

That the water user diverting water under the authority of this permit shall not: 1) stop the flow of the stream at or below the point at which the water is diverted; or 2) pump at a rate in excess of the natural flow of the stream at the time the pumping occurs. That the stream flow shall not be stopped at the first riffle below the point of diversion while pumping under the authority of this 3. That this permit does not give any right-of-way, or authorize any injury to, or trespass upon, public or private property. That if used for oil or gas wells on or before the date drilling commences on each oil or gas well, or water is diverted for such purposes, the permittee shall mail a report to the Division of Water Resources (DWR), indicating the location of the actual point of diversion by legal description, the Kansas Corporation Commission "intent to drill" number for that oil or gas well, the DWR term permit number, the estimated quantity of water to be used for drilling the oil or gas well, and the estimated dates the diversion will begin and end for that particular well. That the applicant shall maintain records from which the total quantity of water actually diverted during the term of the permit may readily be determined. Such information shall be furnished to the Chief Engineer on or before March 1 of the calendar year following the water use. That failure without cause to comply with provisions of the permit and its terms, conditions and limitations will result in revocation of

Re: Possible Illegal Diversion of Water

The Department of Agriculture Division of Water Resources has become aware that you may be diverting surface water, or threatening to divert surface water for industrial use, by means of a pump site located as follows: In the Northeast Quarter of the Southeast Quarter of Section 20, Township 16 South, Range 21 East, Franklin County, Kansas.

There is nothing in the office of the Chief Engineer to show that this is covered by any vested right or approved application for permit to appropriate water for beneficial use, which may be required under the Kansas Water Appropriation Act. K.S.A. 82a-728 (copy enclosed) makes it unlawful for any person to appropriate, or threaten to appropriate, water from any source without first applying for and obtaining a permit to appropriate water in accordance with the Kansas Water Appropriation Act and provides for criminal penalties for violation.

You must submit the properly completed application, accompanied by the appropriate filing fee as set forth by statute, to the office of the Chief Engineer, Division for Water Resources (DWR), Kansas Department of Agriculture, by November 24, 2019, in order to bring your diversion of water into compliance with the Kansas Water Appropriation Act.

I have enclosed a Basin Term Permit Application which will allow you to pump water from any stream within the Marais des Cygnes drainage basin, as shown on the attached map. The filing fee is \$200.
