

Water Right, File Nos. 28,375 & 37,282 Appropriation of Water, File No. 43,428

Paul Heinen, on behalf of Rural Water District No. 3, Jefferson County, Kansas, has filed applications for approval to change the place of use for the referenced file numbers. These files are authorized to appropriate groundwater in the Delaware River basin for municipal use. These files overlap the same point of diversion (battery of two wells) and the same place of use.

The District reported selling water to the City of Ozawkie on the 2022 and 2021 annual water use reports. These change approvals will update the authorized place of use to be described as:

within the boundaries of Rural Water District No. 3, Jefferson County, Kansas; Rural Water District No. 11, Jefferson County, Kansas; and the City of Ozawkie; and their immediate vicinities.

Rural Water District No. 6, Jefferson County, Kansas will be removed from the place of use as it was dissolved in 2002. The former boundaries of this district appear to be encompassed by current boundaries of Rural Water District No. 3, Jefferson County, Kansas. A map published by the Kansas Rural Water Association (KRWA) is attached to these approvals to show the boundaries of the entities being served water.

The referenced file numbers are not abandoned per K.S.A. 82a-718. The applications are considered complete per K.A.R. 5-5-2a, *Complete change application*.

This application proposes a change in place of use to include existing areas being served and no new wells will be authorized. Therefore, notification per K.S.A. 82a-1906 is unnecessary. Also, the local source of supply will not change as no new wells will be authorized.

These files authorize a total quantity of 136 million gallons per year as shown below:

The perfection period for File No. 43,428 ends on December 31, 2023. The maximum authorized quantity has yet to be reached, so it appears the changes should not result in an increase in consumptive use. The District may need to request an extension of this perfection period in order to perfect additional quantity. The District has been selling water to the City of Ozawkie since 2021 without exceeding the authorized quantity. Thus, the existing files appear to authorize sufficient quantity to provide water to the proposed place of use.

These applications do not propose any change to the point of diversion location. However, G.P.S data were collected during a January 12, 2009 Field Inspection which more accurately describe the well locations. The actual location of the geographic center is 135 feet from the authorized location (i.e. less than 300 feet) and so it complies with K.A.R. 5-5-6 (*Failure to construct diversion works at authorized location*).

The point of diversion description will be updated on these approvals based on GPS data as:

A battery of two (2) wells with a geographic center located in the Southwest Quarter of the Northeast Quarter (SW¼ NE¼ NE½) of Section 3, more particularly described as being near a point 4,464 feet North and 956 feet West of the Southeast corner of said section, in Township 10 South, Range 17 East, Jefferson County, Kansas.

Brett Bunger, Topeka Field Office Water Commissioner, recommended approval of these change applications in an August 18, 2023 e-mail. Based on the above discussion, that the changes are reasonable, that no change is planned to the authorized point of diversion or the authorized quantity of water and rate of diversion, and the proposed change will not cause impairment of existing water rights, it is recommended that the referenced applications be approved.

APPROVAL OF APPLICATION FOR CHANGE IN PLACE OF USE AND ORDER BETTER DESCRIBING THE AUTHORIZED POINT OF DIVERSION APPROPRIATION OF WATER FILE NO. 43,428

The Chief Engineer, Division of Water Resources, Kansas Department of Agriculture, after due consideration of the written application of Terry Broxterman and Paul Heinen, on behalf of Rural Water District No. 3, Jefferson County, Post Office Box 129, Valley Falls, Kansas, 66088, received in this office on April 25, 2022, for approval of a change in the location of the place of use under the Approval of Application, File No. 43,428, for permit to appropriate water for beneficial use, as modified and amended by the Order of the Chief Engineer dated December 14, 2021, approving the application to change the place of use, finds that the change is reasonable and will not impair existing rights, that the change relates to the same local source of supply and that the application should be and is hereby approved.

The effective date of the change shall be the date this order is executed by the Chief Engineer, after which the authorized place of use shall be:

within the boundaries of Rural Water District Nos. 3 and 11, Jefferson County, Kansas, and within the City of Ozawkie, Kansas, and its immediate vicinity,

and the location of the authorized point of diversion shall be better described as:

a battery of two (2) wells with a geographic center located in the Southwest Quarter of the Northeast Quarter (SW¼ NE¼ NE½) of Section 3, more particularly described as being near a point 4,464 feet North and 956 feet West of the Southeast corner of said section, in Township 10 South, Range 17 East, Jefferson County, Kansas.

All diversion works into which any type of chemical or other foreign substance will be injected into the water pumped from the diversion works shall be equipped with an in-line, automatic, quick-closing check valve capable of preventing pollution of the source of the water supply. The type of valve installed shall meet specifications adopted by the Chief Engineer and shall be maintained in an operating condition satisfactory to the Chief Engineer.

The water right owner shall properly install an acceptable water meter on the diversion works authorized under this water right, prior to the use of water, in strict accordance with the Kansas Administrative Regulations 5-1-4 through 5-1-12 adopted by the Chief Engineer. The water right owner shall notify the Chief Engineer when installation of the water meter has been completed.

The water right owner shall maintain the water meter in an operating condition satisfactory to the Chief Engineer, at all times during diversion of water and shall maintain records from which the total quantity of water diverted may be determined. The water right owner shall also report the reading of said water meter and the total quantity of water diverted annually to the Chief Engineer. Such records shall be furnished to the Chief Engineer by March 1 following the end of each calendar year.

In all other respects, Approval of Application, File No. 43,428, for permit to appropriate water for beneficial use, is as stated and set forth in the approval dated December 28, 1998, as modified and amended by the aforementioned order.

RIGHT TO A HEARING AND TO ADMINISTRATIVE REVIEW

If you are aggrieved by this Order, then pursuant to K.S.A. 82a-1901, you may request an evidentiary hearing before the Chief Engineer, or request administrative review by the Secretary of Agriculture. Failure to request an evidentiary hearing before the Chief Engineer does not preclude your right to administrative review by the Secretary.

To obtain an evidentiary hearing before the Chief Engineer, a written request for hearing must be filed within 15 days after service of this Order as provided in K.S.A. 77-531 (i.e., within a total of 18 days after this Order was mailed to you), with: Kansas Department of Agriculture, Attn: Legal Division, 1320 Research Park Drive, Manhattan, Kansas 66502, FAX (785) 564-6777.

If you do not file a request for an evidentiary hearing before the Chief Engineer, you may petition for administrative review of the Order by the Secretary of Agriculture. A petition for review shall be in writing and state the basis for requesting administrative review. The request for review may be denied if the request fails to clearly establish factual or legal issues for review. See K.S.A. 77-527. The petition must be filed within 30 days after service of this Order as provided in K.S.A. 77-531 (i.e., within a total of 33 days after this Order was mailed to you), and be filed with: Secretary of Agriculture, Attn: Legal Division, Kansas Department of Agriculture, 1320 Research Park Drive, Manhattan, Kansas 66502, FAX (785) 564-6777.

If neither a request for an evidentiary hearing nor a petition for administrative review is filed as set forth above, then this Order shall be effective and become a final agency action as defined in K.S.A. 77-607(b). Failure to timely request either an evidentiary hearing or administrative review may preclude further judicial review under the Kansas Judicial Review Act.
