Tim A. Gintner, on behalf of Rural Water District No. 1, Crawford County, filed applications for approval to change the authorized place of use under the referenced file numbers, all files authorized groundwater for municipal use.

The referenced file numbers do not appear to be abandoned pursuant to K.S.A. 82a-718. The perfection period for File No. 41,089 expires December 31, 2021 and the perfection period for File No. 47,563 expires on December 31, 2031.

The above referenced files are authorized a total limited quantity and diversion rate of 40.308 million gallons per calendar year and 350 g.p.m. from the same well for municipal use within the boundaries of Crawford County Rural Water District Nos. 1, 2 and 7 and their immediate vicinities.

Plans to supply Crawford County RWD Nos. 2 and 7 never materialized and there is no physical connection with those districts. However, Crawford RWD No. 1 does have an emergency connection to supply Crawford County Rural Water District No. 3 so the District filed the referenced changes. The District proposes to drop Crawford County RWD Nos. 2 and 7, and add Crawford County RWD No. 3 so that the proposed place of use will be described as:

within the boundaries of Rural Water District No. 1, Crawford County, Kansas and immediate vicinity; and within the boundaries of Rural Water District No. 3, Crawford County, Kansas and immediate vicinity.

It appears that Crawford County RWD No. 1 has sufficient quantity at this point in time to supply the other rural water district. Crawford County RWD No. 3 is also authorized its own water rights, Water Right, File Nos. 8,697 and 34,866.

The additional limitations on the rate under File No. 41,089 and on the rate and quantity under File No. 47,563 will be modified to reflect the change in place of use.

There are no other non-domestic wells within one-half mile of the authorized point of diversion and the applicant did not identify any domestic wells within one-half mile. Also, no domestic wells were identified within one-half mile of the authorized well in the WWC-5 records.

The same local source of supply will not change.

In an e-mail dated January 19, 2017, Katherine Tietsort, Water Commissioner of the Topeka Field Office, indicated no objection to approval of the referenced applications.

Water flow meters will be required on the diversion works in accordance with existing rules and regulations. Check valves will be required if any chemical or foreign substance is injected into the water through the diversion works.

Based on the above discussion, that the changes are reasonable, that impairment to existing water rights is unlikely and that no change in the local source of supply will occur, it has been recommended that the referenced applications be approved.

The Chief Engineer, Division of Water Resources, Kansas Department of Agriculture, after due consideration of the written application of Tim A. Gintner, on behalf of Rural Water District No. 1, Crawford County, Kansas, P.O. Box 902, Frontenac, Kansas, 66763-0984, received in this office on December 28, 2016, for approval of a change in the location of the place of use under the certificate of appropriation issued pursuant to the application for permit to appropriate water for beneficial use, as modified and amended by the Order of the Chief Engineer dated November 3, 2010, approving the application to change the place of use, finds that the change is reasonable and will not impair existing rights, and that the application should be and is hereby approved.

The effective date of the change shall be the date this order is executed by the Chief Engineer, after which the authorized location of the place of use shall be:

within the boundaries of Rural Water District No. 1, Crawford County, and immediate vicinity;
and within the boundaries of Rural Water District No. 3, Crawford County, and immediate vicinity,

located substantially as shown on the map accompanying the application to change the place of use.

All diversion works into which any type of chemical or other foreign substance will be injected into the water pumped from the diversion works shall be equipped with an in-line, automatic, quick-closing check valve capable of preventing pollution of the source of the water supply. The type of valve installed shall meet specifications adopted by the Chief Engineer and shall be maintained in an operating condition satisfactory to the Chief Engineer.

The water right owner shall properly install an acceptable water meter on the diversion works authorized under this water right, prior to the use of water, in strict accordance with the Kansas Administrative Regulations 5-1-4 through 5-1-12 adopted by the Chief Engineer. The water right owner shall notify the Chief Engineer when installation of the water meter has been completed. The water right owner shall maintain the water meter in an operating condition satisfactory to the Chief Engineer, at all times during diversion of water and shall maintain records from which the total quantity of water diverted may be determined. The water right owner shall also report the reading of said water meter and the total quantity of water diverted annually to the Chief Engineer. Such records shall be furnished to the Chief Engineer by March 1 following the end of each calendar year.

