File Nos. 30,677 and 31,260.

Steve Butts has filed an application for approval to change the authorized place of use under Water Right, File Nos. 30677 and 31260. The applicant has requested to add additional acreage to the authorized place of use. Currently, both water rights form a complete overlap in point of diversion and place of use covering 140 acres. A change in 1994 created the complete overlap. The referenced water rights do not appear abandoned as per K.S.A. 82a-718.

A base acre review was completed by Jeff Lanterman in 2016. The review indicates these files have separate and unique base acres that were developed individually prior to 1994. Since there was no overlap in acres prior to 1994, the base acreage can be applied separately to each file. File No. 30677 was determined to have 105 base acres and File No. 31260 has 60 base acres. File No. 30677 could be increased to 115 acres and 31260 could be increased to 66 acres providing a total of 181 acres that could be irrigated under a base acre change.

This change is requesting a swing arm to be added to the pivot which would increase the irrigation from 140 acres to 170 acres. This proposal to increase to 170 acres is allowed and reasonable based on the 2016 base acre review and as further explained in paragraph 2.

File Nos. 30677 and 31260 form a complete point of diversion overlap. File No. 30677 is authorized 138 AF @ 570 GPM and 31260 is authorized 72 AF @ 600 GPM, for a total of 210 AF. 210 AF on 170 acres is 1.23 AF/acre which is considered reasonable to irrigate in Sumner County where the minimum reasonable is 1.01 AF/acre and the maximum allowed is 1.3 AF/acre.

There was one nearby well within one half mile as shown on the revised map. A nearby letter is not necessary to send on this type of place of use change application and furthermore, the marked well is owned by the applicant.

In an e-mail on November 3, 2021, Jeff Lanterman, Water Commissioner of the Stafford Field Office, indicated no objections to approval of the referenced change applications.

A water flow meter is required. A check valve is required if chemigating.

Based on the above discussion that the changes are reasonable, that impairment to existing water rights is unlikely, and that no change in the local source of supply will occur, it is recommended that the referenced applications be approved.

Jeff, Brandon assisted the applicant and worked this p/u change app. Brandon and I had quite a few email discussions early on to get this application reviewed, modified, explained, and then I didn't realize it didn't get formally finished to be sent out with the field office review until Brandon just reminded us last week before I left.

So, this is a field office p/u change that could have been worked in our office. They are proposing to increase the current pivot irrigation acreage by adding a swing arm. In 2016 you did a base acre review on this file and determined File 30677 had 105 base and 31260 had 60 base. Since these were developed separately, they have an individual base so they can technically increase base on each file by 10 ac/10% or 115 + 66 for a maximum of 181 total acres. This is also explained in the memo. This change to a swing arm is requesting 170 acres so we are within the base acre allowance. If approved, the change will authorize 210 AF on 170 acres which is 1.23 AF/acre which is squarely in between the minimum of 1.01 AF/acre and maximum of 1.3 AF/acre.

There was a new application (No. 50515) that was filed to the west and had an incomplete overlap with 30677 & 31260. The new app was modified to be a complete overlap with these files. Brandon is also working the new application. A letter of dismissal was recently sent for failure to meet SY. Brandon said that process is ongoing, perhaps trying to find a new location or something. Regardless, whatever happens with that file doesn't really have anything to do with this P/U change application (if the new app ends up going through in any form, it either needs to be a complete P/U overlap or be a completely different P/U).

The p/u changes that are filed are reasonable and ok, generally would have been a FO change. We can recommend approval of these applications. Please pass on to Brandon. Thanks,

Brandon,

I think it would be good to explain more in the memo about the 1994 change application that originally overlapped these rights to cover the currently authorized 140 acres. Explain that both rights have separate and unique base acres that were developed prior to the 1994 change application. File 30677 has 105 base acres and File 31260 has 60 base acres (per the base acre review from Jeff Lanterman noted in emails in 2016). Per the reg we can increase 10 acres or 10% on base whichever is less, so the proposal to irrigate 170 acres with the swing arm is reasonable based on the developed base acres of both files.

Also, the map needs to be showing nearby well owners names and addresses.

located substantially as shown on the topographic map accompanying the application to change the place of use, and the location of the authorized point of diversion shall be better described as:

one (1) well located in the Northeast Quarter of the Southwest Quarter of the Northeast (NE¼ SW¼ NE¼) of Section 13, more particularly described as being near a point 3,949 feet North and 2,088 feet West of the Southeast corner of said section, in Township 30 South, Range 1 East, Sumner County, Kansas.

All diversion works into which any type of chemical or other foreign substance will be injected into the water pumped from the diversion works shall be equipped with an in-line, automatic, quick-closing check valve capable of preventing pollution of the source of the water supply. The type of valve installed shall meet specifications adopted by the Chief Engineer and shall be maintained in an operating condition satisfactory to the Chief Engineer.

The water right owner shall properly install an acceptable water meter on each of the diversion works authorized under this water right, prior to the use of water, in strict accordance with the Kansas Administrative Regulations 5-1-4 through 5-1-12 adopted by the Chief Engineer. The water right owner shall notify the Chief

Engineer when installation of the water meter has been completed. The water right owner shall maintain the water meter in an operating condition satisfactory to the Chief Engineer, at all times during diversion of water and shall maintain records from which the total quantity of water diverted may be determined. The water right owner shall also report the reading of said water meter and the total quantity of water diverted annually to the Chief Engineer. Such records shall be furnished to the Chief Engineer by March 1 following the end of each calendar year

In all other respects, the Certificate of Appropriation issued pursuant to Approval of Application the, File No. 30,677 for permit to appropriate for beneficial use, is as stated and set forth in the Certificate of Appropriation dated June 1, 1988, as modified and amended by the aforementioned order.


