Willam R. Maasen, on behalf of Johnson County Park and Recreation District, filed an application for approval to change the place of use and use made of water from irrigation to solely recreation use.

The referenced file number is not abandoned pursuant to K.S.A. 82a-718.

There are no overlaps in the points of diversion or place of use. File No. 44,716 is certified 138 acre-feet of storage and 97 acre-feet of direct use from three reservoirs impounded on an unnamed tributary to Indian Creek (Indian Creek Trib 3 Missouri) for irrigation use on 127 acres all located in the Southwest Quarter of Section 33, Township 12 South, Range 25 East, Johnson County (formerly Meadowbrook Golf and Country Club).

Paragraph No. 3 of the application indicates that the referenced change will address the enlargement of existing reservoirs and convert the use made of water entirely to recreational use within the reservoirs. Consumptive use will not be increased since the water right owner has agreed to a reduction in quantity to 8.50 acre-feet, which allows storage of three years of net evaporation from the reservoirs (8.5 surface acres x 4"/12 net evaporation x 3 years). In a March 2, 2017 e-mail to Katie Tietsort, Water Commissioner of the Topeka Field Office, Mr. Maasen indicated that they will irrigate with potable water sources, and will not be recirculating water at this time.

Nearby landowners within one-half mile upstream and downstream from the property lines of the land owned or controlled by the applicant were not notified of the proposed change; the reservoirs are already in existence, and the authorized quantity is being significantly reduced.

The same local source of supply will remain the same.

In an e-mail dated July 25, 2017 Katie indicated no objection to approval of the referenced application.

Based on the above discussion, that the changes are reasonable, that impairment to existing water rights is unlikely, and that no change in the local source of supply will occur, it has been recommended that the referenced application be approved.

The Chief Engineer, Division of Water Resources, Kansas Department of Agriculture, after due consideration of the written application of William R. Maasen, on behalf of Johnson County Park and Recreation District, Attention: Superintendent of Parks, 7900 Renner Road, Shawnee Mission, Kansas, 66219-9723, received in this office on April 19, 2017, for approval of a change in the location of the place of use and the use made of water under the certificate of appropriation issued pursuant to the application for permit to appropriate water for beneficial use, finds that the change is reasonable and will not impair existing rights, and that the application should be and is hereby approved.

This order reduces the authorized quantity to 8.50 acre-feet of water per calendar year and to a diversion rate not to exceed natural flows, in accordance with the Application for Approval to Change the Place of Use and Use Made of Water, File No. 44,716, received on April 19, 2017.

The effective date of the change shall be the date this order is executed by the Chief Engineer, after which the authorized use made of water shall be:

Recreational Use,

and the authorized location of the place of use shall be:

three (3) reservoirs in the Southwest Quarter (SW $\frac{1}{4}$) of Section 33, Township 12 South, Range 25 East, Johnson County, Kansas,

located substantially as shown on the map accompanying the application to change the place of use and use made of water.

In all other respects, the Certificate of Appropriation issued pursuant to Approval of Application, File No. 44,716, for permit to appropriate water for beneficial use, is as stated and set forth in the Certificate of Appropriation dated June 30, 2015.

RIGHT TO A HEARING AND TO ADMINISTRATIVE REVIEW

If you are aggrieved by this Order, then pursuant to K.S.A. 82a-1901, you may:

- 1) request an evidentiary hearing before the Chief Engineer, or
- 2) request administrative review by the Secretary of Agriculture.

Failure to request an evidentiary hearing before the Chief Engineer does not preclude your right to administrative review by the Secretary.

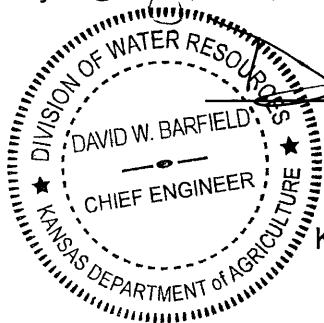
To obtain an evidentiary hearing before the Chief Engineer, a written request for hearing must be filed within 15 days after service of this Order as provided in K.S.A. 77-531 (i.e., within a total of 18 days after this Order was mailed to you), with: Kansas Department of Agriculture, Attn: Legal Section, 1320 Research Park Drive, Manhattan, KS 66502, FAX (785) 564-6777.

