<u>MEMORANDUM</u>

Kansas Department of Wildlife Parks & Tourism has filed the application referred to above proposing to appropriate 240 acre-feet of surface water at a diversion rate of 6,000 gallons per minute from one pump site on Bull Creek in the Marais des Cygnes River drainage basin, for recreational use in waterfowl marshes. This application will allow water to be pumped directly from Bull Creek (when flows are adequate, and permission is granted). The water will be used to fill and maintain water levels in a marsh complex (i.e. offset evaporative and seepage losses). The marsh complex is located in the East Half of the Southeast Quarter (E½ SE¼) of Section 21; the West Half of the Southwest Quarter (W½ SW½) of Section 22; the Northwest Quarter of the Northwest Quarter (NW½ NW½) of Section 27; and the Northeast Quarter of the Northeast Quarter (NE1/4 NE1/4) of Section 28, all in Township 15 South, Range 22 East, Miami County, Kansas. The marshes are already permitted under Structures Program File No. LMI-0051 and LMI-0022.

The point of diversion and place of use overlap with Water Right, File No. 46,477, however this file dismissed will be dismissed for failure to perfect any water. This new application effectively replaces this senior file. 8/20/2020 Water Right, File No. 46,478 overlaps in place of use, and it is authorized 128.35 acre-feet for the LI/DWR collection of natural flows into the marshes. The quantity requested on the new application was based on a total marsh area of 40 acres, filling it with 3 feet of water, and two fillings per year, equals 240 acre-feet. The combined quantity of the two files would be 368.35 acre-feet (128.35 AF + 240 AF). Therefore, this junior file will be limited to 240 acre-feet when combined with the senior file on the place of use, providing 111.65 acre-feet of additional water.

The applicant identified that the COE owns all of the adjacent land and no notification letters are required. There are several permitted water rights downstream within the two-mile radius circle, with all but one owned by the applicant. With proper conditioning, as discussed below, approval of this application will not impair senior water rights.

This approval will be subject to specific conditions, which stipulate strict requirements for direct surface water diversion. These conditions include the stipulation that no diversion shall occur unless there is water available to satisfy all demands by senior water rights and permits, written or verbal permission from the Chief Engineer, or an authorized representative is required prior to diverting water, and streamflow cannot be stopped at the first riffle below the point of diversion while diversion is taking place. The application also complies with K.A.R 5-3-15 (c)(5) because the proposed use of water for recreational use is typically during the fall season, and there is no need for direct diversion of water from July 1 through September 30.

The applicant has submitted a signed and notarized Marais des Cygnes River Assurance District (MDS) form acknowledging that there may be times when diversion of water will not be allowed.

In accordance with K.S.A. 82a-706c, the Chief Engineer retains full authority to require any water user to install meters, gages, or other measuring devices, which devices he or she or his or her agents may read at any time. Water flowmeter requirements are further described in K.A.R. 5-1-4 through K.A.R. 5-1-12.

In an October 21, 2020 e-mail, Katie Tietsort, Water Commissioner, Topeka Field Office, gave a recommendation that the application be approved.

Based on the above discussion, the area remains open to new appropriations, the approval is subject to specific conditions relative to direct surface water diversions, diversion is limited to fall "off-season" pumping, the project is already properly permitted by the Structures Program, it is replacing a file that failed to perfect any water, and there is no indication that existing water rights will be impaired, it is recommended that the referenced application be approved.

for a permit to appropriate water for beneficial use, together with the maps, plans and other submitted data, and that the application is hereby approved and the applicant is hereby authorized, subject to vested rights and prior appropriations, to proceed with the construction of the proposed diversion works (except those dams and stream obstructions regulated by K.S.A. 82a-301 through 305a, as amended), and to proceed with all steps necessary for the application of the water to the approved and proposed beneficial use and otherwise perfect the proposed appropriation subject to the following terms, conditions and limitations:

- 1. That the priority date assigned to such application is **July 22**, **2020**.
- 2. That the water sought to be appropriated shall be used for recreational use in a wildlife marsh complex located in the East Half of the Southeast Quarter (E½ SE¼) of Section 21; the West Half of the Southwest Quarter (W½ SW¼) of Section 22; the Northwest Quarter of the Northwest Quarter (NW¼ NW¼) of Section 27; and the Northeast Quarter of the Northeast Quarter (NE¼ NE¼) of Section 28, all in Township 15 South, Range 22 East, Miami County, Kansas.
- 3. That the authorized source from which the appropriation shall be made is surface water from Bull Creek, in the Marais des Cygnes River drainage basin, to be withdrawn by means of one (1) pump site located in the Southeast Quarter of the Northeast Quarter of the Southeast Quarter (SE¼ NE¼ SE¼) of Section 21, more particularly described as being near a point 1,510 feet North and 657 feet West of the Southeast corner of said section, in Township 15 South, Range 22 East, Miami County, Kansas, located substantially as shown on the map accompanying the application.
- 4. That the appropriation sought shall be limited to a maximum diversion rate not in excess of 6,000 gallons per minute (13.37 c.f.s.) and to a quantity not to exceed 240 acre-feet of water for any calendar year.
- 5. That installation of works for diversion of water shall be completed on or before <u>December 31</u>, <u>2022</u> or within any authorized extension thereof. The applicant shall notify the Chief Engineer and pay the statutorily required field inspection fee of \$400.00 when construction of the works has been completed. Failure to timely submit the notice and the fee will result in revocation of the permit. Any request for an extension of time shall be submitted prior to the expiration of the deadline and shall be accompanied by the required statutory fee of \$100.00.

