculture, Attn: Legal Section, 1320 Research Park Drive, Manhattan, Kansas 66502, or by FAX (785) 564-6777.

If you do not file a request for an evidentiary hearing before the Chief Engineer, you may petition for administrative review of the Order by the Secretary of Agriculture. A petition for review shall be in writing and state the basis for requesting administrative review. The request for review may be denied if the request fails to clearly establish factual or legal issues for review. See K.S.A. 77-527. The petition must be filed within 30 days after service of this Order as provided in K.S.A. 77-531 (i.e., within a total of 33 days after this Order was mailed to you), and be filed with the Secretary of Agriculture, Attn: Legal Division, Kansas Department of Agriculture, 1320 Research Park Drive, Manhattan, Kansas 66502, or by FAX (785) 564-6777.

JOINT STIPULATION FOR DISCONTINUED PIT OR QUARRY

This stipulation is filed to provide information regarding annual evaporative loss from the aquifer and to free the owner from having to file annual water use reports otherwise required as a condition of the approval of the permit. This stipulation is only available when the authorized pit or quarry is no longer used for industrial purposes.

I, cmg outdoors LLC, owner of a sand/gravel pit which is located in the ---, ---, N2 NW4, of Section 22, Township 28 S, Range 2 W, Sedgwick County, Kansas, hereby stipulate as follows:

1. That the pit/quarry is no longer being mined, dredged or otherwise enlarged as of 02/10/17 (Date).
2. That the surface area of the water in the pit/quarry is 3 acres.
3. That based on the average annual evaporation and precipitation in this area, the net average annual evaporation from the pit is 1.83 acre-feet per acre.
4. That the total average annual evaporation from the pit is 5.5 acre-feet.
5. That based on the above information, I agree that the annual water use from this pit or quarry will be 5.5 acre-feet per calendar year.
6. The above information is true and correct to the best of my knowledge and belief.
7. This stipulation shall remain in effect until it is rescinded.
8. Either party may rescind this stipulation in writing between March 1 and December 31 of any calendar year.

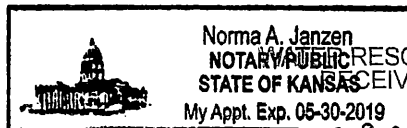

Such violation is a class C misdemeanor, punishable by a fine not to exceed \$500 and/or a term of confinement not to exceed one month in the county jail. K.S.A. 82a-728(b). Civil penalties shall be not less than \$100 nor more than \$1,000 per violation. In the case of a continuing violation, each day such violation continues may be deemed a separate violation. In addition to these penalties the water right may be modified or suspended. K.S.A. 82a-737, as amended.

The application must be signed by all owners of the place of use authorized under the water right and his or her spouse, if married. Please indicate if there is no spouse. If land is being purchased under contract, the seller must sign as landowner until such time as the contract is completed.

In the event that all applicants cannot appear before one notary public, they may as necessary sign separate copies of the application before any notary public conveniently available to them. All copies signed in this manner shall be considered to be valid parts of the application.