If you do not file a request for an evidentiary hearing before the Chief Engineer, you may petition for administrative review of the Order by the Secretary of Agriculture. A petition for review shall be in writing and state the basis for requesting administrative review. The request for hearing may be denied if the request fails to clearly establish factual or legal issues for review. See K.S.A. 77-527. The petition must be filed within 30 days after service of this Order as provided in K.S.A. 77-531 (i.e., within a total of 33 days after this Order was mailed to you), and be filed with: Secretary of Agriculture, Attn: Legal Division, Kansas Department of Agriculture, 1320 Research Park Drive, Manhattan, KS 66502, FAX (785) 564-6777.

If neither a request for an evidentiary hearing nor a petition for administrative review is filed as set forth above, then this Order shall be effective and become a final agency action as defined in K.S.A. 77-607(b). Failure to timely request either an evidentiary hearing or administrative review may preclude further judicial review under the Kansas Judicial Review Act.



Such violation is a class C misdemeanor, punishable by a fine not to exceed \$500 and/or a term of confinement not to exceed one month in the county jail. K.S.A. 82a-728(b). Civil penalties shall be not less than \$100 nor more than \$1,000 per violation. In the case of a continuing violation, each day such violation continues may be deemed a separate violation. In addition to these penalties the water right may be modified or suspended. K.S.A. 82a-737, as amended.

The application must be signed by all owners of the place of use authorized under the water right and his or her spouse, if married. Please indicate if there is no spouse. If land is being purchased under contract, the seller must sign as landowner until such time as the contract is completed.

In the event that all applicants cannot appear before one notary public, they may as necessary sign separate copies of the application before any notary public conveniently available to them. All copies signed in this manner shall be considered to be valid parts of the application.

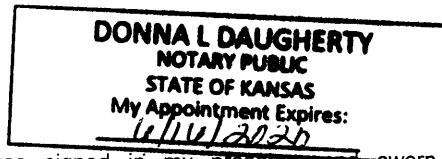

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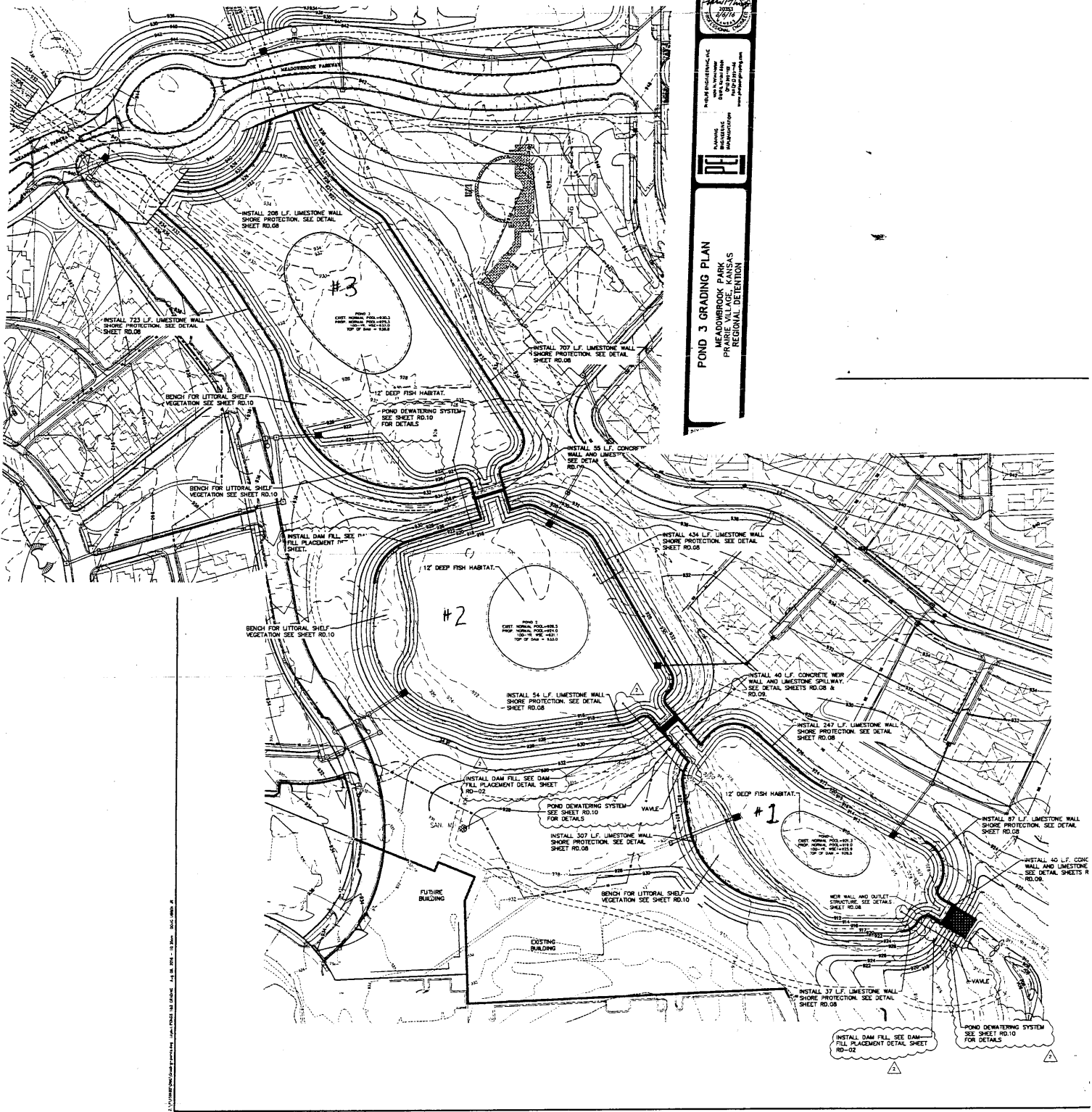
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POND 3 GRADING PLAN

