James R. Chappell on behalf of the James R. Chappell Indenture of Trust, has filed applications for approval to change place of use under the referenced files authorized for recreational use as marsh wetlands to divert water from the Neosho River. File No. 49,390, has been requested to be dismissed with its place of use picked up by the remaining files. The owners have also requested a change in point of diversion under File No. 43,440, to overlap its pumpsites with the other rights. The applications were received on December 8, 2015.

The referenced files appear to be in meet K.S.A.82a-732, and the applications meet K.A.R. 5-5-2a, *Complete change application*. The owner has received notice of his meter being out of compliance, but he filed his reports on time.

The referenced files are authorized to fill and maintain marshes and account for evaporative loss with levies and dikes permitted under Structure Permits LNO-0069, LNO-0084 & LNO-0088. The rights authorize the diversion of 487.5 acre-feet to inundate 136.5 acres of wetland with 61.5 acre-feet of the authorized diversions accredited towards evaporative loss. This indicates approximately 3.1 feet of water per acre is authorized to cover the marshes. The rates of diversion are not limited to allow the capture of high flow events. The permits have different pumping conditions and restrictions with the exception of File No. 36,696, that has no special conditions. All of the junior rights prohibit summer pumping, with File No. 43,440 restricting pumping to the months of October to January. The allowance for natural evaporation was added under File Nos. 49,390 & 49,391 and appear to have been for a full year of evaporative loss.

The WRIS database indicates three(3) pumpsites along the *Neosho River Cutoff* are authorized under File Nos. 36,696; 40,788; 44,332 & 49,391, in Sections 7 and 8, Township 30 South, Range 21 East, Neosho County. The change in point of diversion requested by File No. 43,440, will increase the authorized points of diversion from three(3) to five(5) pumpsites, with pumpsites #1-3, all authorized under File Nos. 36,696; 40,788; 44,332 & 49,391, with pumpsites # 4 & 5 to be only authorized by File No. 43,440, due to the dismissal of File No. 49,390. This dismissal will remove 100 acre-feet of which 30.2 acre-feet had been designated for potential net evaporation. It appears the change in point of diversion will not alter the local source of supply.

The review of the ownership found that the pumpsite determined to be in Section 8 is not on land owned by the applicant or an owner of the place of use. As File No. 43,440, is requesting to change the point of diversion, the nearby landowners were notified of the requested change. No Comments were received, so it would appear the owners have an agreement and the application for change complies with K.A.R. 5-3-3a, *Legal access*.

The place of use changes will make a complete overlap of the North and South Marshes and add some new marsh land located in the Southeast Quarter (SE $\frac{1}{4}$ ) between the places of use historically identified by the owner as Field and Southwest. The currently authorized marshes located in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$  & SE $\frac{1}{4}$  have a total combined surface acres of 136.5 acres. Adding the 5 acres in the Northeast Quarter of the Southeast Quarter (NE $\frac{1}{4}$  SE $\frac{1}{4}$ ) will result in a total of 141.5 surface acres that could be inundated for recreational use as a wetland in the East Half of Section 7. This would afford 283 acre-feet for a single filling at the historical 2 acre-feet per acre.

The quantity authorized by Water Right, File Nos. 36,696; 40,788 and 44,332 is 122 acre feet. As detailed in the 2015 summary memo for File No. 49,391, it's authorized 320 acre-feet providing 210 additional acre-feet and limited to 332 acre feet with File Nos. 36,696; 40,788 and 44,332, allowing 31.3 acre-feet for evaporation and 300 acre feet for two fillings of the 75 acres of marsh located in the Northeast Quarter. The marsh located in the Southeast Quarter authorized by File Nos. 43,440 & 49,390, is for 72.5 acres with a combined 167.5 acre-feet, allowing 30.2 acre-feet for potential net evaporation. The dismissal of File No. 39,390, will result in a total of 399.5 acre-feet authorized for the 141.5 acres of wetland marshes.

The annual potential net evaporation from the 141.5 acres located in Township 30, Range 21 East, Neosho County per K.A.R 5-6-3 *Potential net evaporation* and K.A.R. 5-6-7 *Determination of average annual potential net evaporation loss*, the marsh evaporative loss would be:

141.5 acres x 5 inches ÷ 12 inches per acre-foot = 58.96 acre-feet per year  
58.96 acre-feet per year ÷ 12 months per year x 5 months indention = 24.6 acre-feet of evaporation

It appears that the 31.3 acre-feet authorized for evaporation under File No. 49,391 is sufficient to meet the requirement of K.A.R. 5-6-3.

