Nelson Farms, Inc., etal filed applications for approval to change the authorized place of use for all the above referenced file numbers. In addition, an application to change the point of diversion and use made of water was filed for Water Right, File No. 4,304, an application to change the use made of water application for Water Right, File No. 35,648 and applications to change the point of diversion for Water Right, File Nos. 31,148.08 and 37,269.01. The referenced file numbers are in the RRC Prairie Dog Creek Special Use Area.

The referenced file numbers do not appear to be abandoned as per K.S.A. 82a-718.

Following are the files involved in these series of change applications along with their authorized/proposed uses:

<u>Irrigation use only</u>: File Nos. PL 016; PL 017-D2; 219, 1,970, 3,130, 3,688; 7,947-D1; 27,754, 31,484

<u>Stockwatering use only</u>: File Nos. 5,069; 31,148.08, 35,648; 35,649; 37,191; 37,269.01, 37,269.02 and 37,269.03

Dual irrigation/stockwatering use: File Nos. 4,005; 4,304; 7,947-D2; 8,203; and 26,865

Industrial/irrigation use: File No. 30,902

PD/UMW Change File No. 4,304

File No. 4,304 is authorized dual irrigation and stockwatering use from two wells; stockwatering use only from a battery of two wells and a single primary well; and standby stockwatering use only from one of aforementioned dual use wells (WRIS ID 6-1519'N,4845'W). The water right owner now proposes convert the entire file to <u>dual</u> irrigation/stockwatering uses, moving all quantities and rates to two wells to be authorized a blanket quantity and rate of 148 acre-feet (48.22 million gallons) - please see Attachment A to this memorandum for details. The file will be limited to 130.7 acre-feet for dual irrigation/stockwatering uses combined; and further limited to 130.7 acre-feet when combined with Vested Right, File No. PL 016 and Water Right, File No. 3,130 for irrigation use on the authorized place of use. The proposed dual use wells will be covered by MYFA Application File Nos. 20187041 MF and 20187042 MF. The currently authorized standby wells will be authorized for standby dual use.

There is an irrigation well not under common ownership (Water Right, File Nos. 2,148/5,248) and numerous stock and irrigation wells under common ownership within one-half mile of WRIS ID 6 and WRIS ID 40 wells. All wells are under common ownership within one-half mile of WRIS ID 5 well. There are two irrigation wells not under common ownership (Water Right, File Nos. 2,148/5,248 and Water Right, File No. 2,979) and numerous wells all under common ownership within one-half mile of the WRIS ID 37 geocenter of the proposed standby well battery.

PD Change File No. 31,148.08

File No. 31,148.08 is authorized 3.816 million gallons and 31 gallons per minute from one well for **solely stockwatering** use in the South Half (S½) of Section 4, Township 2 South, Range 20 West, Phillips County, Kansas. There are no overlaps in the current point of diversion located 4,909 feet North and 2,485 feet West of the Southeast corner of Section 4 but there are partial overlaps in place of use with other stockwatering files. The water right owner proposes to move the authorized quantity and diversion rate to an existing well authorized/to be authorized by Water Right, File Nos. 5,069, 37,269.01 and 37,269.02. The proposed existing primary well (WRIS ID 4), located 3,621 feet North and 4,642 feet West of the Southeast corner of the aforementioned Section 4, will involve a move of approximately 2,512 feet from the present location. In addition, the water right owner proposes to add a standby well (WRIS ID 1) located 3,606 feet North and 4,642 feet West of Section 4, also authorized/to be authorized standby use by File Nos. 5,069; 37,269.01 and 37,269.02, involving a distance move of approximately 2,520 feet from the current location.

There are two irrigation wells (Water Right, File Nos. 2,979 and 5,247) and a domestic well (Water Right, File No. 32,533.01) not under common ownership within one-half mile of the proposed/existing well. There are also four other points of diversion under common ownership.

UMW Change File No. 35,648

File No. 35,648 is authorized 21 acre-feet, temporarily limited to a <u>dual</u> irrigation/stockwatering use quantity of 18.04 acre-feet (5.88 m.g.y.) from one well (WRIS ID 1) located 1,173 feet North and 4,959 feet West of the Southeast corner of Section 34, Township 1 South, Range 20 West, Phillips County, Kansas. The referenced point of diversion overlaps Water Right, File Nos. 37,191 and 37,269.03, and MYFA Application, File No. 20187043-MF. The water right owner now proposes to change the use made of water from dual irrigation/stockwatering use to <u>solely stockwatering</u> use. Since the dual use will be removed and only stockwatering use remains, the authorized quantity will be 18.04 acre-feet and there will be <u>no path back</u> to the 21 acre-feet quantity. The 857.35 acre-feet limitation will be removed since the right will now be authorized only for stockwatering use.