Hi Bill,

Doug Schemm from my office talked with Doug Ubben regarding the Meadowbrook property. Doug U. had the exposed surface acreage diagrams we needed to determine the evaporation needs use. He couldn't answer the following and referred us back to you:

- 1) Will there be any pumping (even recirculation) of water at all? Not at this time.
- 2) Will the existing "man-made" stream between the ponds continue to exist? The three ponds are all directly draining into each other and there is only the dams in between the ponds.
- 3) Will there be pumped water to the waterfall feature? Not at this time.
- 4) Will there be fountains or other devices that may incur additional evaporation or seepage? We are proposing to have aerification in all three ponds to keep the ponds and water looking good and are considering fountains, but not at this time.
- 5) And we want to ensure one last time, you won't pump any water for green spaces, lawns, or landscaping? All irrigation proposed at this time will come from potable water sources.

It may be helpful to set up a quick call for next Monday or later next week to answer this if they are complex.

Dear Sir or Madam:

An application for approval of the Chief Engineer to change the following condition or conditions of the file number referred to above has been received:

- place of use PU/UMW
- point of diversion
- use made of water

As a matter of record, the Division of Water Resources has on hand a large number of applications awaiting processing. Therefore, to be fair to all concerned, and so that we can process those applications on hand in the order they were received, we intend to concentrate on the backlog of applications until the issue is resolved. You will be contacted regarding this application as soon as it has been examined.

In accordance with the provisions of the Kansas Water Appropriation Act, a portion of which is included below, the use of water prior to approval of the application is unlawful. You should not proceed and divert water as indicated by your plans in your application for a change for this file until you receive approval for this change from the Chief Engineer. Once approved, compliance with the terms, conditions and limitations of the permit is necessary. Conservation of the water resources of Kansas is required.

Section 82a-728 of the Kansas Water Appropriation Act, provides (a) except for the appropriation of water for the purpose of domestic use, . . . it shall be unlawful for any person to appropriate or threaten to appropriate water from any source without first applying for and obtaining a permit to appropriate water in accordance with the provisions of the Water Appropriation Act or for any person to violate any condition of a vested right, appropriation right or an approved application for a permit to appropriate water for beneficial use.