The dismissal of File No. 39,390, will result in a total of 399.5 acre-feet authorized for the 141.5 acres of wetland marshes under File Nos. 36,696; 40,788; 43,440; 44,332 & 49,391. The standard two fillings per year of all of the 141.5 acres at a 2 foot depth justifies 566 acre-feet. The potential net evaporation of 24.6 acre-feet results in a total of 590.6 acre-feet that could be authorized for the Chappell Marsh. The additional limitation under File No. 49,391, remain as it reflects the original permitting with the senior rights. The place of use changes comply with K.A.R. 5-5-3, *Change in consumptive use*, there will be no significant increase in inundated acres.

Historically, the marshes have been numbered by DWR and identified in the WRIS database with a PUse ID and named by the owner. As the owner will be adding an additional marsh unit that is mainly existing small ponds, this unit will be designated #5, and may be named by the owner. The correlation of the names:

As proposed by the changes in place of use each unit comprising the place of use will become a complete overlap, all in Section 7, Township 30 South, Range 21 East, the WRIS database will delete PUse ID 52089, and modify the PUse ID 8348, to the description of:

#### WETLAND MARSHES NE & Lot 9 & SE

The water use correspondent for all of the referenced files is James R. Chappell, but historically sequence numbers have been assigned based on the rights pumpsites and places of use (Marsh Unit). The water use reports were streamlined in 2015 with a consolidation to sequence #2 for all of the rights except 49,390 & 49,391, which reported under sequence #1.


The comment line for the point of diversion will be updated. The numbers for the pumpsite designation will remain as stated. The comment line wording for the structures reference of STRUCTURES PERMIT LNO-088 (LNO-069, LNO-0084 & LNO-0088 will remain as listed but shortened to *WS LNO-0088*. The marshes have had a name and numbered designation, a space in the comment line will allow the owner to record the marsh name as he has in the past.

The applicant did not indicate that any additional construction of dikes or levees would occur in this area. No permits from our structures program will be needed for these marshes.

A meter will be required on all diversions and notice of completion for File No. 44,430. It does appear that meters are installed. A check valve will continue to be required if any chemicals are injected into the water. Additionally, the transmittal letter will remind the owner that all of his rights with the exception of File No. 36,969, are subject to MDS, and other pumping restrictions are applicable.

The proposed new application and change in place of use was reviewed by Katie Tietsort Water Commissioner, Topeka Field Office. She had no objection to the requested changes with the dismissal of File No. 49,390 as detailed in her email dated July 15, 2016.

Based on the above discussion, that no change in the local source of supply will occur, the requested changes are reasonable and the dismissal of File No. 49,390 will not result in a significant increase in consumptive use, that impairment to existing water rights is unlikely, it is recommended that the requested applications for change and dismissal of File No. 49,390, be approved.

The Chief Engineer, Division of Water Resources, Kansas Department of Agriculture, after due consideration of the written application of James R. Chappell, 202 S Country Club Road, Chanute, Kansas 66720, received in this office on December 8, 2015, for approval of a change in the location of the point of diversion and the authorized place of use under the certificate of appropriation issued pursuant to the application for permit to appropriate water for beneficial use as modified and amended by the Findings & Order of the Chief Engineer dated July 16, 2013, in the matter of the authorized point of diversion finds that the change is reasonable and will not impair existing rights, that the change relates to the same local source of supply and that the application should be and is hereby approved.

The effective date of the change shall be the date this order is executed by the Chief Engineer, after which the authorized location of the point of diversion shall be:

one (1) pumpsite located in the Southeast Quarter of the Southeast Quarter of the Northeast Quarter (SE $\frac{1}{4}$  SE $\frac{1}{4}$  NE $\frac{1}{4}$ ) of Section 7, more particularly described as being near a point 2,700 feet North and 50 feet West of the Southeast corner of said section, and

one (1) pumpsite located in the Southeast Quarter of the Northeast Quarter of the Southeast Quarter (SE $\frac{1}{4}$  NE $\frac{1}{4}$  SE $\frac{1}{4}$ ) of Section 7, more particularly described as being near a point 1,835 feet North and 450 feet West of the Southeast corner of said section, and

one (1) pumpsite located in the Southwest Quarter of the Southwest Quarter of the Northwest Quarter (SW $\frac{1}{4}$  SW $\frac{1}{4}$  NW $\frac{1}{4}$ ) of Section 8, more particularly described as being near a point 3,256 feet North and 4,919 feet West of the Southeast corner of said section, and

one (1) pumpsite located in the Northeast Quarter of the Southeast Quarter of the Southeast Quarter (NE $\frac{1}{4}$  SE $\frac{1}{4}$  SE $\frac{1}{4}$ ) of Section 7, more particularly described as being near a point 1,150 feet North and 50 feet West of the Southeast corner of said section, and

