<u>MEMORANDUM</u>

FROM: Brandon Milner **RE:** Application, File No. 50,392

Paul Lange has filed the above referenced application to appropriate groundwater for an application to appropriate water on April 29, 2020, and was assigned Application, File No. 50,392.

A letter was sent to the applicant for failure to meet safe yield, more specifically Designated Unit Area (DUA) No. 6 on February 14, 2022, with a deadline of March 1, 2022, to request an extension or provide additional information. The applicant requested an extension to provide additional information and an email dated March 4, 2022, was sent to the applicant giving an extension to May 1, 2022. A letter was sent to the applicant on October 3, 2022, giving a deadline of October 19, 2022, to provide additional information or request additional time to provide additional data since the original deadline of May 1, 2022, was overlooked.

In an e-mail message dated October 14, 2022, the applicant requested that the application be held in accordance with K.A.R. 5-3-4c to determine whether actions on other water rights could result in the application complying with the safe yield requirements. Specifically, at the time that request was made, it was noted that no notice of completion had yet been filed on the approved permit pertaining to File No. 50,333. As of November 11, 2024, the owner has reported completing the diversion works. The earliest perfection period in this DUA (also File No. 50,333) won't expire until December 31, 2028. Based on this information, no additional water has become available for appropriation.

Based on the available information, and that the application does not comply with safe yield requirements, it is recommended that the file be dismissed.

FINDINGS AND ORDER IN THE MATTER OF THE DISMISSAL OF APPLICATION TO APPROPRIATE WATER FILE NO. 50,392

After due consideration, the Chief Engineer, Division of Water Resources, Kansas Department of Agriculture (hereinafter referred to as the "Chief Engineer"), makes the following findings and order:

FINDINGS

- 1. That on April 29, 2020, the Chief Engineer received an application from Paul S. Lange, for a permit to appropriate groundwater for beneficial use, assigned File No. 50,392, proposing the appropriation of 180 acre-feet of water, at a maximum requested diversion rate of 800 gallons per minute, for irrigation use, from a battery of up to four (4) wells with a geographical center located in the Northwest Quarter of the Southeast Quarter of the Southwest Quarter (NW¼ SE¼ SW¼) of Section 12, Township 32 South, Range 4 West, Sumner County, Kansas.
- 2. That the Kansas Water Appropriation Act, in K.S.A. 82a-711, requires the Chief Engineer to consider whether a proposed use will prejudicially and unreasonably affect the public interest, and shall take into consideration established minimum desirable streamflow requirements, the area, safe yield, and recharge rate of the appropriate water supply, the priority of existing claims of all persons to use the water of the appropriate water supply, the amount of each claim to use water from the appropriate water supply, and all other matters pertaining to such question.
- 3. That K.A.R. 5-3-9 states that it shall be considered to be in the public interest that only the safe yield of any source of water supply, including hydraulically connected sources of water supply, shall be appropriated, and K.A.R. 5-3-10 and K.A.R. 5-3-11 set forth the methodology for determining safe yield.
- 4. That K.A.R. 5-1-1(vvv) defines "safe yield" as the long-term sustainable yield of the source of supply, including hydraulically connected surface water or groundwater.
- 5. That on February 14, 2022, a letter was mailed to the applicant, stating that the application failed to comply with the safe yield requirements, that the application would be submitted to the Chief Engineer with a recommendation for denial, and that the applicant had an opportunity to submit additional information to be considered, which must be submitted by March 1, 2022, or within any authorized extension of time.
- 6. That the applicant requested and was granted an extension date of May 1, 2022, to provide additional information and no additional information was submitted.

7. That on October 3, 2022, a letter was mailed to the applicant, reiterating that the application failed to comply with the safe yield requirements, that the application would be submitted to the Chief Engineer with a recommendation for denial, and that the applicant had an opportunity to submit additional information to be considered, which must be submitted by October 19, 2022, or within any authorized extension of time.

- 8. That the application was held from further processing in response to electronic correspondence from the applicant, dated October 14, 2022, requesting the application be retained, in accordance with K.A.R. 5-3-4c, to determine whether pending actions on other water rights, within the area of consideration for the new application, might result in the application complying with safe yield.
- 9. That no pending actions on other water rights, within the area of consideration for the new application, have resulted in the application currently complying with safe yield and the amount of time allowed for retaining the application, as provided by K.A.R. 5-3-4c, has expired.
- 10. That K.A.R. 5-3-4c states that if the application still cannot be approved at the end of the time set forth by the Chief Engineer, the application shall be dismissed by the Chief Engineer and the priority of the application forfeited.
- 11. That Application, File No. 50,392, should be denied and dismissed and its priority forfeited as provided by K.S.A. 82a-711, K.A.R. 5-3-4c, K.A.R. 5-3-9, K.A.R. 5-3-10 and K.A.R. 5-3-11.

ORDER

NOW, THEREFORE, It is the decision and order of the Chief Engineer, Division of Water Resources, Kansas Department of Agriculture, that effective the date of this order, in accordance with the law, Application, File No. 50,392, is herewith dismissed and the priority assigned to it is considered to be forfeited.

RIGHT TO A HEARING AND TO ADMINISTRATIVE REVIEW

If you are aggrieved by this Order, then pursuant to K.S.A. 82a-1901, you may request an evidentiary hearing before the Chief Engineer or request administrative review by the Secretary of Agriculture. Failure to request an evidentiary hearing before the Chief Engineer does not preclude your right to administrative review by the Secretary.

To obtain an evidentiary hearing before the Chief Engineer, a written request for hearing must be filed within 15 days after service of this Order as provided in K.S.A. 77-531 (i.e., within a total of 18 days after this Order was mailed to you), with: Kansas Department of Agriculture, Attn: Legal Division, 1320 Research Park Drive, Manhattan, Kansas 66502, FAX 785-564-6777.

If you do not file a request for an evidentiary hearing before the Chief Engineer, you may petition for administrative review of the Order by the Secretary of Agriculture. A petition for review shall be in writing and state the basis for requesting administrative review. The request for review may be denied if the request fails to clearly establish factual or legal issues for review. See K.S.A. 77-527. The petition must be filed within 30 days after service of this Order as provided in K.S.A. 77-531 (i.e., within a total of 33 days after this Order was mailed to you), and be filed with: Secretary of Agriculture, Attn: Legal Division, Kansas Department of Agriculture, 1320 Research Park Drive, Manhattan, Kansas 66502, FAX 785-564-6777.

If neither a request for an evidentiary hearing nor a petition for administrative review is filed as set forth above, then this Order shall be effective and become a final agency action as defined in K.S.A. 77-607(b). Failure to timely request either an evidentiary hearing or administrative review may preclude further judicial review under the Kansas Judicial Review Act.
