Don Duane Thompson et al, filed applications for approval to change the authorized points of diversion and places of use for the referenced file numbers, both authorized groundwater for irrigation use in the Republican River Basin in the Lower Republican area.

The water rights do not appear abandoned as per K.S.A. 82a-718.

The referenced file numbers are each authorized one well and have no overlaps in their authorized points of diversion or places of use, all located in Section 22, Township 4 South, Range 4 West, Republic County. The applicants propose to create an exact overlap in the authorized place of use and to "flip-flop" the authorized rates and quantities between the well authorized by File No. 6,420 (2620'N, 3,375'W of SE corner of Sect 22/114AF@1,070 g.p.m.) and the well authorized by File No. 8,447 (565'N, 2,620'W of SE corner of Sect 22/75AF@600 g.p.m.), a distance move of approximately 2,189 feet. No new wells will be drilled.

The proposed change in point of diversion for File No. 8,447 does not appear to comply with K.A.R. 5-5-13 *Relocation of alluvial wells* since the proposed move involves a move of just over 10 percent closer to the Republican River. The applicant has requested a waiver of K.A.R. 5-5-13 since a net quantity of 39 acre-feet of water will be moved away from the stream channel. Paragraph No. 3 of the application indicates the proposal will allow the stronger of the two wells to have a higher allocation. It appears the proposal meets well spacing requirements.


According to the application maps and WRIS, there are three irrigation wells and seven domestic(WWC-5) wells within one-half mile of the proposed existing wells. Nearby well owners were notified of the proposed changes by letters dated September 14, 2017. On September 26, 2017 Mikkel Stensaas called to inquire about the proposed changes and ask how a higher diversion rate could be placed on a well that certified a lower diversion rate but did not want to object to the change applications. No written objections have been received as of today's date.

No well logs were submitted with the applications. However, it appears that the same local source of supply will not change, previously determined to be Main Stem Alluvium (113).

The water right owners also propose to create a complete overlap in the authorized place of use between the referenced file numbers for a total of 128 acres to be authorized. Paragraph No. 3 of the applications indicates the owners will convert from flood irrigation to a center pivot. No new acres will be irrigated according to the map. The net irrigation requirement for the 50% chance of rainfall in Republic County with 85% efficiency is 0.98 acre-feet/acre. The total quantity authorized, 189 acre-feet, will irrigate the proposed 128 acres with 1.48 acre/feet per acre, which appears reasonable in Republic County.

In an e-mail dated October 9, 2017, 2017, Kelly Stewart, Water Commissioner of the Stockton Field Office, indicated that he would support the waiver of K.A.R. 5-5-13 and approval of the referenced change applications.

Water flow meters are required. Check valves are required if any chemical or foreign substance is injected into the water through the diversion works.

The Chief Engineer, Division of Water Resources, Kansas Department of Agriculture, after due consideration of the written application of Opal M. Thompson, and Tom S. and Cynthia S. Thompson, 1068 Xavier Road, Concordia, Kansas 66901, and Don D. Thompson, 18720 Pine Road, Argos, Indiana 46501-9745, received in this office on July 21, 2017, for approval of a change in the location of the place of use and point of diversion under the certificate of appropriation issued pursuant to the application for permit to appropriate water for beneficial use, as modified and amended by the Order of the Chief Engineer dated November 19, 2013, approving the application to change the authorized point of diversion, finds that the change is reasonable and will not impair existing rights, that the change relates to the same local source of supply and that the application should be and is hereby approved.

The effective date of the change shall be the date this order is executed by the Chief Engineer, after which the authorized location of the place of use shall be:

a total of 128.00 acres in Republic County, Kansas, and the authorized location of the point of diversion shall be:

one (1) well located in the Northwest Quarter of the Northeast Quarter of the Southwest Quarter (NW¼ NE¼ SW¼) of Section 22, more particularly described as being near a point 2,620 feet North and 3,375 feet West of the Southeast corner of said section, in Township 4 South, Range 4 West, Republic County, Kansas,

located substantially as shown on the map accompanying the application to change the place of use and point of diversion.

Installation of the works for diversion of water shall be completed on or before December 31, 2018, or within any authorized extension of time. The water right owner shall notify the Chief Engineer of the Division of Water Resources, Kansas Department of Agriculture, when construction of the works for diversion has been completed.

All diversion works into which any type of chemical or other foreign substance will be injected into the water pumped from the diversion works shall be equipped with an in-line, automatic, quick-closing check valve capable of preventing pollution of the source of the water supply. The type of valve installed shall meet specifications adopted by the Chief Engineer and shall be maintained in an operating condition satisfactory to the Chief Engineer.

The water right owner shall properly install an acceptable water meter on the diversion works authorized under this water right, prior to the use of water, in strict accordance with the Kansas Administrative Regulations 5-1-4 through 5-1-12 adopted by the Chief Engineer. The water right owner shall notify the Chief Engineer when installation of the water meter has been completed.

The water right owner shall maintain the water meter in an operating condition satisfactory to the Chief Engineer, at all times during diversion of water and shall maintain records from which the total quantity of water diverted may be determined. The water right owner shall also report the reading of said water meter and the total quantity of water diverted annually to the Chief Engineer. Such records shall be furnished to the Chief Engineer by March 1 following the end of each calendar year.

In all other respects, the Certificate of Appropriation issued pursuant to Approval of Application, File No. 8,447, for permit to appropriate water for beneficial use, is as stated and set forth in the Certificate of Appropriation dated April 29, 1975, as modified and amended by the aforementioned order.

RIGHT TO A HEARING AND TO ADMINISTRATIVE REVIEW

If you are aggrieved by this Order, then pursuant to K.S.A. 82a-1901, you may:

- 1) request an evidentiary hearing before the Chief Engineer, or
- 2) request administrative review by the Secretary of Agriculture.