In all other respects, the Certificate of Appropriation issued pursuant to Approval of Application, File No. 18,870, for permit to appropriate water for beneficial use, is as stated and set forth in the Certificate of Appropriation dated April 10, 1996, as modified and amended by the aforementioned order.

This Order shall become a final agency action, as defined by K.S.A. 77-607(b), without further notice to the parties, if a request for hearing or a petition for administrative review is not filed as set forth below.

Request for Hearing. According to K.A.R. 5-14-3(c), any party who desires a hearing must submit a request within 15 days after the date shown on the Certificate of Service attached to this Order. Filing a request for a hearing will give you the opportunity to submit additional facts for consideration, contest any findings made by the Chief Engineer or present any other information you believe should be considered in this matter. A timely-filed request for hearing will stay the deadline for requesting administrative review of this Order pending the outcome of the hearing.

Petition for Review. Any person aggrieved by this Summary Order may petition for administrative review, pursuant to K.S.A. 82a-708b(a) and K.S.A. 82a-1901(a). The petition must be filed within 30 days after the date shown on the Certificate of Service attached to this Order and must set forth the basis for the review, unless stayed by the timely filing of a request for hearing.

Any request for hearing or petition for administrative review shall be in writing and shall be submitted to the attention of: Chief Legal Counsel, Kansas Department of Agriculture, 1320 Research Park Drive, Manhattan, Kansas 66502, Fax: (785) 564 - 6777.

Such violation is a class C misdemeanor, punishable by a fine not to exceed \$500 and/or a term of confinement not to exceed one month in the county jail. K.S.A. 82a-728(b). Civil penalties shall be not less than \$100 nor more than \$1,000 per violation. In the case of a continuing violation, each day such violation continues may be deemed a separate violation. In addition to these penalties the water right may be modified or suspended. K.S.A. 82a-737, as amended.

The application must be signed by all owners of the place of use authorized under the water right and his or her spouse, if married. Please indicate if there is no spouse. If land is being purchased under contract, the seller must sign as landowner until such time as the contract is completed.

In the event that all applicants cannot appear before one notary public, they may as necessary sign separate copies of the application before any notary public conveniently available to them. All copies signed in this manner shall be considered to be valid parts of the application.

If the request is signed on behalf of any Owner by someone with legal authority to do so (for example, an agent, one who has power of attorney, or an executor, executrix, conservator), it will be necessary to attach proper documents showing such authority.

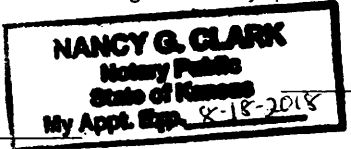

Dear Sir or Madam:

An application for approval of the Chief Engineer to change the following condition or conditions of the file number referred to above has been received:

- place of use PU
- point of diversion
- use made of water

As a matter of record, the Division of Water Resources has on hand a large number of applications awaiting processing. Therefore, to be fair to all concerned, and so that we can process those applications on hand in the order they were received, we intend to concentrate on the backlog of applications until the issue is resolved. You will be contacted regarding this application as soon as it has been examined.

In accordance with the provisions of the Kansas Water Appropriation Act, a portion of which is included below, the use of water prior to approval of the application is unlawful. You should not proceed and divert water as indicated by your plans in your application for a change for this file until you receive approval for this change from the Chief Engineer. Once approved, compliance with the terms, conditions and limitations of the permit is necessary. Conservation of the water resources of Kansas is required.

Section 82a-728 of the Kansas Water Appropriation Act, provides (a) except for the appropriation of water for the purpose of domestic use, . . . it shall be unlawful for any person to appropriate or threaten to appropriate water from any source without first applying for and obtaining a permit to appropriate water in accordance with the provisions of the Water Appropriation Act or for any person to violate any condition of a vested right, appropriation right or an approved application for a permit to appropriate water for beneficial use.

(b) (1) The violation of any provision of this section by any person is a class C misdemeanor...