All wells within one-half mile of the authorized point of diversion are under common ownership.

PD Change File No. 37,269.01

File No. 37,269.01 is authorized 4.61 million gallons (14.15 acre-feet) and 50 gallons per minute well for **solely stockwatering** use from one primary well WRIS ID 40 (1518'N,4854'W) in Section 33 also overlapped by File No. 4,304 and MYFA application, File No. 20187042; and one standby well WRIS ID 6 (1519'N,4845'W) in Section 33 also presently authorized dual irrigation/stockwatering use by File No. 4,304. The water right owner proposes to move the authorized quantity and diversion rate to an existing well authorized/to be authorized by Water Right, File Nos. 5,069, 31,148.08 and 37,269.02. The proposed existing well, located 3,621 feet North and 4,642 feet West of the Southeast corner of the aforementioned Section 4, will involve a move of approximately 3,167 feet from the present location. In addition, the water right owner proposes to add a standby well located 3,606 feet North and 4,642 feet West of Section 4, also authorized/to be authorized by File Nos. 5,069; 31,148.08; and 37,269.02, involving a move of approximately 3,168 feet from the present location. However, both proposed moves are less than one-half mile from the originally authorized point of diversion.

There are two irrigation wells (Water Right, File Nos. 2,979 and 5,247) and a domestic well (Water Right, File No. 32,533.01) not under common ownership within one-half mile of the proposed/existing well. There are also four other points of diversion under common ownership.

<u>PU Changes File Nos. 4,005, 4,304, 5,069, 7,947-D2, 8,203, 26,865, 31,148.08, 35,648, 35,649;</u> 37,191; 37,269.01, 37,269.02 and 37,269.03

<u>File No. 4,005</u> – File No. 4,005 is presently authorized the temporary quantity of 44.11 acre-feet of groundwater for <u>dual</u> stockwatering/irrigation purposes from one well (WRIS ID 7 3198'N,3860'W) in aforementioned Section 34. The well is overlapped by Water Right, File No. 8,203 and MYFA Application, File No. 20187044-MF.

<u>File No. 5,069</u> - File No. 5,069 is presently authorized 15.69 m.g.y. for <u>solely stockwatering</u> use from primary (WRIS ID 4 3621'N,4642'W) and standby (WRIS ID 1 3606'N,4642'W) wells located in the previously mentioned Section 4, both wells presently authorized by File No. 37,269.02.

<u>File No. 7947-D2</u> - File No. 7947-D2 is authorized a temporary <u>dual</u> irrigation and stockwatering use quantity of 91.92 AF from one well (WRIS ID 13 2481'N,3950'W) in aforementioned Section 34. The point of diversion overlaps File No. 35,649 and MYFA Application, File No. 20187046-MF.

<u>File No. 8,203</u> - File No. 8,203 is presently authorized a temporary quantity of 26.63 acre-feet for <u>dual</u> irrigation/stockwatering use and a limited rate of 720 g.p.m. from one well (WRIS ID 7 3198'N,3860'W) in previously mentioned Section 34. The well is overlapped by File No. 4,005 and MYFA Application, File No. 20187044-MF.

<u>File No. 26,865</u> - File No. 26,685 is presently authorized a temporary quantity of 51.54 acre-feet for <u>dual</u> irrigation/stockwatering use from one well (WRIS ID 8 3719'N,3877'W) of aforementioned Section 34. The well is overlapped by MYFA Application, File No. 20187045-MF.

<u>File No. 35,649</u> – File No. 35,649 is authorized 13.03 m.g.y. for <u>solely stockwatering</u> use from a primary battery of three wells (geocenter WRIS ID 14 2489'N,3420'W) and a standby well (WRIS ID 13 2481'N,3950'W) both in the aforementioned Section 34. The standby well is overlapped by Water Right, File No. 7,947-D2 and MYFA Application, File No. 20187046-MF. There are no overlaps on the primary well battery.