one (1) pumpsite located in the Southwest Quarter of the Southeast Quarter of the Southeast Quarter (SW $\frac{1}{4}$  SE $\frac{1}{4}$  SE $\frac{1}{4}$ ) Section 7, more particularly described as being near a point 200 feet North and 700 feet West of the Southeast corner of said section,

all in Township 30 South, Range 21 East, Neosho County, Kansas, and

the authorized place of use shall be:

wetland marshes located in the Northeast Quarter (NE $\frac{1}{4}$ ), and Lot 9, and in the Southeast Quarter (SE $\frac{1}{4}$ ) of Section 7, Township 30 South, Range 21 East, Neosho County, Kansas,

located substantially as shown on the aerial photograph accompanying the application to change the point of diversion and place of use.

Installation of the works for diversion of water shall be completed on or before December 31, 2016, or within any authorized extension of time. The applicant shall notify the Chief Engineer of the Division of Water Resources, Kansas Department of Agriculture, when construction of the works for diversion has been completed.

The water right owner shall properly install an acceptable water meter on the diversion works authorized under this water right, prior to the use of water, in strict accordance with the Kansas Administrative Regulations 5-1-4 through 5-1-12 adopted by the Chief Engineer. The water right owner shall notify the Chief Engineer when installation of the water meter has been completed. The water right owner shall maintain the water meter in an operating condition satisfactory to the Chief Engineer, at all times during diversion of water and shall maintain records from which the total quantity of water diverted may be determined. The water right owner shall also report the reading of said water meter and the total quantity of water diverted annually to the Chief Engineer. Such records shall be furnished to the Chief Engineer by March 1 following the end of each calendar year

All diversion works into which any type of chemical or other foreign substance will be injected into the water pumped from the diversion works shall be equipped with an in-line, automatic, quick-closing check valve capable of preventing pollution of the source of the water supply. The type of valve installed shall meet specifications adopted by the Chief Engineer and shall be maintained in an operating condition satisfactory to the Chief Engineer.

In all other respects, the Certificate of Appropriation issued pursuant to Approval of Application, File No. 43,440, for permit to appropriate water for beneficial use, is as stated and set forth in the Certificate of Appropriation dated October 11, 2005, as modified and amended by the aforementioned order of the Chief Engineer.

This Order shall become a final agency action, as defined by K.S.A. 77-607(b), without further notice to the parties, if a request for hearing or a petition for administrative review is not filed as set forth below.

**Request for Hearing.** According to K.A.R. 5-14-3(c), any party who desires a hearing must submit a request within 15 days after the date shown on the Certificate of Service attached to this Order. Filing a request for a hearing will give you the opportunity to submit additional facts for consideration, contest any findings made by the Chief Engineer or present any other information you believe should be considered in this matter. A timely-filed request for hearing will stay the deadline for requesting administrative review of this Order pending the outcome of the hearing.

Petition for Review. Any person aggrieved by this Summary Order may petition for administrative review, pursuant to K.S.A. 82a-708b(a) and K.S.A. 82a-1901(a). The petition must be filed within 30 days after the date shown on the Certificate of Service attached to this Order and must set forth the basis for the review, unless stayed by the timely filing of a request for hearing.

Jim,

It's a good thing we looked closely at this.

The north set of files, 36696/40788/44332 are set up to cover the north three marshes and authorize all the same ground and pumpsites.

36696- authorizes 46 Acre-Feet at a max 3000 gpm

40788- authorizes 44 Acre-Feet at a max rate of 3575 gpm limited to 3575 gpm with 36696

44332- authorizes 32 Acre-Feet at a max rate of 3575 gpm limited to 3575 gpm with 36696 and 40788

This means you have the right to pump 122 AF into the north marshes at a maximum rate of 3575 gpm.

The south file, 43440 covers the south marsh and authorizes you to divert 67.5 Acre-feet at a maximum rate of diversion of 3095 gpm.

So you can operate a pump pumping to the north for 3575 gpm and to the south for 3095 gpm.

This means if you want to proceed forward with a Crisafulli/Gator style pump that will divert 6-8,000 gps, you would need to file rate-only applications on each of these (2- north and south) current groups to get you up to the rate you need. Also remember, unfortunately, the priority for that rate would be really junior, so in dry years you may be restricted to the rate you have if we work in order of priority like we have to some years.

I wanted to send this so you'd have it in print before I give you a call back.

