Mike Vancampen has filed the above referenced application to appropriate groundwater for recreational use and requested 60 days to locate the point of diversion on August 15, 2024. The application was returned to the applicant on September 11, 2024, providing 60 days to locate the point of diversion, provide additional information, and return the application by a November 11, 2024 deadline. The applicant requested an extension of time and a letter dated November 12, 2024 providing a new deadline of January 11, 2025. The requested information was not provided nor was an extension requested by the January 11, 2025 so it is recommended that 51,295 be dismissed.

**FINDINGS AND ORDER
IN THE MATTER OF THE
DISMISSAL OF APPLICATION
FILE NO. 51,295**

After due consideration, the Chief Engineer, Division of Water Resources, Kansas Department of Agriculture (hereinafter referred to as the "Chief Engineer"), makes the following findings and order:

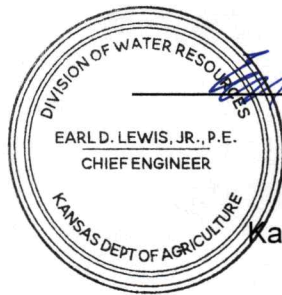
FINDINGS

1. That on August 15, 2024, the Chief Engineer received an application from Mike Vancampen, for a permit to appropriate groundwater for beneficial use, assigned File No. 51,295, proposing the appropriation of 15 acre-feet of water, at a maximum requested diversion rate of 99 gallons per minute, for recreational use.
2. That the Kansas Water Appropriation Act, in K.S.A. 82a-710, states that if an application is found to be defective, inadequate or insufficient to determine the nature and amount of the proposed appropriation, the applicant must correct or complete the application by submitting additional information within such time as may be approved by the Chief Engineer.
3. That in accordance with K.A.R. 5-3-1, the application was accepted for filing provided the applicant supply a more specific location for the proposed point of diversion within the nominal legal quarter-section in the Southwest Quarter (SW $\frac{1}{4}$) of Section 16, Township 26 South, Range 10 West, Reno County, Kansas, within 60 days.
4. That on September 11, 2024, a letter was mailed to the applicant, describing the additional information which must be submitted in order to complete the application, including the specific well location(s), a stratographic log of a well or test hole within 300 feet of the proposed well(s), and a topographic map depicting the location of the proposed point of diversion and place of use, allowing the applicant until November 11, 2024, in which to provide the required information, stating that the application would be dismissed if it was not submitted by that deadline, or within any authorized extension of time.
5. That the applicant requested and was provided an extension of time to submit the required information, with the extended deadline of January 11, 2025.
6. That the required information was not submitted by the January 11, 2025, deadline, nor did the applicant request an extension of time in which to do so.
7. That the incomplete application should be dismissed and its priority forfeited in accordance with K.S.A. 82a-710.

ORDER

NOW, THEREFORE, It is the decision and order of the Chief Engineer, Division of Water Resources, Kansas Department of Agriculture, that effective the date of this order, in accordance with the law, Application, File No. 51,295, is herewith dismissed and the priority assigned to it is considered to be forfeited.
