The application was returned to the applicant on June 16, 2021, providing 60 days to locate the points of diversion, provide additional information, and return the application by an August 16, 2021 deadline. A reminder letter was sent to the applicant on July 16, 2021. The application has not been returned by the applicant by the August 16, 2021 deadline.

Based on the available information, that the application was not returned within the time allowed, it is recommended that the file be dismissed for failure to return, as provided by K.S.A. 82a-710.

FINDINGS AND ORDER IN THE MATTER OF THE DISMISSAL OF APPLICATION FILE NO. 50,601

After due consideration, the Chief Engineer, Division of Water Resources, Kansas Department of Agriculture (hereinafter referred to as the "Chief Engineer"), makes the following findings and order:

FINDINGS

- 1. That on June 14, 2021, the Chief Engineer received an application from the Don and Bonnie Irons Trust for a permit to appropriate groundwater for beneficial use, assigned File No. 50,601, proposing the appropriation of 208 acre-feet of water, at a maximum requested diversion rate of 800 gallons per minute, for irrigation use. The applicant requested 60 days to locate the specific point of diversion within the Northeast Quarter of Section 9, Township 20 South, Range 4 West, McPherson County, Kansas.
- 2. That on June 16, 2021, the original application was returned to the applicant, with a cover letter requesting that additional information be submitted in order to complete the application. The applicant was provided a deadline of August 16, 2021, the time in which to provide the requested information and return the application. The applicant was informed that the application would be dismissed if it was not returned by the deadline, or within any authorized extension of time.
- 3. That a reminder letter was sent to the applicant on July 16, 2021, once again stating the August 16, 2021 date that the original application was required to be returned.
- 4. That the original application was not returned by the August 16, 2021 deadline.
- 5. That the application should be dismissed and its priority forfeited as provided by K.S.A. 82a-710.

ORDER

NOW, THEREFORE, It is the decision and order of the Chief Engineer, Division of Water Resources, Kansas Department of Agriculture, that effective the date of this order, in accordance with the law, Application, File No. 50,601, is herewith dismissed and the priority assigned to it is considered to be forfeited.