As a matter of record, the Division of Water Resources has on hand a large number of applications awaiting processing. Therefore to be fair to all concerned, and so that we can process those applications on hand in the order they were received, we intend to concentrate on the backlog of applications until the issue is resolved. You will be contacted regarding this application as soon as it has been examined.

In accordance with the provisions of the Kansas Water Appropriation Act, a portion of which is included below, the use of water prior to approval of the application is unlawful. You should not proceed and divert water as indicated by your plans in your application for a change for this file until you receive approval for this change from the Chief Engineer. Once approved, compliance with the terms, conditions and limitations of the permit is necessary. Conservation of the water resources of Kansas is required.

**Section 82a-728 of the Kansas Water Appropriation Act, provides (a) except for the appropriation of water for the purpose of domestic use, . . . it shall be unlawful for any person to appropriate or threaten to appropriate water from any source without first applying for and obtaining a permit to appropriate water in accordance with the provisions of the Water Appropriation Act or for any person to violate any condition of a vested right, appropriation right or an approved application for a permit to appropriate water for beneficial use.**

**(b) (1) The violation of any provision of this section by any person is a class C misdemeanor...**

**A class C misdemeanor is punishable by a fine not to exceed \$500 and/or a term of confinement not to exceed one month in the county jail. Each day that the violation occurs constitutes a separate offense.**

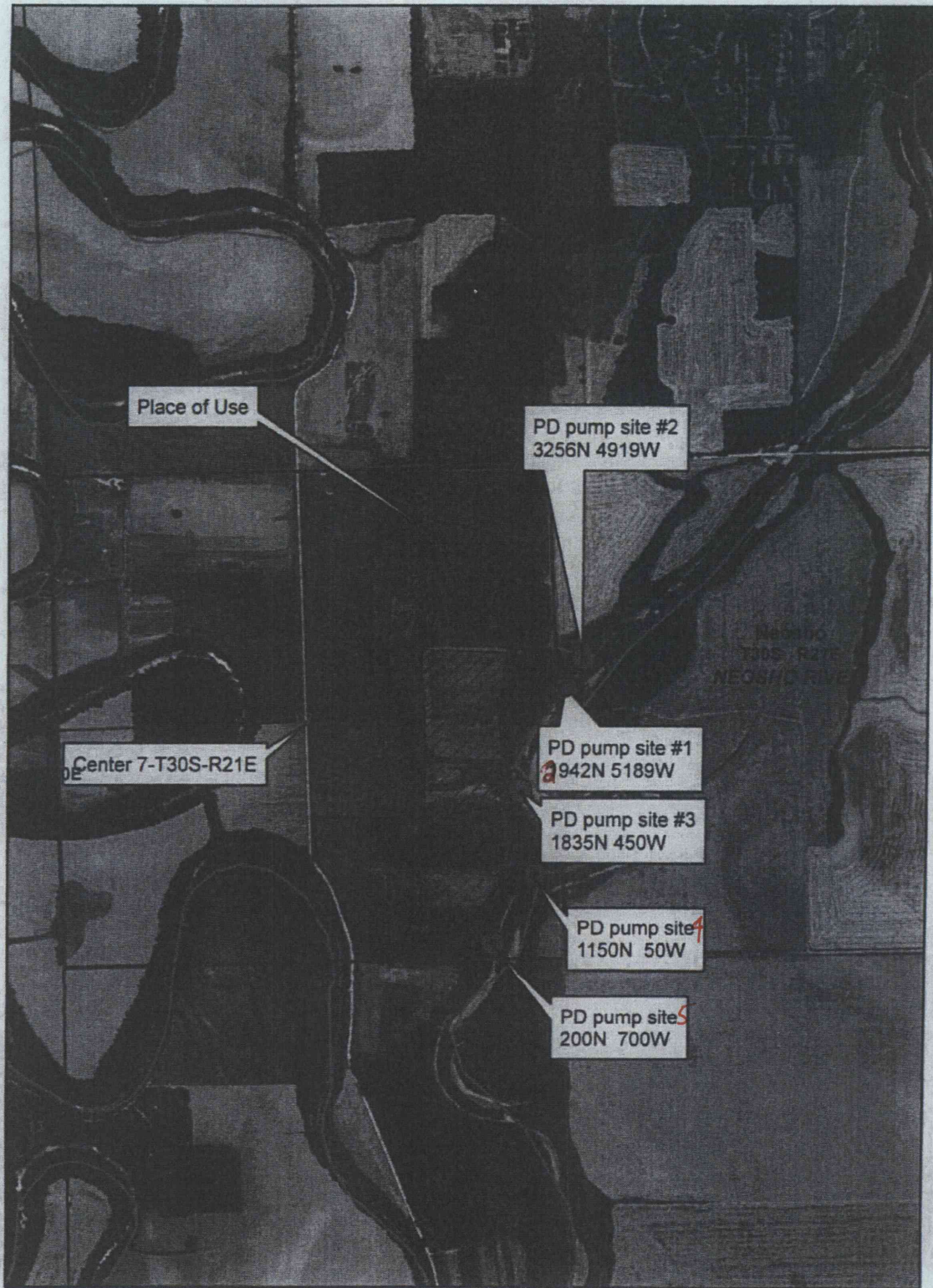

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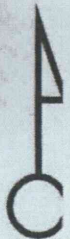