<u>File No. 37,191</u> – File No. 37,191 is authorized 22.81 m.g.y. for <u>solely stockwatering</u> use from one well (WRIS ID 1 1173'N, 4959'W) in Section 34, presently authorized by File Nos. 35,648; 37,269.03 and 20187043 MF

<u>File No. 37,269.02</u> – File No. 37,269.02 is authorized 5.83 m.g.y. for <u>solely stockwatering</u> use from primary (WRIS ID 4 3621'N,4642'W) and standby (WRIS ID 1 3606'N,4642'W) wells located in the previously mentioned Section 4, both wells presently authorized by File Nos. 5,069.

File No. 37,269.03 – File No. 37,269.03 is authorized 5.83 m.g.y. for **solely stockwatering** use from a primary well (WRIS ID 1 1173'N,4959'W) and a standby battery of two wells (geocenter WRIS ID 10 1455'N,4990'W) all located in the previously mentioned Section 34. The primary well currently overlaps File Nos. 35,648, 37,191 and MYFA Application, File No. 20187043-MF, no current point of diversion overlaps on the standby well battery.

The only wells not under common ownership within one-half mile of the above referenced file numbers are: an irrigation well authorized by Water Right, File No. 24,634 (within one-half mile of the wells for File Nos. 4,005, 7,947-D2, 8,203, 26,865, 35,649); two irrigation wells authorized by Water Right, File Nos. 2,979 and 5,247 and a domestic well authorized by Water Right, File No. 32,533.01 (within one-half mile of the wells for File Nos. 5,069 and 37,269.02).

The stockwatering place of use is being expanded and will be authorized by File Nos. 4,005; 4,304; 5,069; 7,947-D2; 8,203; 26,865; 31,148.08; 35,648; 35,649; 37,191; 37,269.01, 37,269.02 and 37,269.03 and MYFA Application, File Nos. 20187041-MF, 20187042-MF, 20187043-MF, 20187044-MF, 20187045-MF and 20187046-MF, and described as: the Southwest Quarter (SW¼) and the West Half of the Southeast Quarter (W½ SE¼) of Section 33, the West Half of the Southwest Quarter (W½ SW¼) and near the center of Section 34, both sections in Township 1 South; the North Half (N½); the North Half of the South Half (N½ S½); the Southwest Quarter of the Southwest Quarter (SW¼ SW¼); and the Southeast Quarter of the South Half of the Northwest Quarter (S½S½NW¾); and the Southwest Quarter (SW¾) of Section 4; the Northeast Quarter (NE¾) of Section 9; the West Half of the Northwest Quarter (W½ NW¾); and the Southwest Quarter (SW¾) of Section 10; and the Northwest Quarter (NW¾) of Section 15; all in Township 2 South, the entire place of use in Range 20 West, Phillips County, Kansas.

The proposed irrigation place of use remains the same, described as 726.50 acres in Sections 28, 33 and 34, Township 1 South, and Section 4, Township 2 South, all in Range 20 West, Phillips County. The irrigation place of use will be authorized by File Nos. PL 016 and PL 017-D2; 219; 1,970; 3,130; 3,688; 4,005; 4,304, 7,947-D1; 7,947-D2; 8,203; 26,865; 27,754; 30,902; and 31,484 and by MYFA Application, File Nos. 20187041-MF, 20187042-MF, 20187044-MF, 20187045-MF and 20187046-MF.

No change proposed for the industrial use for File No. 30,902 described as a truck washing facility in the Northeast Quarter of the Northeast Quarter (NE¼ NE¼) of the aforementioned Section 33.

Nearby well owners were notified as required for the referenced change applications by letters dated November 29, 2018. On December 6, 2018 a call was returned to Brad Cox regarding the point of diversion changes. Mr. Cox asked what they are proposing and was not in favor of the proposal. He was told to contact the field office for more specific concerns, and to put concerns in writing and submit to the DWR Manhattan office within 15 days of the date of the notification letter. In an e-mail dated December 19, 2018, Kelly Stewart, Water Commissioner of the Stockton Field Office, indicated he spoke with Mr. Cox, and after further explanation by Kelly, Mr. Cox did not have any real concerns, but simply wanted to understand what was happening. No written comments have been received as of today's date.

In an e-mail dated January 16, 2019, Kelly Stewart, Water Commissioner of the Stockton Field Office, recommended approval of the applications.

