NEBRASKA ADMINISTRATIVE CODE

Title 458 - NEBRASKA DEPARTMENT OF NATURAL RESOURCES RULES FOR SAFETY OF DAMS AND RESERVOIRS

CHAPTER 12: AUTHORITY TO SIGN ORDERS, NOTICES, REVOCATIONS

<u>001</u>. The Chief Engineer of Dam Safety Section is hereby granted authority to sign orders, notices, and revocations subject to matters covered by these rules and by the Safety of Dams and Reservoirs Act.

STATUTORY AUTHORITY: Neb. Rev. Stat. § 61-206