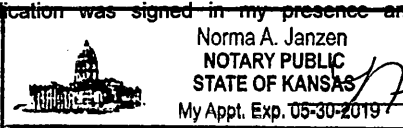

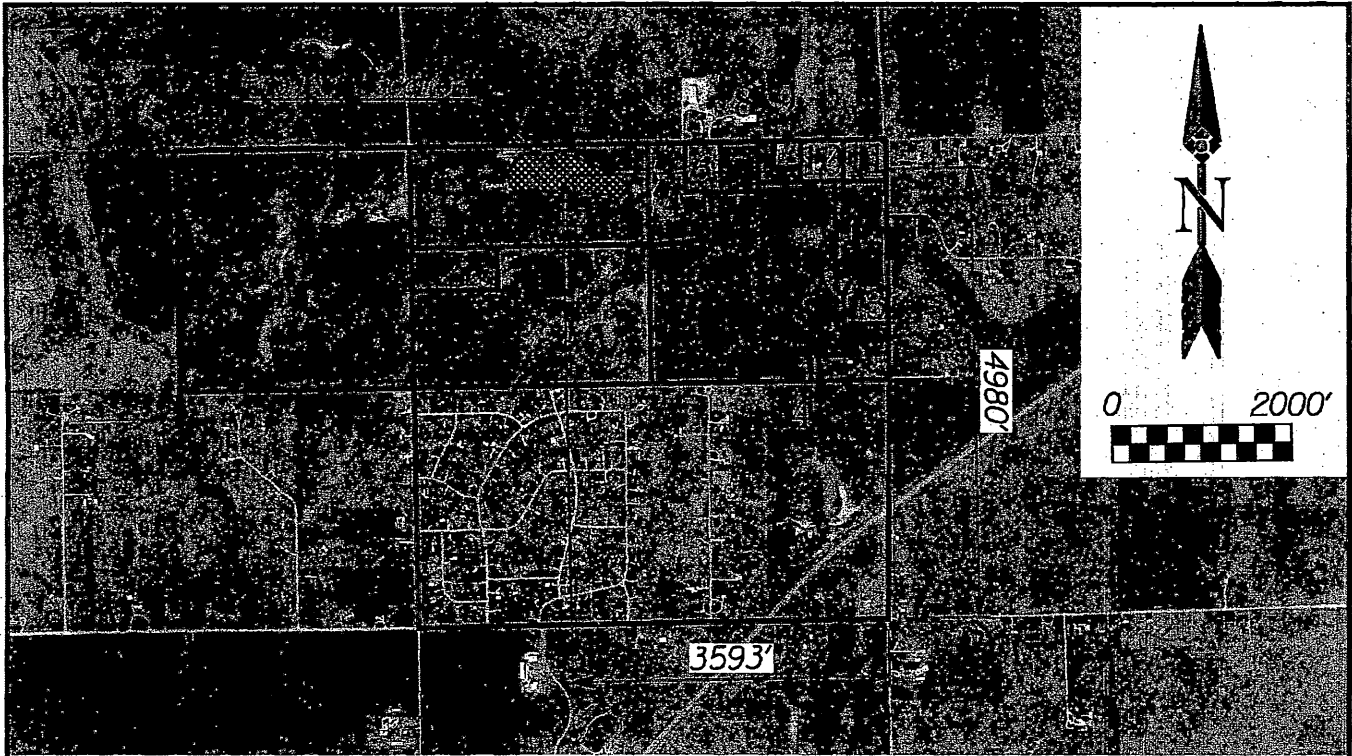



Dear Sir or Madam:

An application for approval of the Chief Engineer to change the following condition or conditions of the file number referred to above has been received:

- place of use UMW
- point of diversion
- use made of water

As a matter of record, the Division of Water Resources has on hand a large number of applications awaiting processing. Therefore, to be fair to all concerned, and so that we can process those applications on hand in the order they were received, we intend to concentrate on the backlog of applications until the issue is resolved. You will be contacted regarding this application as soon as it has been examined.

In accordance with the provisions of the Kansas Water Appropriation Act, a portion of which is included below, the use of water prior to approval of the application is unlawful. You should not proceed and divert water as indicated by your plans in your application for a change for this file until you receive approval for this change from the Chief Engineer. Once approved, compliance with the terms, conditions and limitations of the permit is necessary. Conservation of the water resources of Kansas is required.

Section 82a-728 of the Kansas Water Appropriation Act, provides (a) except for the appropriation of water for the purpose of domestic use, . . . it shall be unlawful for any person to appropriate or threaten to appropriate water from any source without first applying for and obtaining a permit to appropriate water in accordance with the provisions of the Water Appropriation Act or for any person to violate any condition of a vested right, appropriation right or an approved application for a permit to appropriate water for beneficial use.

(b) (1) The violation of any provision of this section by any person is a class C misdemeanor...

A class C misdemeanor is punishable by a fine not to exceed \$500 and/or a term of confinement not to exceed one month in the county jail. Each day that the violation occurs constitutes a separate offense.