Water flow meters are required, and separate meters will be required for dual use water rights. Check valves are required if any chemical or foreign substance is injected into the water through the diversion works.

Dear Mr. Nelson:

Enclosed are the orders executed by the Chief Engineer, Division of Water Resources, Kansas Department of Agriculture, approving the applications for change under the above referenced file numbers. Also enclosed is the Findings and Order by the Chief Engineer, Division of Water Resources, Kansas Department of Agriculture, which modifies the additional quantity limitation under File No. 3,130.

Your attention is directed to the enclosures and to the terms, conditions, and limitations specified in these approvals for change. A condition of the approvals is that acceptable water flow meters must be installed so that both irrigation and stockwatering uses can be metered independent of each other. Please return the required notification of completion of the diversion works and/or installation of the required meters as soon as these actions are completed.

Also enclosed are the order/permits executed by the Chief Engineer, Division of Water Resources, Kansas Department of Agriculture, suspending the base water rights referenced above, and approving your Applications for Term Permit to Establish a Multi-Year Flex Account. Your attention is directed to the enclosures and to the terms, conditions, limitations, and requirements specified in the Applications and its "Attachment A", which are incorporated in these enclosed orders/permits. The approval of these multi-year flex account term permits affords you the ability to divert water without annual limits, during the set period of January 1, 2018 through December 31, 2022, inclusive. However, the use of water in excess of the authorized quantity within the five-year set period listed above, shall result in the immediate revocation of the multi-year flex account term permits and the imposition of penalties as provided in K.A.R. 5-14-10.

Prior to any further diversion of water, an acceptable water flowmeter must be installed on each point of diversion authorized by the base right. A seal will be placed on the water flowmeter by the Division of Water Resources in such a manner as to render the meter non-removable from the measuring chamber without breaking the seal. If the seal is broken without the written permission of the Chief Engineer, it shall constitute a violation of the order of the Chief Engineer. If the water flowmeter is repaired or replaced during the duration of the multi-year flex account term permit, then such flowmeter must be equipped with an anti-reverse flow mechanism. Also, a condition of the approvals is that acceptable water flow meters must be installed so that both irrigation and stockwatering uses can be metered independent of each other.

An annual water use report must be filed with the Chief Engineer by March 1, following the end of each calendar year. If a complete annual water use report is not received by the deadline, then a fine may be assessed and all water use under such permit or right may be suspended. Reports submitted in paper form will be assessed a \$20 per file number paper filing fee. In order to avoid this filing fee, you may submit your report online at www.kswaterusereport.org.

Box 38, Long Island, Kansas, 67647, Husky Hogs, L.L.C., Terry Nelson, Box 8, Long Island, Kansas, 67647, Nelson Hog Farms, L.L.C., 1304 West Fox Road, Long Island, Kansas, 67647, and NTN L.P., PO Box 560, Norton, Kansas, 67654, received in this office on October 18, 2018, for approval of a change in the place of use and use made of water under the certificate of appropriation issued pursuant to the application for permit to appropriate water for beneficial use, as modified and amended by the Findings and Order of the Chief Engineer dated May 9, 2000, reducing the authorized place of use, the Order of the Chief Engineer dated July 21, 2008, approving the application to change the place of use and better describing the location of the authorized point of diversion, the Findings and Order of the Chief Engineer dated March 6, 2012, modifying the additional limitation on the authorized quantity, the Findings and Order of the Chief Engineer dated April 8, 2014, reducing the authorized place of use and modifying the additional limitation on the authorized quantity, the Order of the Chief Engineer dated November 22, 2016, approving the application to change the place of use, and by the Order of the Chief Engineer dated April 30, 2018, approving the application to change the place of use and use made of water, finds that the changes are reasonable and will not impair existing rights and that the application should be and is hereby approved.

All diversion works into which any type of chemical or other foreign substance will be injected into the water pumped from the diversion works shall be equipped with an in-line, automatic, quick-closing check valve capable of preventing pollution of the source of the water supply. The type of valve installed shall meet specifications adopted by the Chief Engineer and shall be maintained in an operating condition satisfactory to the Chief Engineer.