Failure to request an evidentiary hearing before the Chief Engineer does not preclude your right to administrative review by the Secretary.

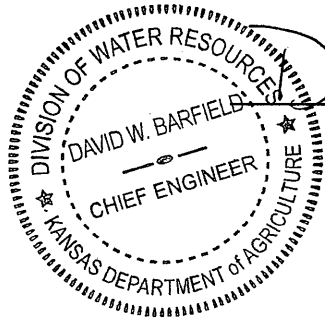
To obtain an evidentiary hearing before the Chief Engineer, a written request for hearing must be filed within 15 days after service of this Order as provided in K.S.A. 77-531 (**i.e., within a total of 18 days after this Order was mailed to you**), with: Kansas Department of Agriculture, Attn: Legal Section, 1320 Research Park Drive, Manhattan, KS 66502, FAX (785) 564-6777.

If you do not file a request for an evidentiary hearing before the Chief Engineer, you may petition for administrative review of the Order by the Secretary of Agriculture. A petition for review shall be in writing and state the basis for requesting administrative review. The request for hearing may be denied if the request fails to clearly establish factual or legal issues for review. See K.S.A. 77-527. The petition must be filed within 30 days after service of this Order as provided in K.S.A. 77-531 (**i.e., within a total of 33 days after this Order was mailed to you**), and be filed with: Secretary of Agriculture, Attn: Legal Division, Kansas Department of Agriculture, 1320 Research Park Drive, Manhattan, KS 66502, FAX (785) 564-6777.

If neither a request for an evidentiary hearing nor a petition for administrative review is filed as set forth above, then this Order shall be effective and become a final agency action as defined in K.S.A. 77-607(b). Failure to timely request either an evidentiary hearing or administrative review may preclude further judicial review under the Kansas Judicial Review Act.

Any request for hearing or petition for administrative review shall be in writing and shall be submitted to the attention of: Chief Legal Counsel, Kansas Department of Agriculture, 1320 Research Park Drive, Manhattan, Kansas 66502, Fax: (785) 564 - 6777.

K.A.R. 5-5-13 Relocation of alluvial wells

RE: Water Right, File No. 8,447

1. That K.A.R. 5-5-13 states in part: "If an authorized point of diversion is a well that has its source of supply an alluvium in a reach of a basin that is fully appropriated or closed to new appropriations, the approval of a change in point of diversion, and any subsequent approvals of changes in points of diversion, shall not authorize the distance between the well and the centerline of the stream to be decreased by more than 10 percent as measured from the following: (1) The authorized well location when the basin became fully appropriated or was closed to new appropriations; and (2) the centerline of the stream when the change application was filed."
2. That Water Right, File No. 8,447, located in the Republican River Basin, is in an area that has been determined to be fully appropriated. That File No. 8,447 is authorized 75 acre-feet for irrigation use from one well located in Section 22, Township 4 South, Range 4 West, in Republic County, Kansas.
3. That applications to change the point of diversion and place of use for Water Right, File Nos. 6,420 and 8,447 were received in the office of the Chief Engineer on July 3, 2017 and July 21, 2017 respectively. The referenced applications propose to create an exact overlap in the authorized place of use and to exchange the authorized diversion rates and quantities between the wells authorized by File Nos. 6,420 and 8,447, neither of which have current overlaps in their authorized points of diversion or places of use. The move of the quantity and diversion rate of File No. 8,447 from its present location to the well currently authorized by File No. 6,420 will not comply with K.A.R. 5-5-13 *Relocation of alluvial wells* since the proposal appears to decrease the distance between the currently authorized well and the centerline of the stream by more than 10 percent.
4. That the water right owners have requested a waiver of K.A.R. 5-5-13 since the proposed move will result in a net quantity of 39 acre-feet of water being pumped further away from the stream channel.

5. A waiver of K.A.R. 5-5-13 appears reasonable since the approval of the changes in points of diversion and place of use for File Nos. 6,420 and 8,447 will result in a net quantity of 39 acre-feet of water being pumped further away from the stream channel.

6. That a waiver of K.A.R. 5-5-13 will neither prejudicially nor unreasonably affect the public interest and it will not impair an existing water right.

Dear Sir or Madam:

An application for approval of the Chief Engineer to change the following condition or conditions of the file number referred to above has been received:

- place of use PU/PD
- point of diversion
- use made of water

As a matter of record, the Division of Water Resources has on hand a large number of applications awaiting processing. Therefore, to be fair to all concerned, and so that we can process those applications on hand in the order they were received, we intend to concentrate on the backlog of applications until the issue is resolved. You will be contacted regarding this application as soon as it has been examined.

In accordance with the provisions of the Kansas Water Appropriation Act, a portion of which is included below, the use of water prior to approval of the application is unlawful. You should not proceed and divert water as indicated by your plans in your application for a change for this file until you receive approval for this change from the Chief Engineer. Once approved, compliance with the terms, conditions and limitations of the permit is necessary. Conservation of the water resources of Kansas is required.

Section 82a-728 of the Kansas Water Appropriation Act, provides (a) except for the appropriation of water for the purpose of domestic use, . . . it shall be unlawful for any person to appropriate or threaten to appropriate water from any source without first applying for and obtaining a permit to appropriate water in accordance with the provisions of the Water Appropriation Act or for any person to violate any condition of a vested right, appropriation right or an approved application for a permit to appropriate water for beneficial use.

(b) (1) The violation of any provision of this section by any person is a class C misdemeanor...

A class C misdemeanor is punishable by a fine not to exceed \$500 and/or a term of confinement not to exceed one month in the county jail. Each day that the violation occurs constitutes a separate offense.
