Calvin Minor, signing as owner of Clark County Feeders Inc., the listed owner of the referenced files authorized for stockwatering use, filed applications to change the place of use on all of the referenced files and point of diversion under File No. 26,959. The applications were received on December 17, 2018, with proposed new appropriations that were assigned File Nos. 50,185; 50,186 & 50,187. The rights are not located with a special use area. These Clark County rights are within the Hydrological Atlas Area.

The subject rights appear to be in compliance with K.S.A. 82a-732 and not abandoned per K.S.A. 82a-718. The applications for change appear to comply with K.A.R. 5-5-2a, *Complete change application*.

The referenced files are certified to provide a limited quantity of 43.695 million gallons (mgy) (134.1 acre-feet) per year from five (5) wells and a battery of four(4) wells with the only overlap in point of diversion between the well identified as Well #4, under File Nos. 26,959 & 38,439, that is limited to 55 gallons per minute with the three(3) other wells authorized under File No. 26,959. Approvals will update the well locations under File Nos. 26,959; 38,438 & 38,439. The actual well locations are within 300 feet of the authorized and comply with K.A.R. 5-5-6, *Failure to construct diversion works at authorized location*.

These wells are not located in a special use area and have had the source of determined to be the Kiowa Formation. Lithology logs of the referenced files with the most recent being the proposed well under File No. 26,959, drilled in June 2019, listing a depth of 135 feet a static water level of 78 feet appears to be common for the wells. The requested change in point of diversion under File No. 26,595, will authorize a point of diversion located in the Northwest Quarter of the Northwest Quarter of the Northeast Quarter (NW¼ NW¼ NE¼) near a point 4,874 feet North and 1,985 feet West of the Southeast corner from a point approximately 5,160 feet North and 2,200 feet West of the Southeast corner all in Section 16, Township 31, Range 25 West Clark County. The change is a distance of approximately 358 feet. It appears the source of supply will remain unchanged. The approval under File No. 26,959 will also update the three(3) other wells authorized. The well under File No. 38,438 will also be updated to the 2008 GPS determined location. The approval for File No. 38,439, will also be updated as it overlaps with the owners identified Well #4 under File No. 26,959.

The old stockwatering well identified by the owner as Well #1 will be retained for domestic use at a house in the NE¼ of Section 16. The change application under File No. 26,959, stated the proposed well does not meet spacing to well CIN 6, 5 & proposed point of diversion CIN 11 under File No. 50,186. It does not appear a waiver of well to well spacing K.A.R. 5-4-4, *Well spacing* would be needed for the proposed change in point of diversion as this regulation in part (a) allows spacing to be sufficient to prevent direct impairment between wells in a common source of supply necessary and where the owner has given permission to reduce the spacing. As the applicant is the owner it would appear consent to reduce spacing has been given. A review of the area indicates there are no other wells other than the applicant/owners located within one-half (½) mile of the proposed well.

As there are only the applicants/owner's wells within one-half (½) mile of the proposed well, under File No. 26,959, no notice for nearby comments on the proposed change were sent.

The currently authorized place of use is located within the Northeast Quarter (NE¼) of Section 16, Township 31 South, Range 25 West, Clark County. The change in place of use has been requested for all the referenced files to expand the feedlot to the South within Section 16, to authorize the NE¼ and the North half of the Southeast (N½ SE¼), and to the East into the North half of the Northwest Quarter (N½ NW¼) of Section 15. The approval will modify the place of use listed on the application to provide a consistent description for half sections. The expansion into Section 15 will add land owned by John S. Wilkey Revocable Trust, as shown on the change and new permit applications. A complete overlap will be authorized under the referenced files and File Nos. 50,158; 50,186 & 50,187. The expansion to the stockwatering facility head count and associated increase in water use will be under the new permits. Their permitting should not result in an increase in consumptive use per K.A.R. 5-5-3, *Change in Consumptive use*, thus complying with K.A.R. 5-5-8, *Standards for approval of an application for a change in the place of use and/or a change in the use made of water*, for the referenced files.

Jeff Lanterman, Water Commissioner was sent a copy of this memorandum for comments and a recommendation on the proposed changes. He indicated in an e-mail dated January 15, 2020, he recommends approval of the changes in-conjunction with the new permits.

Water flowmeters are required according to KSA 82a-706c, for all the referenced files. The proposed change in point of diversion under File No. 26,959, will not require a water level measurement tube will not be required on the new well as all the wells under File No. 26,959, are authorized less that 100 gallons per minute. Additionally, as a WWC-5 log was obtained from the KGS water well web site, a WWC-5 will not be a condition of the approval.

Based on the above discussion, that new permits will be issued for the expansion, the changes appear to be reasonable, that impairment to existing water rights is unlikely, that there are no pending applications within the vicinity of the proposed changes and filed prior that may be affected by the approvals and that no change in the local source of supply will occur, it is recommended that the applications be approved.



I don't know Brandon. I'm certainly not comfortable recommending approval of the new applications for a total of 241.1 AF while increasing the capacity to 24,000 cattle. This equates to only 9 gallons per head per day. The maximum is 15 GPHD...based on this, we could allow an expansion to 14,350 cattle. The applicant could provide information to us to show how and why they could operate with only 9 gallons per head per day. Cameron,

Just wanted to see where we were on the above mentioned applications as the applicant called to check the status today. I think the last item of business was an email I sent to Stafford back in October about a potentially approving the application with a reduced quantity and making sure that would be adequate for the number of cattle. Please see below from October.

I started working application # 50,185, 50,186 50,187 for Clark County Feed Inc. They are requesting a total of 269.157 Acre-feet of water for stock watering up to 24,000 head of cattle. They are currently authorized 134.1 acre-feet of water for 12,000 head of cattle. They are looking to upsize their operation and hence have filed new applications to appropriate water. They are located in DUA area BLC-67. This area only has 107 acre-feet of available. With these new applications being filed, they are asking for an additional 135 acre-feet of water to get to the total of 269.157 acre-feet. Therefore there would only be 107 acre-feet available instead of the 135 acre-feet requested. This new volume based off of that would be 241 acre-feet for 24,000 cattle. This would equate out to roughly 9 gallon per head of cattle per day. Is this an acceptable number in your mind or what are your thoughts on this? Thanks
