CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION FOR BENEFICIAL USE OF WATER

WHEREAS, It has been determined by the undersigned that construction of the appropriation diversion works has been completed, that water has been used for beneficial purposes and that the appropriation right has been perfected, all in conformity with the conditions of approval of the application pursuant to the water right referred to above and in conformity with the laws of the State of Kansas.

NOW, THEREFORE, Be It Known that CHRISTOPHER W. BEIGHTEL, the duly appointed, qualified and acting Chief Engineer of the Division of Water Resources of the Kansas Department of Agriculture, by authority of the laws of the State of Kansas, and particularly K.S.A. 82a-714, does hereby certify that, subject to vested rights and prior appropriation rights, the appropriator is entitled to make use of all natural flows of an unnamed tributary to Terrapin Creek, identified in the office of the Chief Engineer as Terrapin Creek Tributary No. 5 (South Fork of the Big Nemaha River), to be incrementally accumulated to a maximum quantity not to exceed 141.5 acre-feet of water per calendar year in a reservoir created by a dam located in the Southwest Quarter of the Northeast Quarter of the Southwest Quarter (SW¼ NE¼ SW¼) of Section 36, more particularly described as being near a point 1,835 feet North and 3,390 feet West of the Southeast corner of said section, in Township 1 South, Range 15 East, Brown County, Kansas, to be rediverted at a rate of diversion not in excess of 775 gallons per minute (1.73 c.f.s) and a quantity not to exceed 100 acre-feet of water per calendar year, for direct irrigation use at the following location:
