RE: Water Right File No. 38,387

Darrell N. Wood, trustee on behalf of Darrell N. Wood and Natalie Wood Trust, water right owners, filed an application for approval to change the authorized place of use for the referenced file number, authorized groundwater for irrigation use in the Rattlesnake Creek basin.

The referenced file does not appear abandoned as per K.S.A. 82a-718.

File No. 38,387 is authorized 200 acre-feet from one well for irrigation of 123.60 acres (1.62 af/ac) in Section 32, Township 24 South, Range 16 West, Edwards County, Kansas. There are no overlaps in the authorized point of diversion or place of use. On December 3, 2010, a Findings and Order was issued by the Chief Engineer in response to a reduction in place of use request and an AWEP (Agricultural Water Enhancement Program) affidavit submitted by the water right owners. The Order reduced the authorized place of use from 133.00 acres to 123.60 acres in the Southwest Quarter of Section 32 and placed further conditions on File No. 38,387:

That the authorized place of use shall not be increased unless the water right owner agrees to the requirements described in K.A.R. 5-5-11; and

That if all or part of the water right is sold, legally removed, or the place of use is otherwise modified from the authorized place of use as described in a findings and order, that the water right shall be subject to the maximum reasonable quantity as per K.A.R. 5-3-23 or the monitoring requirements in K.A.R. 5-5-11 where applicable.

The water right owners were not required at that time to reduce the authorized quantity to a reasonable quantity (1.5 af/ac Edwards Co.). However, they agreed in the affidavit to comply with K.A.R. 5-5-11 if they increase the place of use and/or to comply with K.A.R. 5-3-23 and K.A.R. 5-5-11 if all or part of the water right is sold, legally removed, or the place of use is otherwise modified from the authorized place of use as described in a findings and order.

The water right owner initially proposed to move the pivot primarily to the Southeast Quarter of Section 32 and increase the acreage to 133.5 acres. Paragraph No. 7 of the application indicates the purpose of moving the pivot is to locate it on better ground with fewer water holes. Base acres as determined by Stafford Field office staff on February 3, 2020 are 133 acres so the proposal appears to comply with K.A.R 5-5-11, however the proposal does not comply with K.A.R. 5-3-23 because the water right owner wished to retain the authorized 200 acre-feet.

No notices were sent to nearby well owners since the proposal does not exceed base acres by 10 acres or 10 percent.

In a letter dated February 24, 2020, Orrin Feril, Manager of Big Bend Kansas Groundwater Management District No. 5 indicated that the intent of the AWEP program was to incentivize producers to voluntarily remove end guns from center pivot systems. The purpose was to reduce the consumptive use within the Rattlesnake Creek subbasin by reducing the number of acres consuming water by removing the most inefficient portion of the system. Orrin indicated the proposed change nullifies the intent of AWEP and that the District paid for the end gun removal in 2010. The application was presented to the Board of Directors at the February regular board meeting for review. The applicant discussed the issues regarding this center pivot system and the history of the water right file with the Board. The applicant has no desire to increase the acres to 133.5 acres, but rather just move the center pivot system east to better ground and still irrigate the 123.6 acres. Based upon this discussion, the Board voted to recommend approval of this application if amended to 123.6 acres with 200 acre-feet in line with the AWEP provisions from 2010.

After discussion among DWR staff, it was initially determined that a waiver of K.A.R. 5-3-23 would be required to retain the 200 acre-feet. However, in an e-mail dated March 20, 2020, Lane Letourneau, Water Appropriation Program Manager, indicated he had a phone conversation with Chris Beightel, Acting Chief Engineer, and Darrell Wood, applicant, and they came up with an alternative agreement. It was determined since the applicant indicated 25 acres of the current place of use were remaining, those acres could retain the 1.62 acre-feet per acre or 40.5 acre-feet. The balance of the 98.6 acres would have 1.5 acre-feet per acre or 147.9 acre-feet. The water right would be reduced from 200 acre-feet to 188.4 acre-feet or 1.5 acre-feet per acres for the proposed 123.6 acres, which would comply with K.A.R. 5-3-23 and K.A.R. 5-5-11. Lane gave verbal approval to the proposal at the time of the phone conversation.

It was later determined that there will be 8.39 acres of the current place of use remaining, so in an April 13<sup>th</sup> phone conversation with Lane and Jeff Lanterman, Water Commissioner of the Stafford Field Office, it was determined the applicant can retain 1.62 acre-feet/acre on 8.39 acres = 13.59 acre-feet and the balance of 115.21 acres allowed 1.5 acre-feet/acre = 172.82 acre-feet for a total of 186.41 acre-feet to be authorized under File No. 38,387.

The same local source of supply will not change which appears to be undifferentiated Kansan/Nebraskan (180).

Jeff indicated no objection in the April 13, 2020 phone conversation with Lane and me.

A water flow meter is required. Check valves are required if any chemical or foreign substance is injected into the water through the diversion works.

