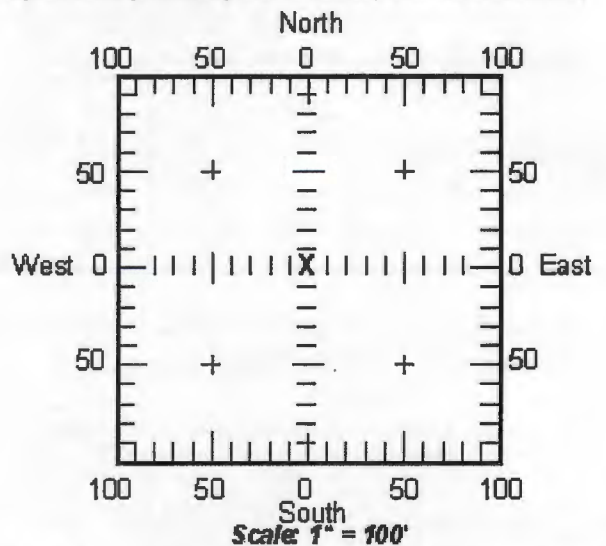

The application should not be considered to be a complete application as per K.A.R. 5-3-1b or K.A.R. 5-5-2a.