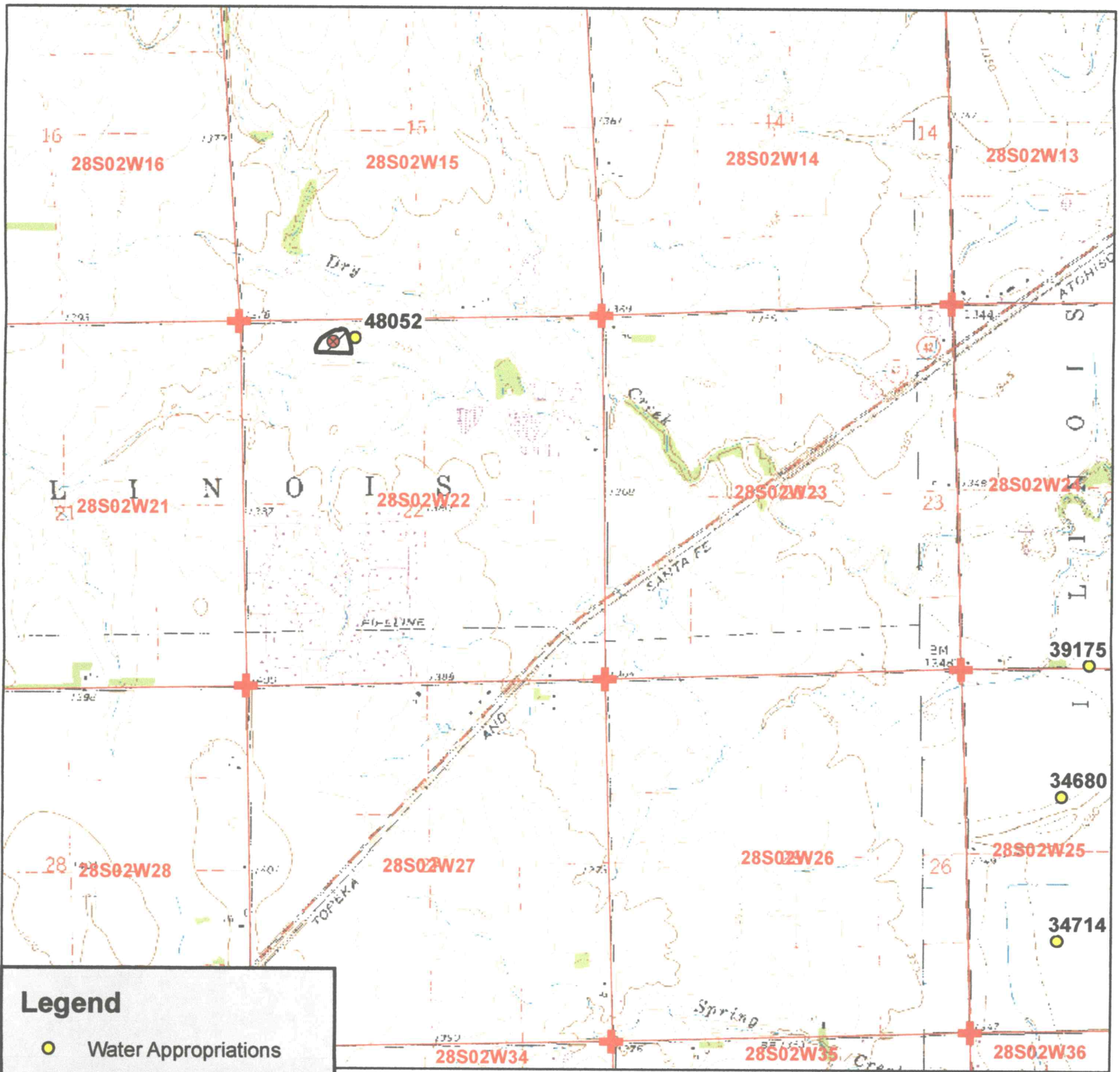
