1. Summary

An *Application to Change an Existing Water Right* was received in this office on January 27, 2023. Gerald Hirt submitted a change in place of use for the referenced file number.

This file does not appear to be abandoned as per K.S.A. 82a-718. The notification for the proposed change per K.S.A. 82a-1906 does not appear to be needed as the point of diversion is not moving and the quantity and rate of diversion will not be modified.

The place of use is located in Section 29, Township 29 South, Range 13 West in Pratt County, Kansas.

2. Source of Supply

As the well is not moving the local source of supply will remain the same. The source of supply has been listed in the WRIS database as Quaternary System (Code 100) of the Medicine Lodge River. A test log submitted with the application for appropriation shows a depth of approximately 173 feet with a static water level of 103 feet. The file is located in the Big Bend Groundwater Management District No. 5 (GMD 5) and is enrolled in a GMD 5 Place of Use Monitoring Agreement.

3. Change Application, File No. 45,520

3.1 Currently Authorized Rate, Quantity and Use Made of Water

The currently authorized point of diversion is a well for irrigation use, located as follows:

- One well located in the Northeast Quarter of the Northwest Quarter of the Southwest Quarter (NE% NW% SW%) of Section 29, Township 29 South, Range 13 West.
- The well authorizes 149 acre-feet at a rate of 835 gallons per minute on 126 acres.
- The maximum reasonable quantity for irrigation in Pratt County is 1.4 acre-feet per acre. The referenced water appropriation is 1.18 acre-foot per acre.

3.2 Proposed Changes

The applicants have requested to modify the place of use to the to add 194 acres to the place of use for a total of 320 acres. If approved, this change will be enrolled in a GMD#5 monitoring agreement with a 5-year allocated quantity of 745 acre-feet. The point of diversion will also be modified to reflect more accurate location using GPS obtained by DWR staff during the compliance investigation.

3.3.a Compliance of proposed changes

- See GMD 5 Monitoring Agreement
 - o GMD 5 will assume monitoring responsibility.

- The authorized quantity of water under File No. 45,520 will remain limited to a five-year fixed allocation of 745 acre-feet.
- Use of water in excess of the five-year allocation shall result in a two-year suspension of all water use under the referenced rights and subsequent restriction of the authorized place of use to the base acres at the location specifically set forth in the change approvals.

3.4 Nearby Water Rights and Landowners

There are no other appropriation wells within 1,320 feet, or domestic wells within reported 660 feet of the authorized point of diversion. No nearby well owners were notified since a new well is not being drilled and source and quantity will not be changed.

4. Recommendations

In a letter dated December 18, 2024, Orrin Feril, Manager of the Big Bend Kansas Groundwater Management District No. 5, recommended the application be approved. Water Commissioner recommendation place holder. Based on the above discussion, that the change is reasonable, that impairment to existing water rights is unlikely and that no change in the local source of supply will occur, it is recommended that the proposed change be approved for File No. 45,520.

Jeff, this is for Gerald Hirt to enter a 5 year p/u monitoring agreement with GMD#5 agreeing to take on the monitoring responsibilities. This is a new agreement and as such, Orrin took it to the board for review and they recommended approval to enter the monitoring.

Taylor and I filled this application out (been a while, it was filed in January 2023) so I have some familiarity with it. Basically the change requests to allow irrigation on the entire west half of the section. In reality it will be 2 pivots but we went ahead and covered the west half hoping to head off any future potential p/u issues on it. I'm interested to see how he crops and farms this because there isn't enough water to run both pivots. He is authorized 149 AF at 835 GPM and he ended up with 149 AF x 5 for a total of 745 AF in the 5 year allocation. The 5 year allocation calculation is as follows: $50\%NIR/0.85 \times 30\%NIR/0.85 \times 30\%N$

On the new 5 year monitoring agreement applications we have been adding a seal to pipe and AR gear requirement. I think it is appropriate to add that additional condition on this application as well. I hope our cover letter can clearly state his annual quantity as well as his 5 year quantity. I could see them treating this like a MYFA and over pumping the annual quantity right off the bat!

I think the FO can recommend approval with the additional condition for AR and seal to pipe, with the understanding that GMD will be monitoring it.

