Jaeger Enterprises LLC filed the referenced application for a permit to appropriate water for beneficial use, proposing the appropriation of 224 acre-feet of groundwater for irrigation use. The application proposed the geographic center of a four (4) well battery located in the Southeast Quarter of the Southeast Quarter (SE½ SE½ NW½) of Section 28, more particularly described as being near a point 2,910 feet North and 2,760 feet West of the Southeast corner of said section, in Township 30 South, Range 25 West, Clark County, Kansas.

That the proposed point of diversion is located within South-Central Kansas Designated Unit Area, BLC-67. Based on the original quantity of water available in this designated unit (5,557 acre-feet) and the current quantity of water appropriated (5,558 acre-feet), there remains no water available in Designated Unit Area, BLC-67.

The applicant was sent a letter on December 10, 2020, explaining the safe yield evaluation and stating that it would be recommended to the Chief Engineer that pending application, File No. 50,243 be denied and dismissed due to the failure to meet safe yield criteria, as required by K.A.R. 5-3-10 and K.A.R. 5-3-11. The applicant was provided 15 days (until December 25, 2020) to either (1) submit additional information to our office or (2) request additional time beyond the 15 days to submit additional information.

No response of any kind was received from the applicant. Therefore, based on the existing information, it is recommended that the referenced application be denied and dismissed for failure to meet safe yield criteria.

FINDINGS AND ORDER IN THE MATTER OF THE DISMISSAL OF APPLICATION FILE NO. 50,243

After due consideration, the Chief Engineer, Division of Water Resources, Kansas Department of Agriculture (hereinafter referred to as the "Chief Engineer"), makes the following findings and order:

FINDINGS

- 1. That on April 22, 2019, the Chief Engineer received an application from Jaeger Enterprises LLC for a permit to appropriate water for beneficial use, assigned File No. 50,243, proposing the appropriation of 224 acre-feet of groundwater for irrigation use. The application proposed the geographic center of a four (4) well battery to be located in the Southeast Quarter of the Southeast Quarter of the Northwest Quarter (SE½ SE½ NW½) of Section 28, more particularly described as being near a point 2,910 feet North and 2,760 feet West of the Southeast corner of said section, in Township 30 South, Range 25 West, Clark County, Kansas.
- 2. That the proposed point of diversion is located within South-Central Kansas Designated Unit Area, BLC-67. Based on the original quantity of water available in this designated unit (5,557 acre-feet) and the current quantity of water appropriated (5,558 acre-feet), there remains **no** water available in Designated Unit Area, BLC-67.
- 3. That on December 10, 2020, a letter was mailed to the applicant stating that the application did not comply with the safe yield requirements of K.A.R. 5-3-10 and K.A.R. 5-3-11, and that the application would be submitted to the Chief Engineer with a recommendation that the pending application be denied and dismissed, for failure to meet safe yield criteria. The applicant was provided 15 days, until December 25, 2020, to either submit additional information to our office or request additional time, prior to final action on the application.
- 4. That the applicant, has not submitted additional information for consideration, nor requested an extension of time, for Application, File No. 50,243, thus the application should be denied and dismissed, and its priority forfeited for failure to comply with K.A.R. 5-3-10 and K.A.R. 5-3-11.

ORDER

NOW, THEREFORE, It is the decision and order of the Chief Engineer, Division of Water Resources, Kansas Department of Agriculture, that effective the date of this order, in accordance with the law, Application, File No. 50,243, is herewith dismissed and the priority assigned to it is considered to be forfeited.

Petition for Review. The applicant, if aggrieved by this Order, may petition for administrative review, pursuant to K.S.A. 82a-71 1(c) and K.S.A. 82a-1 90 1(a). The petition must be filed within 30 days after the date shown on the Certificate of Service attached to this Order and must set forth the basis for the review, unless stayed by the timely filing of a request for hearing. Any request for hearing or petition for administrative review shall be in writing and shall be submitted to the attention of: Secretary of Agriculture; Attn: Legal Division, Kansas Department of Agriculture, 1320 Research Park Drive, Manhattan, Kansas 66502, FAX (785) 564-6777.

RIGHT TO A HEARING AND TO ADMINISTRATIVE REVIEW

If you are aggrieved by this Order, then pursuant to K.S.A. 82a-1901, you may request an evidentiary hearing before the Chief Engineer or request administrative review by the Secretary of Agriculture. Failure to request an evidentiary hearing before the Chief Engineer does not preclude your right to administrative review by the Secretary.

To obtain an evidentiary hearing before the Chief Engineer, a written request for hearing must be filed within 15 days after service of this Order as provided in K.S.A. 77-531 (i.e., within a total of 18 days after this Order was mailed to you), with: Kansas Department of Agriculture, Attn: Legal Division, 1320 Research Park Drive, Manhattan, Kansas 66502, FAX 785-564-6777.

If you do not file a request for an evidentiary hearing before the Chief Engineer, you may petition for administrative review of the Order by the Secretary of Agriculture. A petition for review shall be in writing and state the basis for requesting administrative review. The request for review may be denied if the request fails to clearly establish factual or legal issues for review. See K.S.A. 77-527. The petition must be filed within 30 days after service of this Order as provided in K.S.A. 77-531 (i.e., within a total of 33 days after this Order was mailed to you), and be filed with: Secretary of Agriculture, Attn: Legal Division, Kansas Department of Agriculture, 1320 Research Park Drive, Manhattan, Kansas 66502, FAX 785-564-6777.

If neither a request for an evidentiary hearing nor a petition for administrative review is filed as set forth above, then this Order shall be effective and become a final agency action as defined in K.S.A. 77-607(b). Failure to timely request either an evidentiary hearing or administrative review may preclude further judicial review under the Kansas Judicial Review Act.
