Summary

Max D Fisher Trust filed the above referenced applications to appropriate water for beneficial use. Application 51,034 is located within the Rattlesnake Creek drainage basin. The applicant originally filed application 51,034 with the intention of moving water from senior file 37,961 to 51,034. Instead, the applicant has decided to move the water from 37,961 to application 51,169 and instead file a new application to replace 51,034. Application 51,184 effectively replaces 51,034 and will instead be using water from senior file 27,580. The applicant has signed the voluntary dismissal form for 51,034. Therefore, it is recommended that application 51,034 be dismissed as per the applicant's request.

After receiving a recommendation to deny applications 51,169 and 51,184 from Big Bend Groundwater Management District #5, the applicant elected to voluntarily dismiss the applications. The applicant has signed the voluntary dismissal forms for 51,169 and 51,184. Therefore, it is recommended that both application 51,169 and 51,184 be dismissed as per the applicant's request.

FINDINGS AND ORDER IN THE MATTER OF THE DISMISSAL OF APPLICATION TO APPROPRIATE WATER FOR BENFICIAL USE FILE NO. 51,184

- 1. That on February 13, 2024, an Application to Appropriate Water for Beneficial Use was received in the office of the Chief Engineer, assigned File No. 51,184, proposing to use water for irrigation use from the following point of diversion:
 - one (1) well located in the Southwest Quarter of the Northeast Quarter of the Southeast Quarter (SW¼ NE¼ SE¼) of Section 27, more particularly described as being near a point 1,352 feet North and 1,272 feet West of the Southeast corner of said section, in Township 24 South, Range 11 West, Stafford County, Kansas.
- 2. That on December 4, 2024, the office of the Chief Engineer received a voluntary dismissal form, signed by the applicant, pertaining to File No. 51,184, indicating that all plans to proceed with the proposed appropriation had been abandoned.
- 3. That Application, File No. 51,184, should be dismissed as requested by the applicant.

If no petition for administrative review is filed as set forth above, then this Order shall be effective and become a final agency action as defined in K.S.A. 77-607(b). Failure to timely request administrative review may preclude further judicial review under the Kansas Judicial Review Act.