The Chief Engineer, Division of Water Resources, Kansas Department of Agriculture, after due consideration of the written application of Gerald and Sandra Hirt, and Aaron and Rachel Hirt, Post Office Box 77, Sawyer, Kansas, 67134-0077, received in this office on January 27, 2023, for approval of a change place of use under the Certificate of Appropriation issued pursuant to Water Right, File No. 45,520, finds that the change is reasonable and will not impair existing rights, that the change relates to the same local source of supply and that the application should be and is hereby approved.

2. That if the Big Bend Groundwater Management District (GMD) No. 5 and/or the Division of Water Resources terminate(s) their/its Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) pertaining to K.A.R. 5-5-11(b)(3), (4) and (5), by which the District assumes monitoring responsibility, then the place of use authorized by this change approval, which was issued by the Division pursuant to the MOU, shall revert to the property described in Paragraph No. 3, above, starting the calendar year following the year of termination.

The water right owner shall properly install an acceptable water meter on each of the diversion works authorized under this water right, prior to the use of water, in strict accordance with the Kansas Administrative Regulations 5-1-4 through 5-1-12 adopted by the Chief Engineer. The water right owner shall notify the Chief Engineer when installation of the water meter has been completed. The water right owner shall maintain the water meter in an operating condition satisfactory to the Chief Engineer, at all times during diversion of water and shall maintain records from which the total quantity of water diverted may be determined. The water right owner shall also report the reading of said water meter and the total quantity of water diverted annually to the Chief Engineer. Such records shall be furnished to the Chief Engineer by March 1 following the end of each calendar year.

The owner of the Water Right shall install an anti-reverse totalizing water flowmeter which meets or exceeds the specifications adopted by the Chief Engineer.

A seal shall be placed on the water flowmeter by Division of Water Resources in such a manner as to render the meter non-removable from the measuring chamber without breaking the seal. If the seal is broken without the written permission of the Chief Engineer, this shall create a rebuttable presumption that the point of diversion had been unlawfully operated in violation of the order of the Chief Engineer and that the water right holder had been acting in violation of the conditions of his or her water right. If any such violation occurs, a written order shall be issued by the Chief Engineer stating the nature of the violation and the civil penalty, suspension of water right or modification to the water right, or any combination of these to be imposed.

All diversion works into which any type of chemical or other foreign substance will be injected into the water pumped from the diversion works shall be equipped with an in-line, automatic, quick-closing check valve capable of preventing pollution of the source of the water supply. The type of valve installed shall meet specifications adopted by the Chief Engineer and shall be maintained in an operating condition satisfactory to the Chief Engineer.

In all other respects, the Certificate of Appropriation issued pursuant to Approval of Application, File No. 45,520, for permit to appropriate water for beneficial use, is as stated and set forth in the Certificate of Appropriation dated January 19, 2010.



Since the enclosed order modifies the Certificate of Appropriation for the above referenced water right, it should be recorded with the Register of Deeds as other instruments affecting real estate.

RIGHT TO A HEARING AND TO ADMINISTRATIVE REVIEW

If you are aggrieved by this Order, then pursuant to K.S.A. 82a-1901, you may request an evidentiary hearing before the Chief Engineer or request administrative review by the Secretary of Agriculture. Failure to request an evidentiary hearing before the Chief Engineer does not preclude your right to administrative review by the Secretary.

To obtain an evidentiary hearing before the Chief Engineer, a written request for hearing must be filed within 15 days after service of this Order as provided in K.S.A. 77-531 (i.e., within a total of 18 days after this Order was mailed to you), with: Kansas Department of Agriculture, Attn: Legal Section, 1320 Research Park Drive, Manhattan, KS 66502, FAX (785) 564-6777.

If you do not file a request for an evidentiary hearing before the Chief Engineer, you may petition for administrative review of the Order by the Secretary of Agriculture. A petition for review shall be in writing and state the basis for requesting administrative review. The request for hearing may be denied if the request fails to clearly establish factual or legal issues for review. See K.S.A. 77-527. The petition must be filed within 30 days after service of this Order as provided in K.S.A. 77-531 (i.e., within a total of 33 days after this Order was mailed to you), and be filed with: Secretary of Agriculture, Attn: Legal Division, Kansas Department of Agriculture, 1320 Research Park Drive, Manhattan, Kansas 66502, FAX 785-564-6777.

If neither a request for an evidentiary hearing nor a petition for administrative review is filed as set forth above, then this Order shall be effective and become a final agency action as defined in K.S.A. 77-607(b). Failure to timely request either an evidentiary hearing or administrative review may preclude further judicial review under the Kansas Judicial Review Act.
