RE: Application, File No. 50,354

Randy and Shelly Shumate filed the referenced application for a permit to appropriate water for beneficial use, proposing the appropriation of 256 acre-feet of groundwater for irrigation use. The application proposed using an existing well site located in the Northeast Quarter of the Southeast Quarter of the Northeast Quarter (NE $\frac{1}{4}$, NE $\frac{1}{4}$, NE $\frac{1}{4}$) of Section 6, Township 25 South, Range 25 West in Clark County.

The proposed point of diversion is located within South-Central Kansas Designated Unit Area, BLC-67. Based on the original quantity of water available in this designated unit (5,557 acre-feet) and the current quantity of water appropriated 5,558 acre-feet), there remains **no water available** in Designated Unit Area, BLC-67.

The applicant was sent a letter on November 20, 2020 explaining the safe yield evaluation and stating that it would be recommended to the Chief Engineer that pending application, File No. 50,354 be denied and dismissed due to the failure to meet safe yield criteria, as required by K.A.R. 5-3-10 and K.A.R. 5-3-11. The applicant was provided 15 days (December 6, 2020) to either (1) submit additional information to our office or (2) request additional time beyond the 15 days to submit additional information. An additional letter was sent to the applicant on December 8, 2020 providing the applicant 15 days (December 23, 2020) to either (1) submit additional information to our office or (2) request additional information after a conversation with the Stafford Field Office on December 7, 2020 until December 23, 2020.

No response of any kind was received from the applicant. Therefore, based on the existing information, it is recommended that the referenced application be denied and dismissed for failure to meet safe yield criteria.

FINDINGS AND ORDER IN THE MATTER OF THE DISMISSAL OF APPLICATION FILE NO. 50,354

After due consideration, the Chief Engineer, Division of Water Resources, Kansas Department of Agriculture (hereinafter referred to as the "Chief Engineer"), makes the following findings and order:

FINDINGS

- That on February 24, 2020, the Chief Engineer received an application from Randy and Shelly Shumate for a permit to appropriate water for beneficial use, assigned File No. 50,354, proposing the appropriation of 256 acre-feet of groundwater for irrigation use. The application proposed using an existing well located in the Northeast Quarter (NE¼), more specifically 5,135 feet North and 35 feet West of the Southeast Quarter of Section 6, in Township 30 South, Range 25 West, Clark County, Kansas.
- 2. That the proposed point of diversion is located within South-Central Kansas Designated Unit Area, BLC-67. Based on the original quantity of water available in this designated unit (5,557 acre-feet) and the current quantity of water appropriated (5,558 acre-feet), there remains <u>no</u> <u>water available</u> in Designated Unit Area, BLC-67.
- 3. That on November 20, 2020, a letter was mailed to the applicant stating that the application did not comply with the safe yield requirements of K.A.R. 5-3-10 and K.A.R. 5-3-11, and that the application would be submitted to the Chief Engineer with a recommendation that the pending application be denied and dismissed, for failure to meet safe yield criteria. The applicant was provided 15 days, until December 6, 2020, to either submit additional information to our office or request additional time, prior to final action on the application.
- 4. That on December 7, 2020, the applicant talked to the Stafford Field Office requesting more time to submit additional information for this application. A letter was mailed December 8, 2020, providing the applicant 15 days, until December 23, 2020, to either submit additional information to our office or request additional time, prior to final action on the application.
- 5. That the applicant, has not submitted additional information for consideration, nor requested an extension of time, for Application, File No. 50,354, thus the application should be denied and dismissed and its priority forfeited for failure to comply with K.A.R. 5-3-10 and K.A.R. 5-3-11.

ORDER

NOW, THEREFORE, It is the decision and order of the Chief Engineer, Division of Water Resources, Kansas Department of Agriculture, that effective the date of this order, in accordance with the law, Application, File No. 50,354, is herewith dismissed and the priority assigned to it is considered to be forfeited.

RIGHT TO A HEARING AND TO ADMINISTRATIVE REVIEW

If you are aggrieved by this Order, then pursuant to K.S.A. 82a-1901, you may:

- 1) request an evidentiary hearing before the Chief Engineer, or
- 2) request administrative review by the Secretary of Agriculture.

Failure to request an evidentiary hearing before the Chief Engineer does not preclude your right to administrative review by the Secretary.

To obtain an evidentiary hearing before the Chief Engineer, a written request for hearing must be filed within 15 days after service of this Order as provided in K.S.A. 77-531 (i.e., within a total of 18 days after this Order was mailed to you), with: Kansas Department of Agriculture, Attn: Legal Section, 1320 Research Park Drive, Manhattan, KS 66502, FAX (785) 564-6777.

If you do not file a request for an evidentiary hearing before the Chief Engineer, you may petition for administrative review of the Order by the Secretary of Agriculture. A petition for review shall be in writing and state the basis for requesting administrative review. The request for hearing may be denied if the request fails to clearly establish factual or legal issues for review. See K.S.A. 77-527. The petition must be filed within 30 days after service of this Order as provided in K.S.A. 77-531 (i.e., within a total of 33 days after this Order was mailed to you), and be filed with: Secretary of Agriculture, Attn: Legal Division, Kansas Department of Agriculture, 1320 Research Park Drive, Manhattan, KS 66502, FAX (785) 564-6777.

If neither a request for an evidentiary hearing nor a petition for administrative review is filed as set forth above, then this Order shall be effective and become a final agency action as defined in K.S.A. 77-607(b). Failure to timely request either an evidentiary hearing or administrative review may preclude further judicial review under the Kansas Judicial Review Act.