The water right owner shall properly install an acceptable water meter on the diversion works authorized under this water right, prior to the use of water, in strict accordance with the Kansas Administrative Regulations 5-1-4 through 5-1-12 adopted by the Chief Engineer. The water right owner shall notify the Chief Engineer when installation of the water meter has been completed. The water right owner shall maintain the water meter in an operating condition satisfactory to the Chief Engineer, at all times during diversion of water and shall maintain records from which the total quantity of water diverted may be determined. The water right owner shall also report the reading of said water meter and the total quantity of water diverted annually to the Chief Engineer. Such records shall be furnished to the Chief Engineer by March 1 following the end of each calendar year.

In all other respects, the Certificate of Appropriation issued pursuant to Approval of Application, File No. 35,648, for permit to appropriate water for beneficial use, is as stated and set forth in the Certificate of Appropriation dated June 23, 1997, as modified and amended by the aforementioned orders.

RIGHT TO A HEARING AND TO ADMINISTRATIVE REVIEW

If you are aggrieved by this Order, then pursuant to K.S.A. 82a-1901, you may:

- 1) request an evidentiary hearing before the Chief Engineer, or
- 2) request administrative review by the Secretary of Agriculture.

Failure to request an evidentiary hearing before the Chief Engineer does not preclude your right to administrative review by the Secretary.

To obtain an evidentiary hearing before the Chief Engineer, a written request for hearing must be filed within 15 days after service of this Order as provided in K.S.A. 77-531 (i.e., within a total of 18 days after this Order was mailed to you), with the Kansas Department of Agriculture, Attn: Legal Section, 1320 Research Park Drive, Manhattan, Kansas 66502, or by FAX (785) 564-6777.

If you do not file a request for an evidentiary hearing before the Chief Engineer, you may petition for administrative review of the Order by the Secretary of Agriculture. A petition for review shall be in writing and state the basis for requesting administrative review. The request for review may be denied if the request fails to clearly establish factual or legal issues for review. See K.S.A. 77-527. The petition must be filed within 30 days after service of this Order as provided in K.S.A. 77-531 (i.e., within a total of 33 days after this Order was mailed to you), and be filed with the Secretary of Agriculture, Attn: Legal Division, Kansas Department of Agriculture, 1320 Research Park Drive, Manhattan, Kansas 66502, or by FAX (785) 564-6777.

If neither a request for an evidentiary hearing nor a petition for administrative review is filed as set forth above, then this Order shall be effective and become a final agency action as defined in K.S.A. 77-607(b). Failure to timely request either an evidentiary hearing or administrative review may preclude further judicial review under the Kansas Judicial Review Act.

David and others,

I am seeking clarification or verification on what was decided in our Spring 2018 water commissioner meeting held at MHK.

I came away from that meeting with the thinking and understanding that we would allow a path back to the original irrigated quantity in all changes in the use made of water. For example, if an irrigation right was converted to municipal, industrial, or stockwatering, we would limit (but not reduce) the quantity of water that could be pumped to consumptive use, but then if they changed back to irrigation only, their original quantity would be intact.

After discussing this with Brent this week, his shop believes we only allow the path back for dual use changes and/or partial changes in u/m/w.

I think everyone agrees that if an additional well is incorporated into the change, then we do not allow a path back because we consider the additional well a permanent change.

Can you provide guidance?

As a matter of record, the Division of Water Resources has on hand a large number of applications awaiting processing. Therefore, to be fair to all concerned, and so that we can process those applications on hand in the order they were received, we intend to concentrate on the backlog of applications until the issue is resolved. You will be contacted regarding this application as soon as it has been examined.

In accordance with the provisions of the Kansas Water Appropriation Act, a portion of which is included below, the use of water prior to approval of the application is unlawful. You should not proceed and divert water as indicated by your plans in your application for a change for this file until you receive approval for this change from the Chief Engineer. Once approved, compliance with the terms, conditions and limitations of the permit is necessary. Conservation of the water resources of Kansas is required.

Section 82a-728 of the Kansas Water Appropriation Act, provides (a) except for the appropriation of water for the purpose of domestic use, . . . it shall be unlawful for any person to appropriate or threaten to appropriate water from any source without first applying for and obtaining a permit to appropriate water in accordance with the provisions of the Water Appropriation Act or for any person to violate any condition of a vested right, appropriation right or an approved application for a permit to appropriate water for beneficial use.

(b) (1) The violation of any provision of this section by any person is a class C misdemeanor... A class C misdemeanor is punishable by a fine not to exceed \$500 and/or a term of confinement not to exceed one month in the county jail. Each day that the violation occurs constitutes a separate offense.