A class C misdemeanor is punishable by a fine not to exceed \$500 and/or a term of confinement not to exceed one month in the county jail. Each day that the violation occurs constitutes a separate offense.

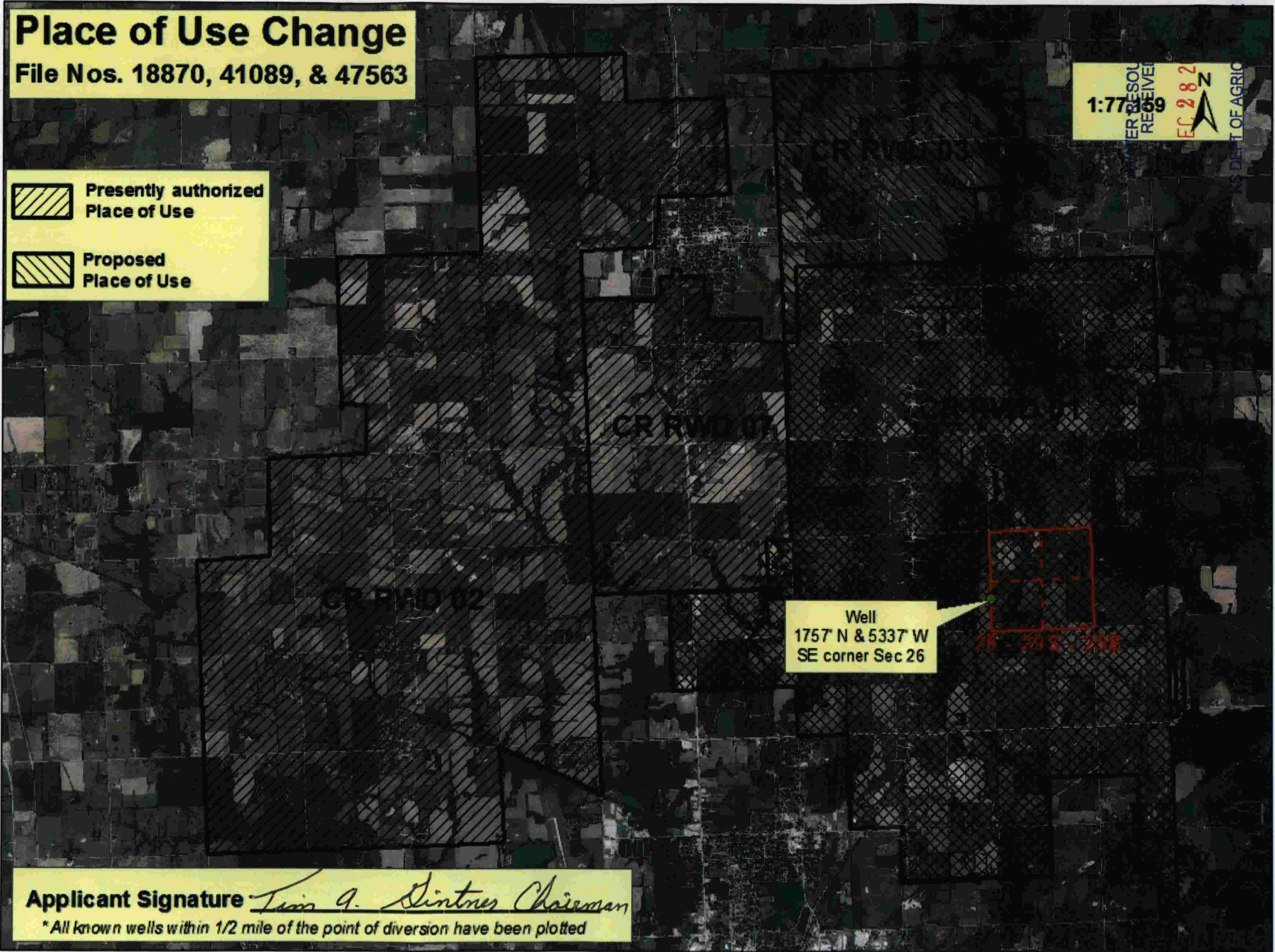
