Summary

An Application to Change an Existing Water Right was received in this office on May 24, 2023. John Houghton requested to change the authorized place of use in McPherson County, Kansas.

Currently Authorized Rate, Quantity and Use Made of Water

The currently authorized point of diversion is located in the Southwest Quarter of 4-20S-1W. It authorizes 121 AF at a rate of 560 GPM on 114 acres for irrigation use. This well is sourced in Equus Beds.

Note: There is an incomplete Term Permit: 20209060 that was received on August 17, 2020. A recommendation from GMD2 for this permit was never received. This permit will be approved along with this change as a point of diversion overlap with File No. 13,020

Proposed Changes

There will be a net increase of four (4) acres added to the currently authorized place of use, however it will reallocate the authorized acres to the following:

Base acres were determined by Tyler Saryerwinnie of the Stafford Field Office on May 22, 2020

K.A.R 5-5-11 (b)(3)

Since the proposed 118 acres exceeds the allowable increase of 10% of the 80 base acres, a monitoring contract with the Equus Beds Groundwater Management District (GMD2) and limited quantity are required.

- The GMD2 monitoring contract was received to this office on January 2, 2025.
- Per K.A.R 5-5-11(b)(E)(I): The authorized quantity of water under the water right shall be limited to a 5-year fixed allocation with the following formula: (McPherson Co. NIR 50% Rainfall/.85) * base acres * 5
 - o McPherson NIR 50% Rainfall = 0.90 feet
 - Base acres = 80
 - \circ (0.90/0.85) *80 *5 = 423.529 AF total for 5-year allocation (NOTE: this is not a flex allocation)
- Per K.A.R 5-5-11(b)(E)(ii): The approval of the change shall be conditioned so that the use of water in
 excess of the 5-year allocation shall result in a two-year suspension of all water use under that water
 right and a subsequent restriction of the authorized place of use to the base acreage at a location
 specifically set forth in the change approval.

Nearby Water Rights and Wells

Nearby letters were mailed on September 11, 2024, to Water Right owner Larry Becker of File No. 28,958; and David Skiba and Alex & Melanie Unruh whom of which have domestic wells. No responses were received.

Nearest Active Non-Domestic: File No. 28,958 approximately 1,492 ft from the proposed well.

Nearest Domestic: Alex & Melanie Unruh approximately 1,845 ft from the proposed well.

Recommendations

A letter requesting that GMD2 provide a recommendation as well as a monitoring contract was sent on October 23, 2024. A recommendation to approve the place of use change was received on December 17, 2024, and the GMD2 Monitoring contract was received on January 2, 2025. Per email with Water Commissioner Jeff Lanterman of the Stafford Field Office dated March 25, 2025 there is no objection to the approval of this change application, along with a request to include the expanded meter requirements of "Anti-reverse Gears and sealing to the pipe" conditions on the approval order.

After due consideration of the written application from John C. Houghton, and Dennis C. and Betty L. Houghton, on behalf of Quadrangle Company, LLC, received in this office on May 24, 2023, for approval of a change in place of use, under the Certificate of Appropriation for Beneficial Use issued on December 3, 1980, the Chief Engineer, Division of Water Resources, Kansas Department of Agriculture, finds that the change is reasonable and will not impair existing rights, that the change relates to the same local source of supply, and that the application should be and is hereby approved.

The effective date of the change shall be the date this order is executed by the Chief Engineer, after which the authorized place of use shall be:

a total of 118 acres in Section 4, Township 20 South, Range 1 West, McPherson County, Kansas, located substantially as shown on the topographic map accompanying the application to change the authorized place of use.

By this approval, this water right is subject to the following conditions:

- 1. The quantity of water authorized under Water Right, File No. 13,020 shall not exceed 423.529 acre-feet per five (5) year period; the first period being calendar years 2025 through 2029, ad infinitum.
- 2. The quantity of water authorized under Water Right, File No. 13,020 shall not exceed 121 acre-feet per calendar year, provided that 423.529 acre-feet per five (5) year period is not exceeded.
- 3. The use of water in excess of 423.529 acre-feet per five (5) year period shall result in a two (2) year suspension of all water use under this water right, effective the next two (2) calendar years, and a subsequent restriction of the authorized place of use to the following described property:

4. If the Equus Beds Groundwater Management District No. 2 and/or the Division of Water Resources terminate(s) their/its Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) pertaining to K.A.R. 5-5-11(b)(3)(A) by which the District assumes monitoring responsibility, then the place of use authorized by this change approval, which was issued by the Division pursuant to the MOU shall revert to the property described in paragraph No. 2, starting the calendar year following the year of termination.

Prior to the use of water, an acceptable anti-reverse totalizing water flowmeter shall be installed and maintained on the diversion works authorized by this water right in accordance with Kansas Administrative Regulations 5-1-4 through 5-1-12 adopted by the Chief Engineer. This water flowmeter shall be used to provide an accurate quantity of water diverted as required for the annual water use report (including the meter reading at the beginning and end of the report year). A seal shall be placed on the required water flowmeter by the Division of Water Resources in such a manner as to render the meter non-removable from the measuring chamber without breaking the seal. If the seal is broken without the written permission of the chief engineer, this shall create a rebuttable presumption that the point of diversion had been unlawfully operated in violation of the order of the chief engineer and that the water right holder had been acting in violation of the conditions of his or her water right.

The diversion works shall be equipped with an in-line, automatic, quick-closing check valve capable of preventing pollution of the source of the water supply if any type of chemical or other foreign substance will be injected into the water pumped. The type of valve installed shall meet specifications adopted by the Chief Engineer and shall be maintained in an operating condition satisfactory to the Chief Engineer.

In all other respects, the Certificate of Appropriation for Beneficial Use issued pursuant to Approval of Application, File No. 13,020, for permit to appropriate water for beneficial use, is as stated and set forth in the Certificate of Appropriation dated December 3, 1980, remains as authorized.

RIGHT TO A HEARING AND TO ADMINISTRATIVE REVIEW

If you are aggrieved by this Order, then pursuant to K.S.A. 82a-1901, you may request an evidentiary hearing before the Chief Engineer or request administrative review by the Secretary of Agriculture. Failure to request an evidentiary hearing before the Chief Engineer does not preclude your right to administrative review by the Secretary.

To obtain an evidentiary hearing before the Chief Engineer, a written request for hearing must be filed within 15 days after service of this Order as provided in K.S.A. 77-531 (i.e., within a total of 18 days after this Order was mailed to you), with: Kansas Department of Agriculture, Attn: Legal Section, 1320 Research Park Drive, Manhattan, KS 66502, FAX (785) 564-6777.

If you do not file a request for an evidentiary hearing before the Chief Engineer, you may petition for administrative review of the Order by the Secretary of Agriculture. A petition for review shall be in writing and state the basis for requesting administrative review. The request for hearing may be denied if the request fails to clearly establish factual or legal issues for review. See K.S.A. 77-527. The petition must be filed within 30 days after service of this Order as provided in K.S.A. 77-531 (i.e., within a total of 33 days after this Order was mailed to you), and be filed with: Secretary of Agriculture, Attn: Legal Division, Kansas Department of Agriculture, 1320 Research Park Drive, Manhattan, Kansas 66502, FAX 785-564-6777.

If neither a request for an evidentiary hearing nor a petition for administrative review is filed as set forth above, then this Order shall be effective and become a final agency action as defined in K.S.A. 77-607(b). Failure to timely request either an evidentiary hearing or administrative review may preclude further judicial review under the Kansas Judicial Review Act.