6. That the proposed appropriation shall be perfected by the actual application of water to the proposed beneficial use on or before <u>December 31, 2026</u> or any authorized extension thereof. Any request for an extension of time shall be submitted prior to the expiration of the deadline and shall be accompanied by the required statutory fee of \$100.00.

- 7. That the applicant shall not be deemed to have acquired a water appropriation for a quantity in excess of the amount approved herein nor in excess of the amount found by the Chief Engineer to have been actually used for the approved purpose during one calendar year subsequent to approval of the application and within the time specified for perfection or any authorized extension thereof.
- 8. That the use of water herein authorized shall not be made so as to impair any use under existing water rights nor prejudicially and unreasonably affect the public interest.
- 9. That the right of the appropriator shall relate to a specific quantity of water and such right must allow for a reasonable raising or lowering of the static water level and for the reasonable increase or decrease of the streamflow at the appropriator's point of diversion.
- 10. That this permit does not constitute authority under K.S.A. 82a-301 through 305a to construct any dam or other obstruction; nor does it grant any right-of-way, or authorize entry upon or injury to, public or private property.
- 11. That all diversion works constructed under the authority of this permit into which any type of chemical or other foreign substance will be injected into the water pumped from the diversion works shall be equipped with an in-line, automatic quick-closing, check valve capable of preventing pollution of the source of the water supply. The type of valve installed shall meet specifications adopted by the Chief Engineer and shall be maintained in an operating condition satisfactory to the Chief Engineer.
- 12. That an acceptable water flow meter shall be installed and maintained on the diversion works authorized by this permit in accordance with the Kansas Administrative Regulations 5-1-4 through 5-1-12 adopted by the Chief Engineer. This water flow meter shall be used to provide an accurate quantity of water diverted as required for the annual water use report (including the meter reading at the beginning and end of the report year).
- 13. That the applicant shall maintain accurate and complete records from which the quantity of water diverted during each calendar year may be readily determined and the applicant shall file an annual water use report with the Chief Engineer by March 1 following the end of each calendar year. Failure to file the annual water use report by the due date shall cause the applicant to be subject to a civil penalty.
- 14. That no water user shall engage in nor allow the waste of any water diverted under the authority of this permit.
- 15. That failure without cause to comply with provisions of the permit and its terms, conditions and limitations will result in the forfeiture of the priority date, revocation of the permit and dismissal of the application.
- 16. That the right to appropriate water under authority of this permit is subject to any minimum desirable streamflow requirements identified and established pursuant to K.S.A. 82a-703c for the source of supply to which this water right applies.

- 17. That diversion of natural flow shall not take place unless there is water available to satisfy all demands by senior water rights and permits.
- 18. That the stream flow shall not be stopped at the first riffle below the point of diversion while diversion is taking place under the authority of this water right or permit.
- 19. That during the period October 1 through June 30, the verbal or written permission of the Chief Engineer, or an authorized representative of the Chief Engineer, shall be obtained in order to divert water each time the applicant desires to divert water.
- 20. That during the period July 1 through September 30 each calendar year, no direct diversions of surface water shall be permitted unless written permission is obtained from the Chief Engineer, or the Chief Engineer's authorized representative.
- 21. That the quantity of water approved under this permit is further limited to the quantity which combined with Water Right, File No. 46,478, will provide a **total not to exceed 240 acre-feet** of water per calendar year for recreational use in the marsh complex described herein.

The approval of your application constitutes a permit to appropriate water. It does not give authority to construct any dam or other stream obstruction regulated by K.S.A. 82a-301 through 305a. It does not give authority to access any right-of-way or authorize trespassing upon or injury to public or private property. RIGHT TO A HEARING AND TO ADMINISTRATIVE REVIEW

If you are aggrieved by this Order, then pursuant to K.S.A. 82a-1901, you may:

- 1) request an evidentiary hearing before the Chief Engineer, or
- 2) request administrative review by the Secretary of Agriculture.

Failure to request an evidentiary hearing before the Chief Engineer does not preclude your right to administrative review by the Secretary. To obtain an evidentiary hearing before the Chief Engineer, a written request for hearing must be filed within 15 days after service of this Order as provided in K.S.A. 77-531 (i.e., within a total of 18 days after this Order was mailed to you), with: Kansas Department of Agriculture, Attn: Legal Section, 1320 Research Park Drive, Manhattan, Kansas 66502, FAX (785) 564-6777.

If you do not file a request for an evidentiary hearing before the Chief Engineer, you may petition for administrative review of the Order by the Secretary of Agriculture. A petition for review shall be in writing and state the basis for requesting administrative review. The request for hearing may be denied if the request fails to clearly establish factual or legal issues for review. See K.S.A. 77-527. The petition must be filed within 30 days after service of this Order as provided in K.S.A. 77-531 (i.e., within a total of 33 days after this Order was mailed to you), and be filed with: Secretary of Agriculture, Attn: Legal Division, Kansas Department of Agriculture, 1320 Research Park Drive, Manhattan, Kansas 66502, FAX (785) 564-6777.

If neither a request for an evidentiary hearing nor a petition for administrative review is filed as set forth above, then this Order shall be effective and become a final agency action as defined in K.S.A. 77-607(b). Failure to timely request either an evidentiary hearing or administrative review may preclude further judicial review under the Kansas Judicial Review Act.