The Chief Engineer, Division of Water Resources, Kansas Department of Agriculture, after due consideration of the written application of Darrell N. Wood, on behalf of Darrell N. and Natalie D Wood Revocable Trusts, 1983 260<sup>th</sup> Avenue, Lewis, Kansas, 67552-5133, received in this office on February 4, 2020, for approval of a change in the location of the place of use under the certificate of appropriation issued pursuant to the application for permit to appropriate water for beneficial use, as modified and amended by the Findings and Order of the Chief Engineer dated December 3, 2010, reducing the authorized place of use, finds that the change is reasonable and will not impair existing rights, that the change relates to the same local source of supply and that the application should be and is hereby approved.

This order effectively reduces the authorized quantity to 186.41 acre-feet in accordance with the Application for Approval to Change the Place of Use, Water Right, File No. 38,387, received in the office of the Chief Engineer on February 4, 2020.

All diversion works into which any type of chemical or other foreign substance will be injected into the water pumped from the diversion works shall be equipped with an in-line, automatic, quick-closing check valve capable of preventing pollution of the source of the water supply. The type of valve installed shall meet specifications adopted by the Chief Engineer and shall be maintained in an operating condition satisfactory to the Chief Engineer.

The water right owner shall properly install an acceptable water meter on the diversion works authorized under this water right, prior to the use of water, in strict accordance with the Kansas Administrative Regulations 5-1-4 through 5-1-12 adopted by the Chief Engineer. The water right owner shall notify the Chief Engineer when installation of the water meter has been completed. The water right owner shall maintain the water meter in an operating condition satisfactory to the Chief Engineer, at all times during diversion of water and shall maintain records from which the total quantity of water diverted may be determined. The water right owner shall also report the reading of said water meter and the total quantity of water diverted annually to the Chief Engineer. Such records shall be furnished to the Chief Engineer by March 1 following the end of each calendar year.





That e-mail Lane sent us back on March 20<sup>th</sup> that indicated that Chris Beightel, Lane and Darrell Wood visited and came to an agreement on the quantity for File No. 38,387 and included Darrell in the email. He indicated that the propose move still had 25 acres of the current place of use. I am kind of paraphrasing Lane's e-mail below, you may have a different interpretation?

Before the PU move. The file is authorized for 200 af on 123.6 acres = 1.62 af/ac

According to Lane's e-mail the proposed move still has 25 acres of the current place of use. I don't know if he is getting credit for those original AWEP acres in the E2 of the SW or what for sure....

Chris, Darrel and Lane agreed to allow Darrel to keep the current 1.62 af/ac per acre on 25 acres. This provides him the original AWEP quantity on these acres. The balance of 98.6 acres will have 1.5 af/ac.

The resulting quantity is 40.5 af + 147.9 af = 188.4 af.

It is my understanding that Lane gave Darrell verbal approval.

Lane indicated those numbers are a little lower than what was discussed as they did not review in detail while on the phone, but that they did agree in concept.

So, I'm really not sure if the quantity is assigned to specific acres or not.....

Chris and I visited with Darrel and we came to an agreement on the quantity for File No. 38,387. Darrel is included in this email. I want to use this email to solidify what we agreed to.

Before the PU move. The file is authorized for 200 af on 123.6 acres. This equals 1.62 af/ac

The proposed move still has 25 acres of the current place of use.

Chris, Darrel and I agreed to allow Darrel to keep the current 1.62 af/ac per acre on 25 acres. This provides him the original AWEP quantity on these acres. The balance of 98.6 acres will have 1.5 af/ac.

The resulting quantity is 40.5 af + 147.9 af = 188.4 af.

We will process this change in headquarters. Because of the two weeks of administrative leave, I gave Darrel verbal approval.

These numbers are a little lower than what we were discussing as we did not review in detail while on the phone. We did agree in concept.

Please review and let me know anything I missed.

### **RIGHT TO A HEARING AND TO ADMINISTRATIVE REVIEW**

If you are aggrieved by this Order, then pursuant to K.S.A. 82a-1901, you may:

- 1) request an evidentiary hearing before the Chief Engineer, or
- 2) request administrative review by the Secretary of Agriculture.

Failure to request an evidentiary hearing before the Chief Engineer does not preclude your right to administrative review by the Secretary.

To obtain an evidentiary hearing before the Chief Engineer, a written request for hearing must be filed within 15 days after service of this Order as provided in K.S.A. 77-531 (i.e., within a total of 18 days after this Order was mailed to you), with: Kansas Department of Agriculture, Attn: Legal Section, 1320 Research Park Drive, Manhattan, KS 66502, FAX (785) 564-6777.

If you do not file a request for an evidentiary hearing before the Chief Engineer, you may petition for administrative review of the Order by the Secretary of Agriculture. A petition for review shall be in writing and state the basis for requesting administrative review. The request for hearing may be denied if the request fails to clearly establish factual or legal issues for review. See K.S.A. 77-527. The petition must be filed within 30 days after service of this Order as provided in K.S.A. 77-531 (i.e., within a total of 33 days after this Order was mailed to you), and be filed with: Secretary of Agriculture, Attn: Legal Division, Kansas Department of Agriculture, 1320 Research Park Drive, Manhattan, KS 66502, FAX (785) 564-6777.

If neither a request for an evidentiary hearing nor a petition for administrative review is filed as set forth above, then this Order shall be effective and become a final agency action as defined in K.S.A. 77-607(b). Failure to timely request either an evidentiary hearing or administrative review may preclude further judicial review under the Kansas Judicial Review Act.