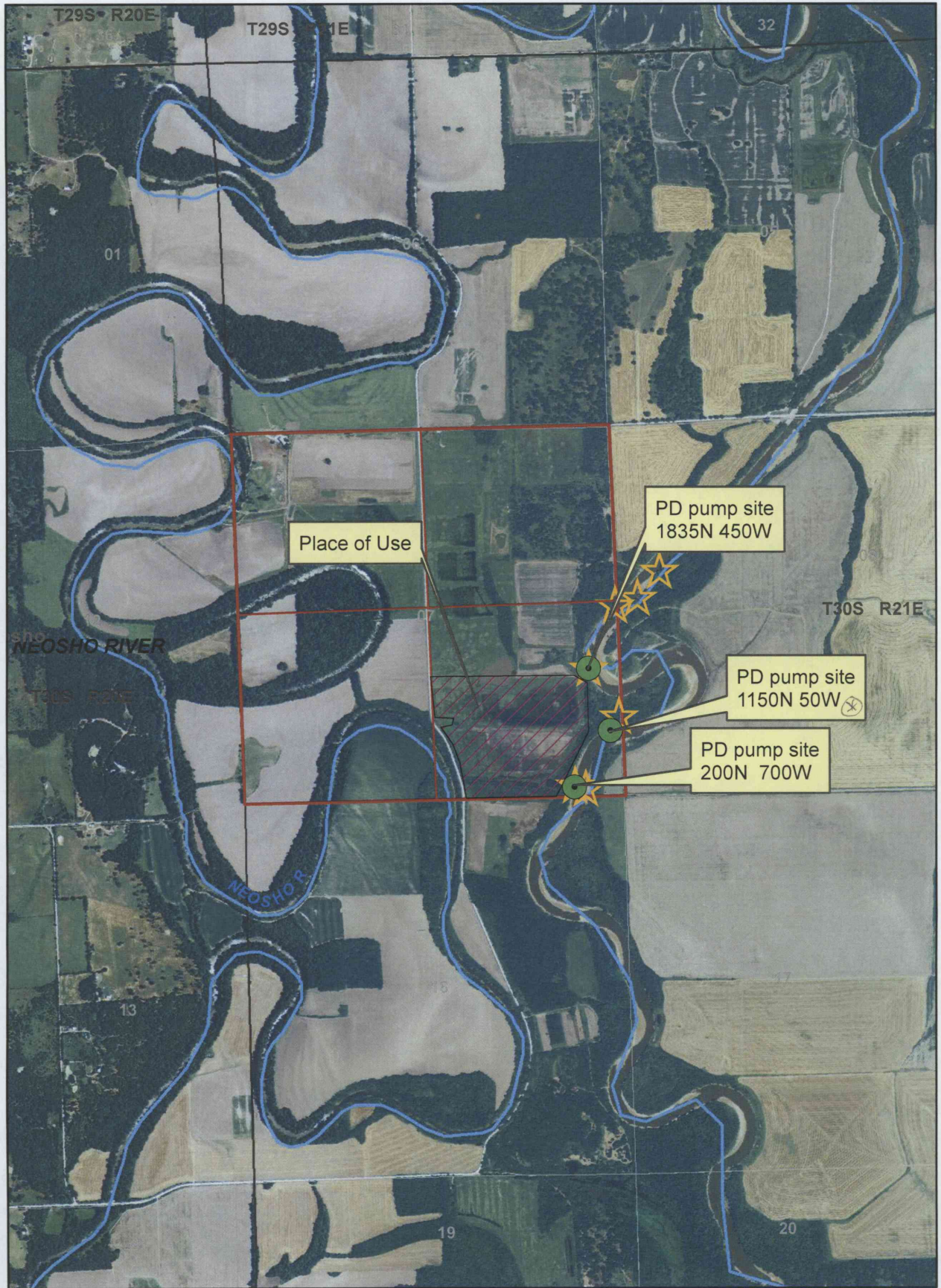