(b) (1) The violation of any provision of this section by any person is a class C misdemeanor...

A class C misdemeanor is punishable by a fine not to exceed \$500 and/or a term of confinement not to exceed one month in the county jail. Each day that the violation occurs constitutes a separate offense.

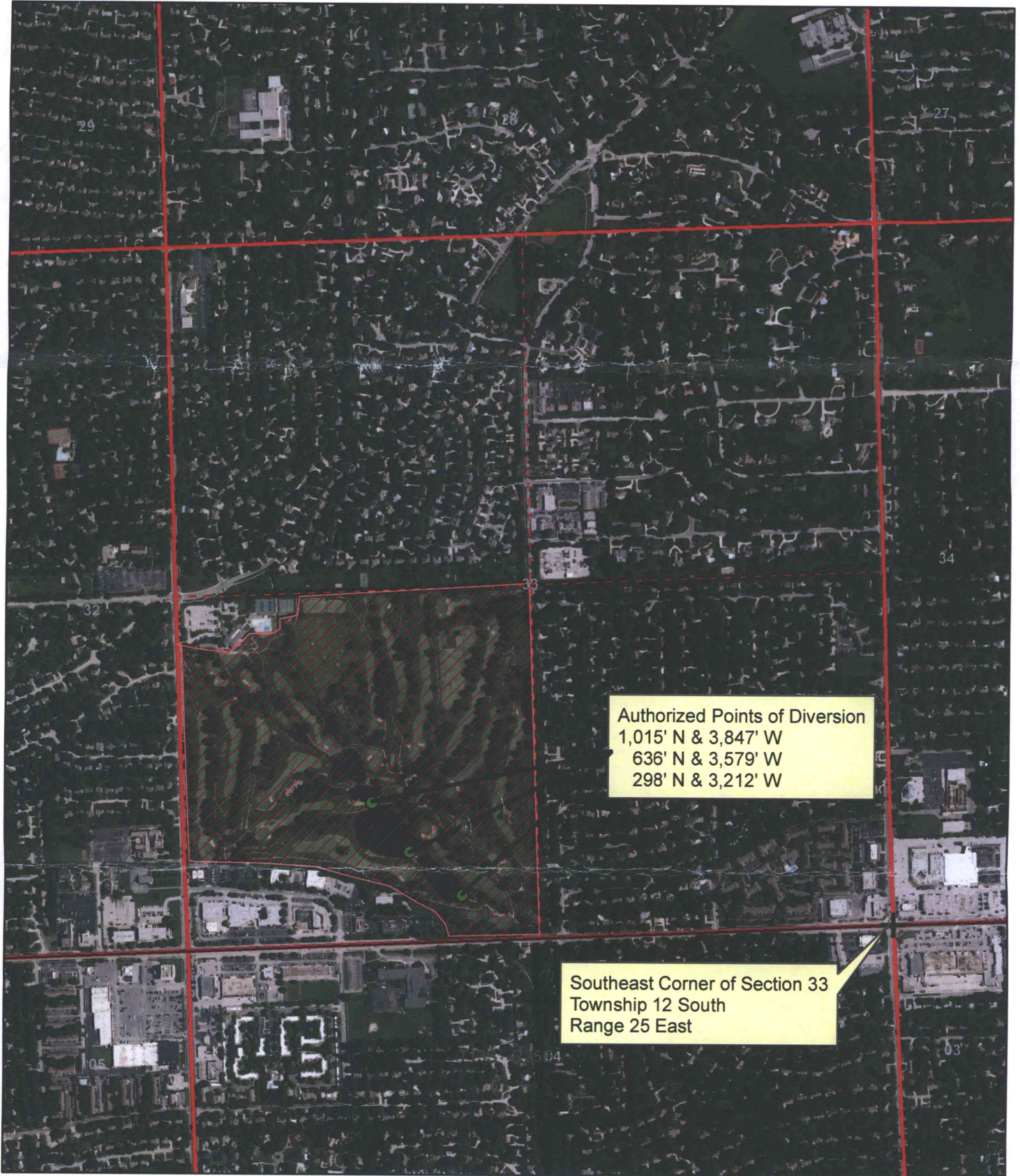
