2 I Feeders Inc. has filed an application for approval to change the place of use authorized by Water Right, File Nos. 44,071 and 47,208; and Appropriation of Water, File No. 50,157.

The referenced file numbers do not appear abandoned pursuant to K.S.A. 82a-718.

The three change applications are designed to create a complete overlap in place of use with between Water Right, File Nos. 44,071 and 47,208, Appropriation of Water, File No. 50,157, and New Application, File No. 50,433. The applications will be approved in unison with New Application, File No. 50,433; another change application for Water Right, File No. 44,071; and the dismissal of Appropriation of Water, File No. 50,158 (voluntary dismissal from the applicant).

The stockwatering place of use will be described as a feedlot located in the Southeast Quarter, the Northeast Quarter, the East Half of the Northwest Quarter, the East Half of the Southwest Quarter of Section 8; the Southwest Quarter and Northwest Quarter of Section 9; the Northwest Quarter and the North Half of the Northeast Quarter of Section 16; the Northeast Quarter and the Northeast Quarter of the Northwest Quarter of Section 17, all in Township 16 South, Range 11 East, Lyon county Kansas.

The memo for New Application, File No. 50,433 outlines the total quantity limitations in further detail for all files involved.

No domestic or non-domestic wells owned by anyone other than the applicant are within a half-mile of File Nos. 47,208, and 50,157. Therefore, no nearby notification letters for those change applications are required. Two letters were mailed on August 9, 2021 to landowners $\frac{1}{2}$ mile upstream and downstream of the applicant's property lines, to notify of the pending change application for File No. 44,071. No responses of any kind have been received to date.

The local source of supply will not change, previously determined to be Council Grove group (550) – File Nos. 47,208 and 50,157, and Allen Creek Tributary 1 (Neosho River) – File No. 44.071.

In an e-mail dated August 6, 2021, Katie Tietsort, Water Commissioner of the Topeka Field Office, recommend approval of the referenced applications.

No File Nos. are within any Groundwater Management Districts. Water flow meters are required. Check valves are required if any chemical or foreign substance is injected into the water through the diversion works.

Based on the above discussion, that the changes are reasonable, that impairment to existing water rights is unlikely, that no change in the local source of supply will occur, it is recommended the referenced application be approved.



The Chief Engineer, Division of Water Resources, Kansas Department of Agriculture, after due consideration of the written applications of Daniel Otto Berges and Derek Thompson on behalf of 2 I Feeders LLC, 884 Road 350, Allen, Kansas, 66833, received in this office on August 26, 2020, for approval of a change in the location of the point of diversion, and on June 7, 2021, for approval of a change in the location of the place of use, under the certificate of appropriation issued pursuant to the application for permit to appropriate water for beneficial use, as modified and amended by the Order of the Chief Engineer dated April 11, 2019, approving the application to change the place of use, finds that the change is reasonable and will not impair existing rights, and that the application should be and is hereby approved.

The effective date of the change shall be the date this order is executed by the Chief Engineer, after which authorized location of the place of use shall be:

a feedlot located in the Southeast Quarter (SE¼) of Section 8, the East Half of the Southwest Quarter (E½ SW¼) of Section 8, the Northeast Quarter (NE¾) of Section 8, the East Half of the Northwest Quarter (E½ NW¾) of Section 8, a portion of the Southwest Quarter (SW¾) of Section 9, the Northwest Quarter (NW¾) of Section 9, the North Half of the Northeast Quarter (N½ NE¾) and the Northwest Quarter (NW¾) of Section 16, the Northeast Quarter of the Northwest Quarter (NE¾ NW¾) and the Northeast Quarter (NE¾) of Section 17, all in Township 16 South, Range 11 East, Lyon County, Kansas,

and the authorized location of the points of diversion shall be:

two (2) water control structures, one located in the Southeast Quarter of the Southwest Quarter of the Northwest Quarter (SE¼ SW¼ NW¼) of Section 9, more particularly described as being near a point 2,834 feet North and 4,480 feet West of the Southeast corner of said section, and a second located in the Southwest Quarter of the Northwest Quarter of the Southwest Quarter (SW¼ NW¼ SW¾) of Section 9, more particularly described as being near a point 1,863 feet North and 4,750 feet West of the Southeast corner of said section, both in Township 16 South, Range 11 East, Lyon County Kansas,

located substantially as shown on the maps accompanying the applications to change the place of use and point of diversion.

All diversion works into which any type of chemical or other foreign substance will be injected into the water pumped from the diversion works shall be equipped with an in-line, automatic, quick-closing check valve capable of preventing pollution of the source of the water supply. The type of valve installed shall meet specifications adopted by the Chief Engineer and shall be maintained in an operating condition satisfactory to the Chief Engineer.

File No. 44,071

The water right owner shall properly install an acceptable water meter on the diversion works authorized under this water right, prior to the use of water, in strict accordance with the Kansas Administrative Regulations 5-1-4 through 5-1-12 adopted by the Chief Engineer. The water right owner shall notify the Chief Engineer when installation of the water meter has been completed. The water right owner shall maintain the water meter in an operating condition satisfactory to the Chief Engineer, at all times during diversion of water and shall maintain records from which the total quantity of water diverted may be determined. The water right owner shall also report the reading of said water meter and the total quantity of water diverted annually to the Chief Engineer. Such records shall be furnished to the Chief Engineer by March 1 following the end of each calendar year.

In all other respects, the Certificate of Appropriation issued pursuant to Approval of Application, File No. 44,071, for permit to appropriate water for beneficial use, is as stated and set forth in the Certificate of Appropriation dated June 16, 2014, as modified and amended by the aforementioned order.
