FINDINGS AND ORDER IN THE MATTER OF THE DISMISSAL OF APPLICATION FILE NO. 50,366

After due consideration, the Chief Engineer, Division of Water Resources, Kansas Department of Agriculture (hereinafter referred to as the "Chief Engineer"), makes the following findings and order:

FINDINGS

- 1. That on March 27, 2020, the Chief Engineer received an application from Kent Koster for a permit to appropriate groundwater for beneficial use, assigned File No. 50,366, proposing the appropriation of 179 acre-feet of water, at a maximum requested diversion rate of 500 gallons per minute, for irrigational use. The applicant requested 60 days to locate the specific point of diversion within the Northeast Quarter of Section 4, Township 28 South, Range 4 West, Sedgwick County, Kansas.
- 2. That on January 15, 2021, the original application was returned to the applicant, with a cover letter requesting that additional information be submitted in order to complete the application. The applicant was provided a deadline of March 15, 2021, the time in which to provide the requested information and return the application. The applicant was informed that the application would be dismissed if it was not returned by the deadline, or within any authorized extension of time.
- 3. That a reminder letter was sent to the applicant on February 15, 2021 once again stating the March 15, 2021 date that the original application was required to be returned as a final deadline.
- 4. That the original application was not returned by the March 15, 2021 deadline.
- 5. That the application should be dismissed and its priority forfeited as provided by K.S.A. 82a-710, for failure to return the application.

ORDER

NOW, THEREFORE, It is the decision and order of the Chief Engineer, Division of Water Resources, Kansas Department of Agriculture, that effective the date of this order, in accordance with the law, Application, File No. 50,366, is herewith dismissed and the priority assigned to it is considered to be forfeited.
